Columbia suspends vulgar texting wrestlers for year

Columbia's athletics department suspended members of the wrestling team who were responsible for sexually and racially offensive text messages from competition for the rest of the season and the 2016-17 academic year, according to a statement released Friday.

"It has now been determined that the deeply offensive group messaging and texts were written, sent and viewed by a distinct group within the wrestling team," the school said, a week after the texts became public. "While all team members feel a sense of collective responsibility and regret for what was said and done by some, the investigation found that the individual student-athletes who participated in the group

chat acted on their own."

Doling out punishment based on the student-athletes' level of involvement, the school has suspended other members of the team until the beginning of the 2017 semester, while clearing those not involved in the incident to compete this weekend at the New York State Championships in Ithaca, N.Y.

"We recognize that free speech is a core value both of the University community and of our nation," the statement read. "Our students and faculty have the right to express themselves and their views, whether through their public or private communications. However, the group text messages that have been brought to light do not meet the standard of behavior we expect from

our student-athletes at Columbia."

The announcement comes one week after Bwog, a student-run news site, exposed the vulgar GroupMe chat, in which members of the Class of 2017 call Columbia female students "ugly socially awkward c--ts" and insult African-Americans, whom they call the N-word throughout, for the protests that broke out in Ferguson, Mo., in 2014 over the death of Michael Brown. The messages, which span from 2014 until a few weeks ago, include numerous photos of female students attached to vulgar commentary.

On Monday, the university announced it was suspending the wrestling season.

Members of the wrestling team released an apology letter Thursday.

NFL: K.C.'s Maclin still out

The Chiefs again will be without receiver **Jeremy Maclin** (groin) versus Tampa Bay on Sunday, though it's increasingly likely linebacker **Justin Houston** will make his season debut.

Klay Thompson scored 28 points, **Kevin Durant** had 23 points and 10 rebounds and Warriors scored 18 points in a row in the third quarter to beat the Celtics 104-88 on Friday night in Boston.

● **Anthony Davis** had 38 points, nine rebounds and four blocks, **Jrue Holiday** added 21 points in his first action this season, and the Pelicans beat the Trail Blazers 113-101 in New Orleans.

MLB: Cashner heads to Texas

Right-hander **Andrew Cashner** is going home for a spot in the Rangers' rotation.

The Texas native and former Marlins pitcher and the team had

reached an agreement on a \$10 million, one-year deal on Friday, according to reports.

● The Royals signed veteran catcher **Drew Butera** to a \$3.8 million, two-year contract, keeping him as the primary backup to **Salvador Perez**. Butera will make \$1.5 million this season and \$2.3 million next season.

GOLF: Hughes leads RSM

Canadian rookie **Mackenzie Hughes** shot a 5-under 67 on the Plantation course Friday at Sea Island in St. Simmons Island, Ga., and built a two-shot lead going into the weekend at the RSM Classic. **C.T. Pan** shot a 64 and was two back.

● In Naples, Fla., **Lydia Ko** (12-under 132) shot a tournament-record 10-under 62 to take a three-stroke lead in the CME Group Tour Championship. **Ryann O'Toole** (67) and **So Yeon Ryu** (68) were tied for second.

ETC.: Boise St. blasts UNLV

Jeremy McNichols ran for 206 yards and a career-high four touchdowns to help No. 22 Boise State beat UNLV 42-25 on Friday night in Boise, Idaho, to keep its Mountain West title hopes alive

● **Marian Hossa's** controversial goal with 2:23 left in the third period lifted the Blackhawks to a 3-2 victory over the Flames in Calgary, Alberta. **Artemi Panarin's** shot was deflected by **Chad Johnson's** glove high in the air and as the puck came down, Hossa knocked it in. Replays showed it might have been a high stick by Hossa.
