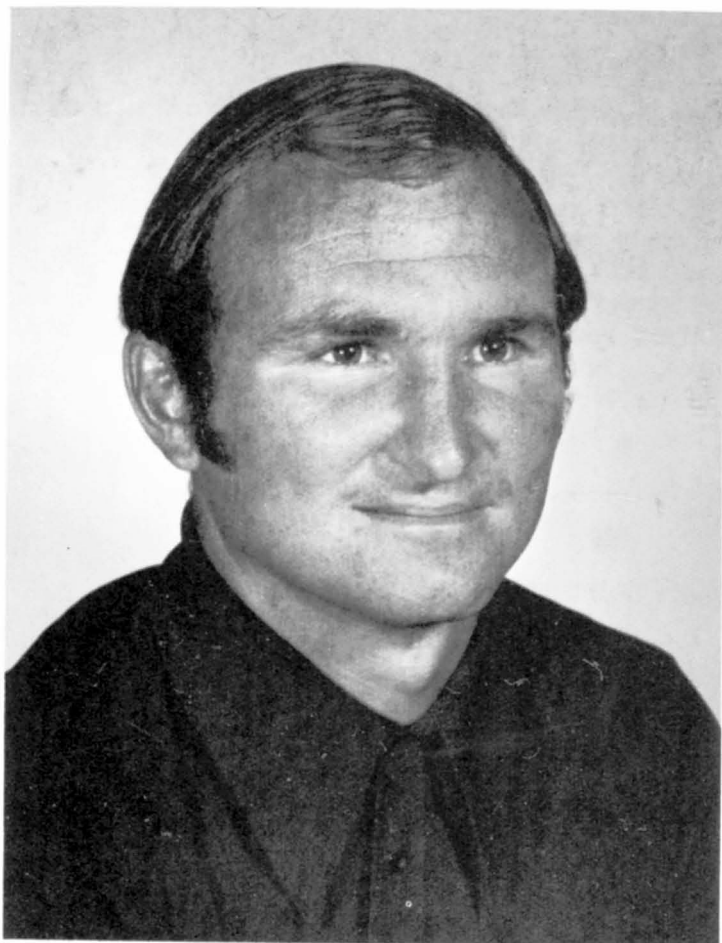

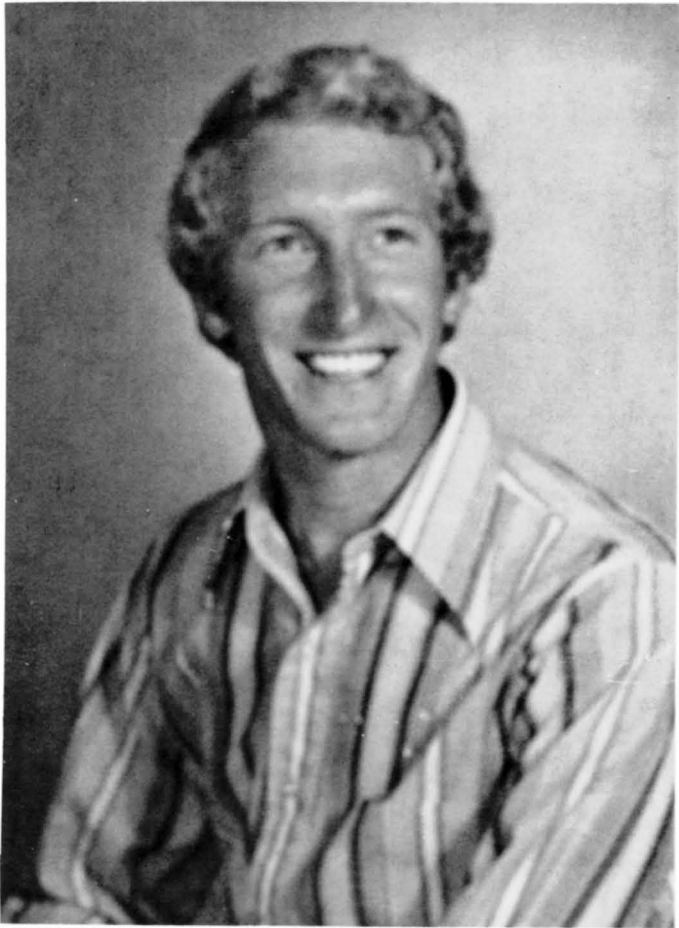
SOUTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL COACHES ASSOCIATION

Bozied, with previous coaching experience in Wyoming and Nebraska, stated that he was "honored and surprised to be recognized by the S.D.H.S.C.A."

