About the position

One to two permanent 100 % positions as Professor/Associate Professor in Entrepreneurship are available at the School of Business and Law, University of Agder, Norway. The positions are located at the Department of Management at Campus Kristiansand.

Responsibilities

The School of Business and Law seeks applicants who will contribute to a new and innovative master program in entrepreneurship. The program will be a so-called venture creation program aimed at delivering state-of-the-art entrepreneurship education while enabling students to actually start businesses in parallel with the academic experience.
