### Disclaimer

- While we have made every effort to be accurate in this guide, financial aid programs change. Be sure to get current information.
- This guide is intended for foster youth in California who qualify for "Independent Status" on the FAFSA, because they have been in foster care on or after their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday or have a legal guardian. If you do not qualify for "Independent Status" we recommend you seek additional support and guidance in completing the Parental Demographics and Financial Information Section.
- If you are an undocumented student, remember to fill out the CA Dream Act Application (CADAA) at <u>www.dream.csac.ca.gov</u> instead of the FAFSA. If you are a CA undocumented student, you should apply even if you were a DACA recipient and granted a temporary social security number. Most of the questions in the CADAA mirror the questions in the FAFSA; this guide can still be a helpful tool.

- A driver's license and telephone number are not required to complete the application.
- Your legal status is "single" if you are not married, even if you live with or have a boyfriend, girlfriend or significant other.

If you are convicted of possessing or selling drugs after you submit your FAFSA, you must notify the financial aid administrator at your college immediately. You will lose your eligibility for federal student aid and will be required to pay back all aid you received after your conviction.



Free Application

- Are you interested in being considered for workstudy? Work study allows students with financial need to earn a portion of their financial aid award money through part-time employment on or offcampus. You can decline it later if you change your mind.
- You will be asked: "Are you a foster youth or were you at any time in the foster care system?"  $\rightarrow$  Answering yes may give you access to more support to help you in school. Answer YES to this question, even if you were only in foster care one day.
- Foster youth can select "Other/unknown" for "Highest School Completed by Parent."  $\rightarrow$  Parent does not refer to a legal guardian or foster parent.
  - $\rightarrow$  How you answer does not affect your eligibility for federal student aid.
