
### **Detailed Methodology**

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the <u>International Republican Institute</u>'s <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u> by Norstat Eesti AS.
- Data was collected between January 10 and February 2, 2020 through face-to-face interviews at respondents' homes.
- The sample comprised of 1,010 residents of Latvia, aged 18 and older. The sample is representative of the adult population of Latvia by NUTS-3 region (Statistikie reģioni/regions) and urbanicity in accordance with the 2011 Census of Latvia.
- The survey's response rate was 52 percent. The margin of error for the full sample is ±3.1 points at the 95 percent confidence level.
- A multistage probability sampling method was used, employing a random route method for household selection and the Kish grid for respondent selection.
  - Stage 1: PPS stratification across six NUTS-3 regions.
  - Stage 2: PPS stratification by urbanicity.
  - Stage 3: Random allocation of primary sampling units across settlements.
- The sample is weighted for region, urbanicity, gender, age, nationality, and educational attainment level based on the results of the 2011 Census.
- Interviews were conducted in Latvian and Russian.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- Cited bases are weighted.



## In general, would you say that Latvia is headed in the right direction or in the wrong direction?




### What is the most important problem facing our country today? (Spontaneous answers)





How about at the European level? What is the biggest single problem facing Europe today, the one that you are most concerned about? (Spontaneous answers)




### How would you describe the current economic situation of your household?




### How likely or unlikely are ordinary people able to influence decisions made in Latvia?




How important or unimportant is it that all members of our country's adult population, including women, young adults, minorities, and people with disabilities, are included in political decision-making?



## Do you think that today's generation of young people has a good future in Latvia or not?




### Did you vote in the Latvian parliamentary elections in 2018?




#### For which party did you vote?




### If parliamentary elections were held this Sunday, how likely would you be to vote in this election?



## If the following parties/coalitions would run candidates in these elections, for which party would you vote?





## Do you believe that democracy is the best possible form of government for Latvia or not?




Some people argue that the party choices in our country's politics are too limited and that new political forces should provide other alternatives in future elections. To what extent do you agree or disagree with this statement?









### From which source do you get most of your daily social and political news?



#### How reliable or unreliable do you find the following sources of news:






### If so, can you name some sources of news you use in Russian? (Up to 3 answers)




### Do you access news in any other languages?




### If so, can you name some sources of news you use in other languages? (Up to 3 answers)



### Do you support or oppose blocking television and radio broadcasts from the Russian Federation into Latvia?




## How much do you trust or distrust the national media's accuracy in its coverage of the following topics?








### And, for each of these aspects, would you like it to have more in common with Western Europe or Russia?




# Vladimir Putin's Russia has tried to portray itself as a defender of Christendom and traditional European values. What is your opinion of this view of Russia?





# Which of the following statements comes closest to your view of Russia and Putin as you consider these changes in European culture?



### What should be the role of the Russian language in Latvia today?




### Do you think Russian language is a basis of discrimination in Latvia?








# How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statement? Latvia's interests are best served by maintaining strong relations with:




### Why do you think our country's interests are best served by maintaining strong relations with Russia?




### In your opinion, what has the European Union's impact on the following issues been?






### In your opinion, what is the biggest security threat facing our country today?




#### What is your personal view of NATO?




# Regardless of your view on NATO as an organization, which statement comes closest to your feelings about foreign NATO troops being stationed in Latvia?




### Which statement comes closest to your opinion about NATO military exercises in the region?




## Which statement comes closest to your opinion about why Germany should not increase its defense spending to 2 percent?


