According to Forbes, they received three types of answers: some try to inflate their wealth, others collaborate but omit details, and some refuse to answer any questions. Interviews are carried out to verify data and improve the estimate of an individual's companies. Finally, positions in stock market securities are listed on the market at a date of about a month before publication. The known debt is subtracted from the activities to obtain a final estimate of the estimated value of an individual in US dollars. Since the prices of the shares quickly fluctuate, the true wealth and the position of an individual at the time of may vary from its situation at the time of compilation of the list[6]. Family fortunes spread over a large number of relatives are included only if the properties of these individuals are worth more than a billion dollars. Dollars.where a living individual has lost his or her assets among the immediate family members, it shall be included in a single list, provided that the individual is still alive[6]. Royal families and dictators whose wealth depends on a position are always excluded from these lists[8]. Annual rankings are published every year in March, so the net worth listed are snapshots taken at that time. These lists show only the top 10 richest billionaires for each year. This included 195 new arrivals, of which 76 were Chinese and 25 from the United States; 56 under 40 and a record of 227 women[14]. The number of billionaires increased by 13% from 1,810 in 2016 to 2,043; this was the largest change in over 30 years of monitoring billionaires globally.[5] Overall, the wealth of billionaires increased by 13% in 2016 to 2,043; total of 2017 billion in 2015.[5][15] He wasn't in the top five. Amancio Ortega climbed from number four to second place last year.[17] Warren Buffett of Berkshire Hathaway was third for the second time in a row,[18] while Mexican telecom magnate Carlos Slim slipped from second place last year to fourth. Jeff Bezos of Amazon,[19] Mark Zuckerberg of Facebook[20] and Michael Bloomberg of Bloomberg L.P., [21] appeared for the first time in the Forbes Top 10 Billionaire this year at the age of 31. Larry Ellison, Charles Koch and David Koch also slipped from the previous year's positions, with Ellison dropping to seventh from fifth, and Koch dropping to ninth from sixth. America's Evan Spiegel, co-founder of Photo Messaging App Snapchat, became the youngest billionaire this year at the age of 24. A total of 1,011 people made the 2010 list. The United States had 403 billionaires, followed by China with 89 billionaires and Russia with 62.[37] This was the first time that China, including Finland and Pakistan, which claimed their first billionaires[37]. However, once the dotcom bubble broke out the new rich saw their fortunes disappear. [48] Billionaires' fortunes have been struck even harder by the global financial markets and global economic recovery have erased financial asset losses.
