ACHES Pill Warning Signs





ABDOMINAL PAIN

- Blood clot in the pelvis or liver [mesenteric or pelvic vein thrombosis]
- Vomiting
- Cramping
- Weakness

CHEST PAIN

- Blood clot in the lung or heart vessels [pulmonary embolism or myocardial infarction]
- Heart attack, angina
- Chest or heart pain, left arm and shoulder pain
- Coughing and shortness of breath

HEADACHES

- Stroke
- Blurred vision, spots, zigzag lines, weakness, difficulty speaking
- Sudden intellectual impairment

EYE PROBLEMS

- Stroke or retinal vein thrombosis
- Complete or partial loss of vision



SEVERE LEG PAIN

- Inflammation and blood clots of a leg in the leg [thrombophlebitis]
- Swelling, heat or redness, tenderness in leg