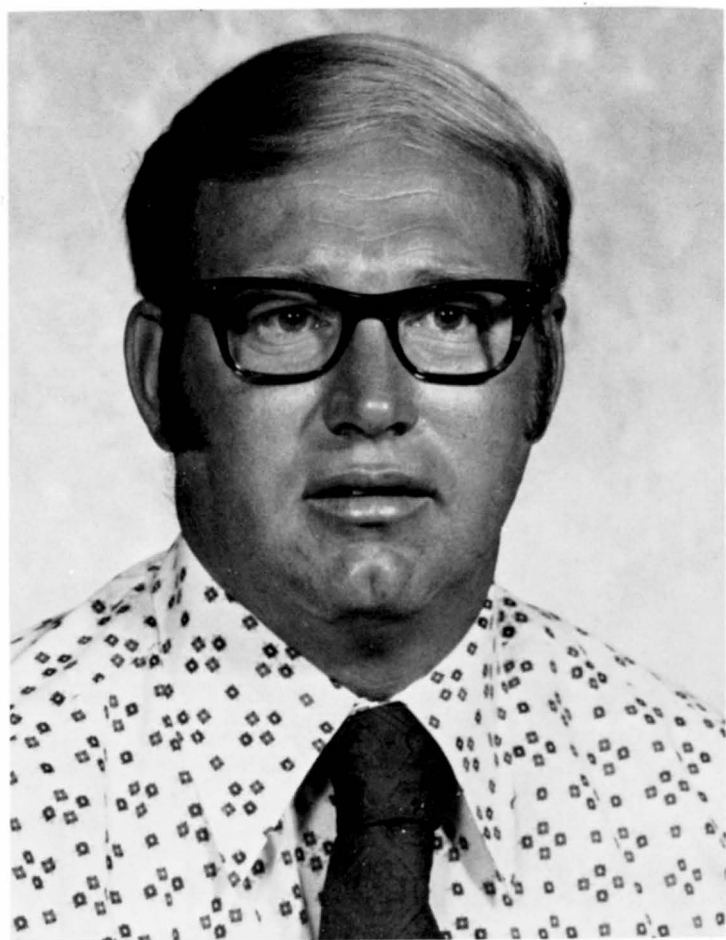
SOUTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL COACHES ASSOCIATION

Gemar is a native of Scotland and a graduate of the University of South Dakota. He had outstanding success as a runner in track and cross country while in high school and college.

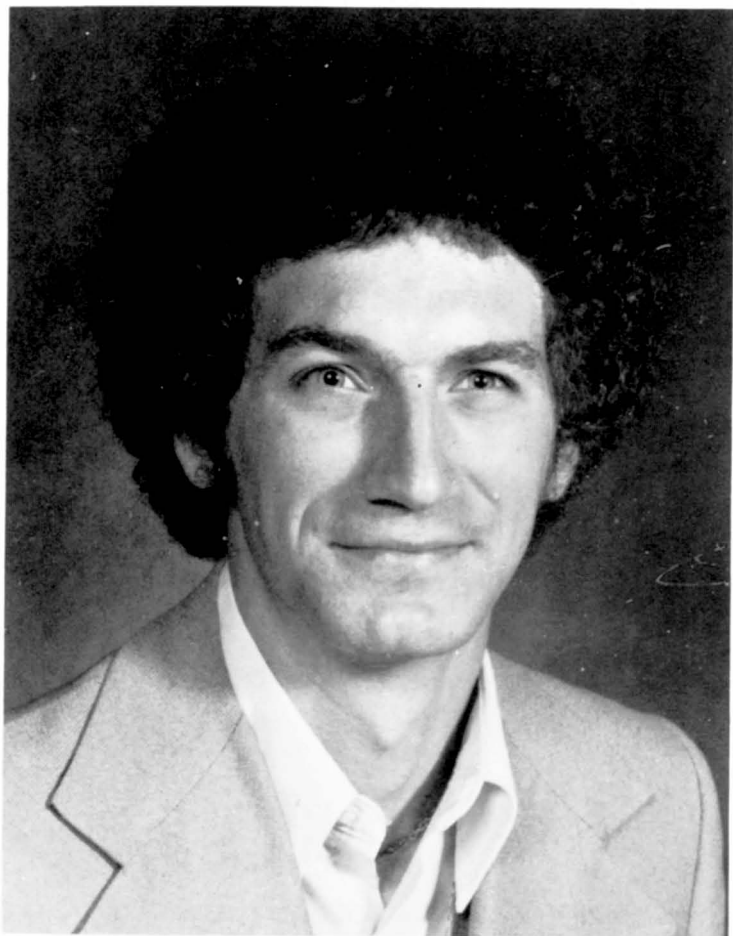
SOUTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL COACHES ASSOCIATION

Lowell Gilbertson has led the girls cross country team of Arlington to two state championships and a runner-up finish in the past three years. During that time the Cardinals have compiled a 24-3 record and have won three consecutive conference and regional titles.

