GPA Calculation Chart

To determine a Grade Point Average (GPA), we must be able to reference the following information about each course attempted:

- 1. Grade Symbol (i.e., A-, B, C+, WU)
- 2. Grade Symbol Value (i.e., A=4, B=3, C+=2.3)
- 3. Unit Value (i.e., 3 unit course, 1 unit course)

Refer to the chart below to find the **Grade Symbol** earned for each of your courses. Take a look at your Unofficial transcript to determine the **Units** for each of the courses. Match the Grade Symbol with the course Units in the chart to find the correct Grade Points.

Example:							
How many Grade Points has a student earned if they receive a B- in a 3 unit course?							
Grade Symbol = B - Grade Symbol Value = 2.7 Course Units = 3							
Grade Symbol Value 2.7 X Course Units 3 = Grade Points 8.1
