# **2-Sided Printing**

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### **Automatic 2-Sided Printing**

Your printer must be an 8400BD, 8400DP or 8400DX configuration to perform automatic 2sided printing. The 8400B and 8400N configurations may be upgraded to include this feature.

### Guidelines

To print a 2-sided document, verify that you are using the following ranges:

Weight/Size	Tray
Plain paper, Legal, Executive, Statement, US Folio, B5 ISO, B5 JIS 60–122 g/m <sup>2</sup> (16–32 lb. Bond)	All Trays
Glossy Coated Paper 148 g/m <sup>2</sup> (100 lb. Text)	All Trays
Postcards 176 g/m <sup>2</sup> (65 lb. Cover)	All Trays
Trifold Brochures 176 g/m <sup>2</sup> (65 lb. Cover)	Tray 1
Weatherproof Paper 100 g/m <sup>2</sup> (27 lb. Bond)	All Trays
Custom size Maximum: 216 mm wide x 355 mm long (8.5 in. wide x 14 in. long) Minimum: 139.7 mm wide x 210 mm long (5.5 in. wide x 8.3 in. long)	Tray 1

## **Binding Preferences**

Use the printer driver to select **Portrait** or **Landscape** orientation for the images on the page. When you print 2-sided jobs, select the binding preference which determines how the pages turn.



To perform automatic 2-sided printing:

- **1.** Insert paper into the tray. For more information, go to Reference/Printing/Basic Printing on the *User Documentation CD-ROM*.
  - **Tray 1**: Insert the side to be printed first **faceup** with the **bottom** of the page against the rollers.
  - **Trays 2, 3, or 4**: Insert the side to be printed first **facedown** with the **top** of the page toward the **back** of the tray.
- **2.** In the printer driver:
  - Select **Tray 1, 2, 3, or 4**.
  - Select either **Portrait** or **Landscape** orientation.
  - Select **2-sided printing** as described in the table below.
- 3. Click **OK** to accept the printer driver settings, then click **OK** to print.
