


Join a Global Network

How to Apply

Your application to our Online MS in Finance program must include the following:

- □ Essay/personal statement
- Resumé
- □ Two letters of professional recommendation
- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended
- □ Application fee

PREREQUISITES:

- Undergraduate degree from an accredited institution of higher learning
- GPA of 3.0 or higher on a scale of 4.0
- Currently employed with five years of demonstrated leadership experience in a work or professional setting
- English proficiency, both written and verbal, is necessary for success in D'Amore-McKim classrooms. If you are not a native English speaker, we require a standardized test of English language proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo, or PTE Academic scores) unless you completed a bachelor's or master's degree at an accredited institution where English is the language of instruction, or you have worked full time for two years in the United States or other native Englishspeaking environment

*Applications are reviewed holistically, and the admissions committee considers a wide variety of application criteria. Factors that may strengthen your application include STEM-designated and business degrees, professional designations, certifications, or an optional GMAT score. If you do not meet a minimum requirement listed above, you are still encouraged to apply.
