

Words With Multiple Definitions

When you open a dictionary, the words in bold are called entry words.

You will also see a definition for the entry word. Some words have more than one definition. Sometimes you will also see the word used in a sentence.

horn [hörn] *n.* **1** A hard pointed growth on the head of some animals. Buffalo, goats, and rhinoceroses have horns. **2** A brass musical instrument. Horns have a narrow end that you blow into to play them. **3** A device used to make a warning signal. The bus driver honked the *horn* at the children in the street.

cab-in [kab'in] *n.* **1** A small, simple house. Cabins are often built of rough boards or logs. Our family rented a *cabin* on the lake. **2** A private room on a ship. They were seasick and spent the trip across the ocean in their *cabin*. **3** A place in an aircraft for passengers, crew members, or cargo.

foot-ball [foot'ból'] *n.* **1** A game played by two teams of eleven players each on a large field with goals at each end. Each team tries to make points by carrying or kicking the ball across the other team's goal. **2** The leather ball used in this game.

ruby [rōō'bē] **1** *n.* A clear, red precious stone. **2** *adj.* Having a deep red color.