Gilbertson is a native of Erwin and a graduate of Dakota State College. In addition to his coaching duties at Arlington he also serves as the Athletic Director and Principal.

Fred Tibbetts coached the Jefferson Hawkettes to the 1978 State "B" Championship. During his seven years of coaching at Jefferson he has compiled a record of 122-11. The Hawkettes had previously captured a state championship and had finished in the runner-up position once.

Tibbetts graduated from DeSmet High School and Dakota State College and credits much of his success to "the good athletes and the good program at the Jefferson school".

The eleventh year of coaching wrestling at the Vermillion schools was a rewarding one for Gerald Schlekeway, as he led the Tanagers to the State "A" Championship. The Tanagers also had two individual champions as they assaulted the Vermillion wrestling record book. The team did not lose a dual meet or tournament throughout the season, and team members won 73% of individual matches.

Schlekeway is a Britton native and graduated from Northern State College. In eleven years his Vermillion teams compiled a 91-41-2 record.

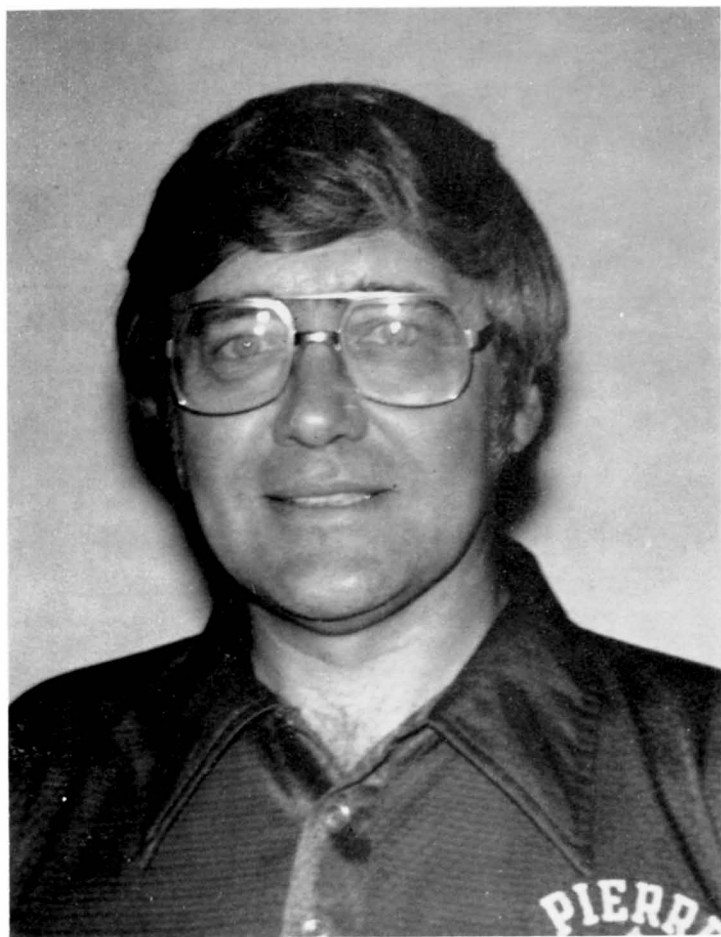
SOUTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL COACHES ASSOCIATION

Hanson is a graduate of Webster High School and Northern State College.

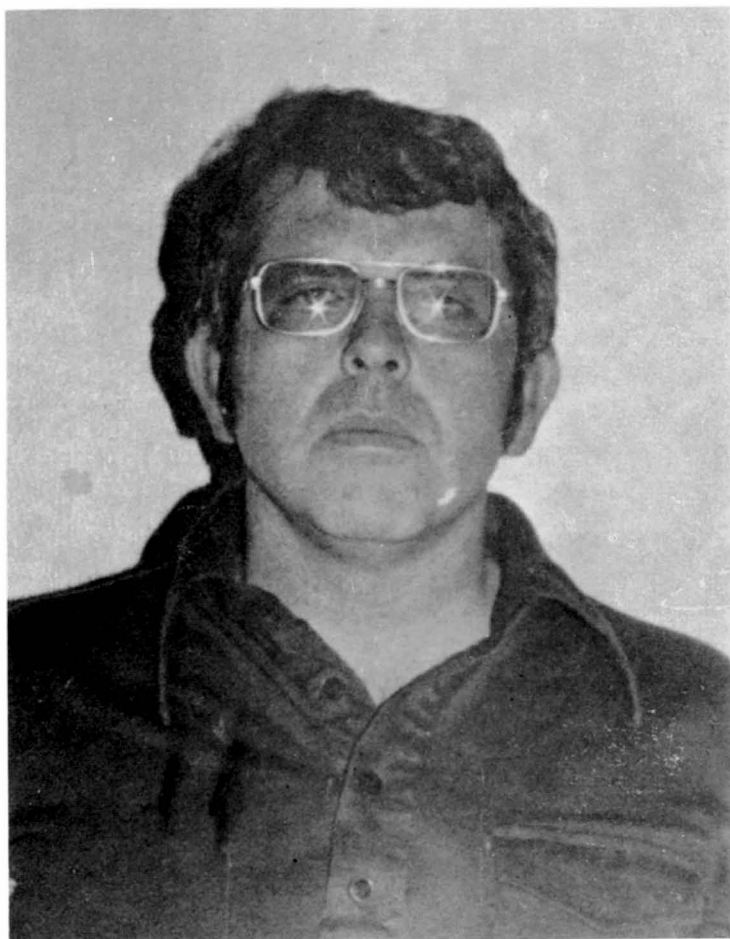
SOUTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL COACHES ASSOCIATION

