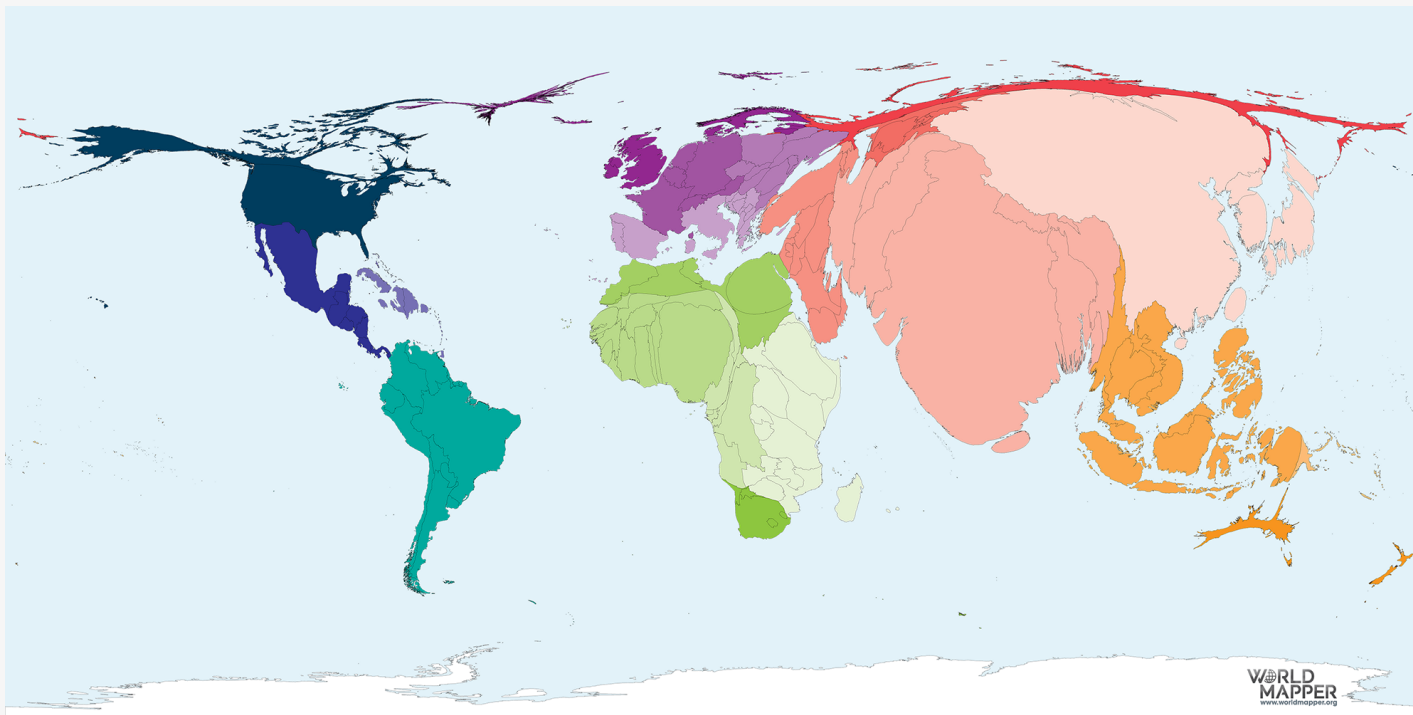


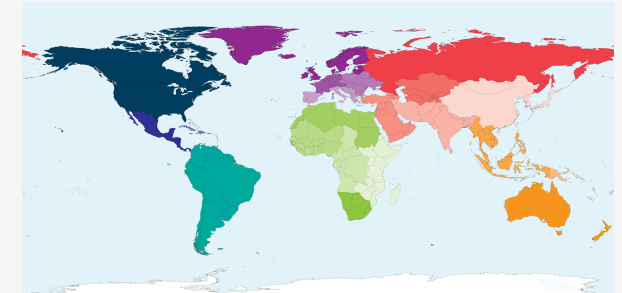

In 2011 world population estimates reached 7 billion; that is 7 thousand million. In 2018 it was estimated to have reached 7.6 billion. The distribution of the earth's population in 2018 is shown in this map.

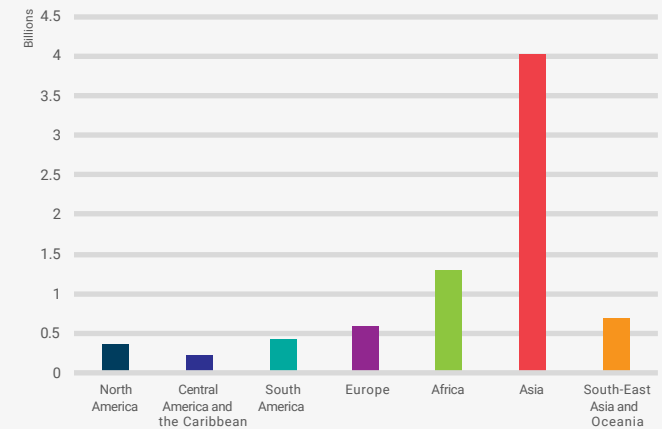
India and China appear large on the map because they have large populations. Large countries by area in contrast, such as Russia or Canada, appear much smaller due to their small populations.
