The garden beautifully reflects the seasons with brilliant <u>autumn colors</u> during November and vibrant greens in spring. There is also a teahouse where <u>green tea</u> is served for a small fee.

Besides the moss garden, the museum grounds additionally feature a Japanese <u>landscape</u> garden, the **Sekirakuen Garden**, which is open only on weekends, national holidays and everyday during the month of November. The garden spreads over the slopes of Gora, featuring large decorative stones, a mountain stream and views over the valley and mountains.

Dinner in Pontocho

Pontocho (先斗町, Pontochō) is one of <u>Kyoto</u>'s most atmospheric dining areas. It is a narrow alley running from Shijo-dori to Sanjo-dori, one block west of Kamogawa River. The alley is packed with restaurants on both sides offering a wide range of dining options from inexpensive <u>yakitori</u> to traditional and modern <u>Kyoto cuisine</u>, foreign cuisine and highly exclusive establishments that require the right connections and a fat wallet.

Business hours and closing days of the restaurants, bars and shops along Pontocho vary by establishment, but most places are usually open from around 17:00 to 23:00. Some also open for lunch. An increasing number of establishments offer English menus.

Most of the restaurants along the eastern side of the alley overlook Kamogawa River. From May to September, many of them build temporary platforms over the flowing water where patrons can dine out in the open air. Known as kawayuka, this type of dining was developed as a way to beat the summer heat and is a great way to try some traditional Kyoto cuisine while taking in the cooling effects of the flowing water and the lively summer atmosphere. Advance reservations for kawayuka are recommended especially on Fridays and Saturdays.

Himeji Castle

Himeji (姫路) is most famous for its magnificent castle, <u>Himeji Castle</u>, widely considered to be Japan's most beautiful surviving feudal <u>castle</u>. The castle is designated both a national treasure and a <u>UNESCO world heritage site</u>.

With half a million inhabitants, Himeji is the second largest city of <u>Hyogo Prefecture</u> after <u>Kobe</u>. It can be reached in less than one hour from <u>Osaka</u> or <u>Kyoto</u> and is also a popular stopover on journeys along the <u>Sanyo Shinkansen</u>.

Miyajima is a small island less than an hour outside the city of <u>Hiroshima</u>. It is most famous for its giant <u>torii gate</u>, which at high tide seems to float on the water. The sight is ranked as one of Japan's<u>three best views</u>.

While officially named Itsukushima, the island is more commonly referred to as Miyajima, <u>Japanese</u> for "shrine island". This is because the island is so closely related to its key shrine, <u>Itsukushima Shrine</u>, in the public's mind. Like the torii gate, the shrine's main buildings are built over water. Miyajima is a romantic place, best enjoyed by staying overnight at one of the island's <u>ryokan</u>. While there are usually many day tourists, in the evening the area becomes much quieter and more peaceful. There are also wild deer on the island that have become accustomed to people. In the day the deer wander around the same sites as the tourists, and in the evening they sleep along the<u>walking paths</u>.

Mount Misen Ropeway

The ropeway station is a ten minute walk inland from <u>Itsukushima Shrine</u> or a 20 minute walk from the Miyajima ferry pier. The ride up the mountain takes about 20 minutes and requires a transfer of ropeways along the way.

From the ropeway's upper station at Shishi-iwa Observatory, it is still about a 30 minute walk up to the summit along a rather steep hiking trail. The Misen Hondo and Reikado buildings are located along the trail, about five minutes before the summit.

Explore Hiroshima Downtown

<u>Hiroshima</u> has a bustling downtown area, the main feature of which is Hondori Street. Hondori is a pedestrian arcade that is closed to traffic and lined with shops and restaurants. It starts near the <u>Peace Park</u> and stretches east about half a kilometer. Running parallel to Hondori is Aioidori (Aioi Street), the main street used by cars and trams. Along Aioi Street stand a few large <u>department stores</u> where more shopping can be found.

While in the downtown area, visitors to Hiroshima may want to take the opportunity to try one of Hiroshima's specialties: Hiroshima Style Okonomiyaki. Many restaurants along both Hondori and Aioi streets offer the local specialty, but the surest place to find it is in Okonomimura.

Usually translated as Okonomiyaki Village, Okonomimura is a small area just south of the eastern end of Hondori. As its name implies, it is devoted to <u>okonomiyaki</u>. Okonomimura has many different restaurants to choose from, and is a convenient place in the downtown area to take a break and grab a bite.

Kenrokuen (兼六園) in <u>Kanazawa</u> is justifiably classified as one of Japan's "three most beautiful landscape <u>gardens</u>" alongside Mito's <u>Kairakuen</u> and <u>Okayama</u>'s <u>Korakuen</u>. The spacious grounds used to be the outer garden of <u>Kanazawa Castle</u> and were constructed by the ruling Maeda family over a period of nearly two centuries. Opened to the public in 1871, Kenrokuen features a variety of flowering trees which provide the garden with a different look for each season.