Pries was also honored as the Coach of the Year in 1971, and calls the award "an honor you really appreciate because the coaches throughout the state vote for the winner.

Diede is a graduate of Scotland High School and the University of South Dakota/Springfield. In addition to his track duties Diede has been involved as a coach of football, basketball, and wrestling and serves as the Athletic Director at Freeman.

Given for outstanding contributions to high school athletics and dedication to the highest and best in high school athletics.

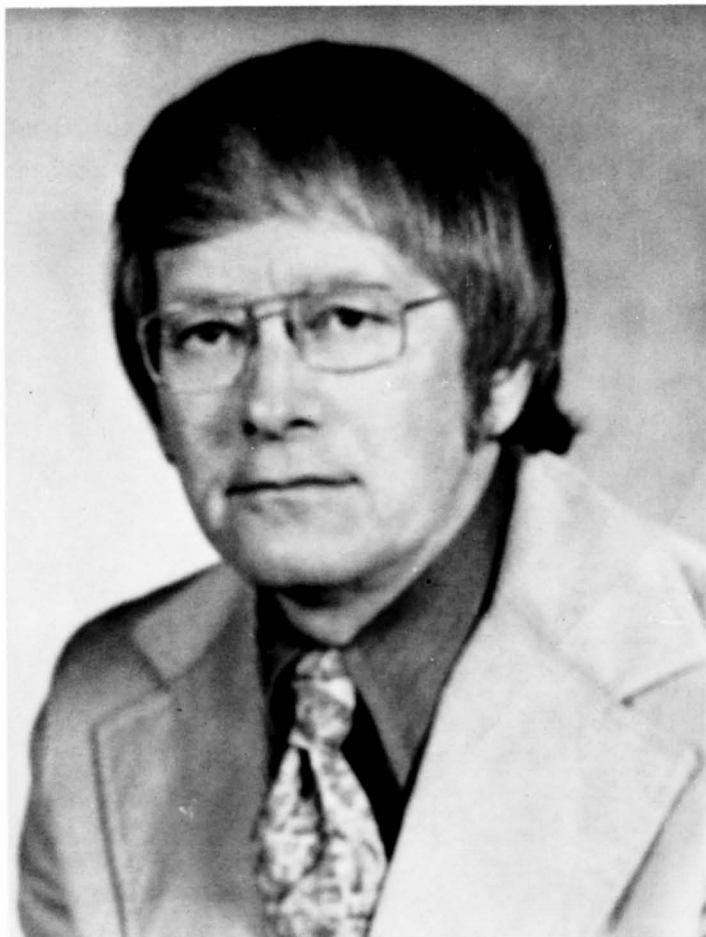

NORM HILSON



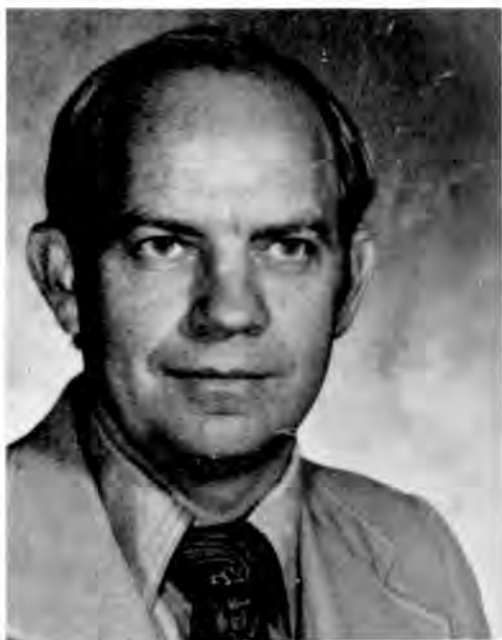
