# **Action Verbs & Adverbs**

Action verbs and adverbs are a good way to describe transferable skills that you have developed. Transferable skills can transfer from position and/or career to another. This list is intended to be a starting point and is not a complete listing of verbs or skills.

NOTE: Pay attention to verb tense! If describing <u>current</u> employment, use <u>present</u> tense!
