Dallas-Fort Worth continues to draw Fortune and Global 500 headquarters by growth and expansion of local companies as well as by relocations of headquarter operations. Similarly, DFW and Beijing are the only two metros to host three Global 20 companies.

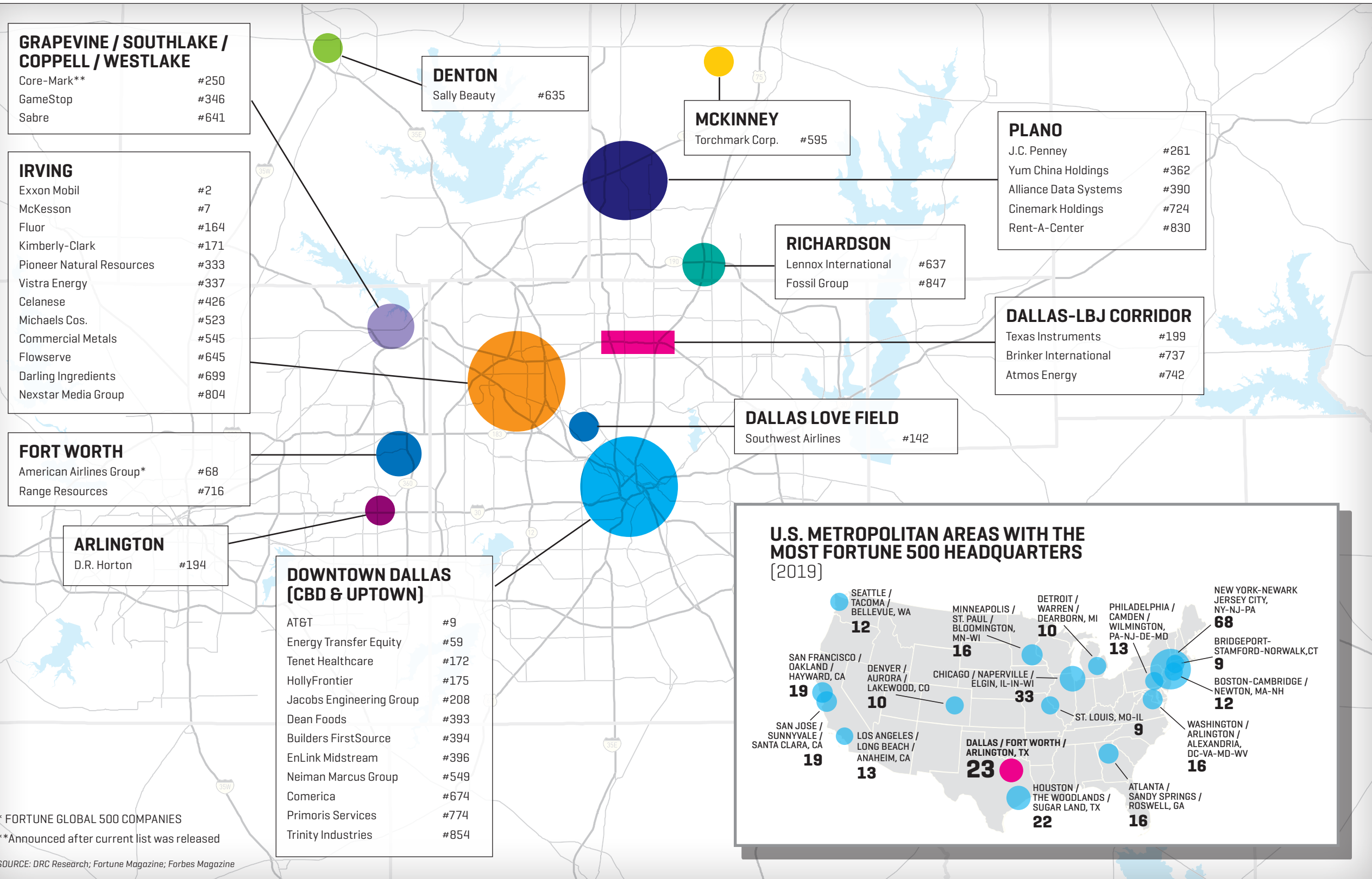
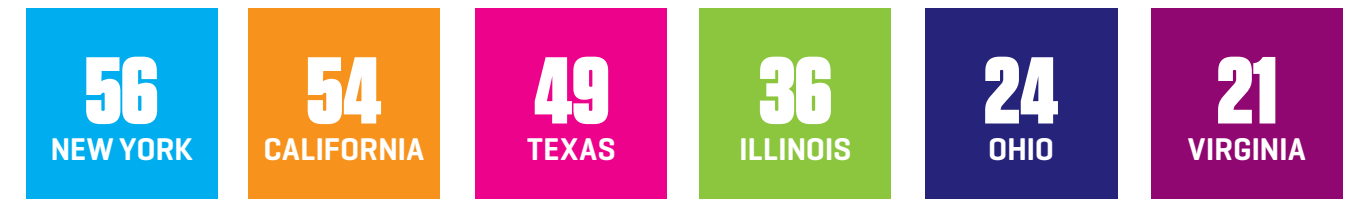
