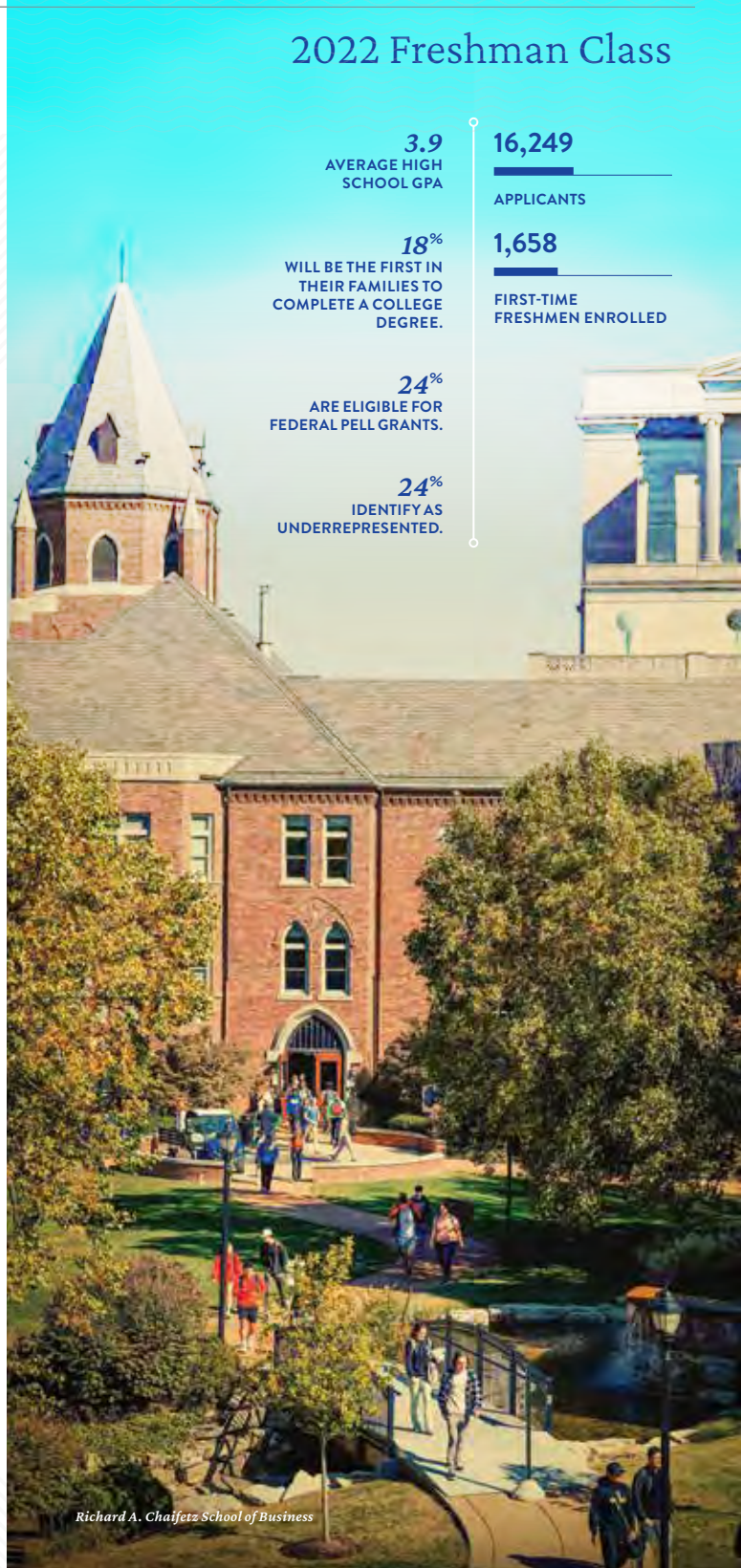

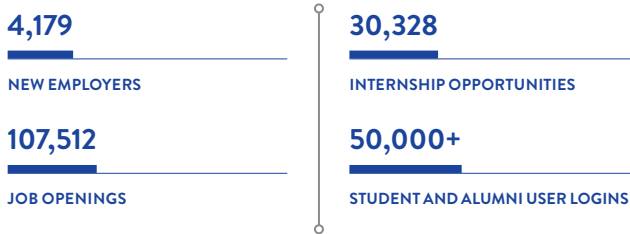

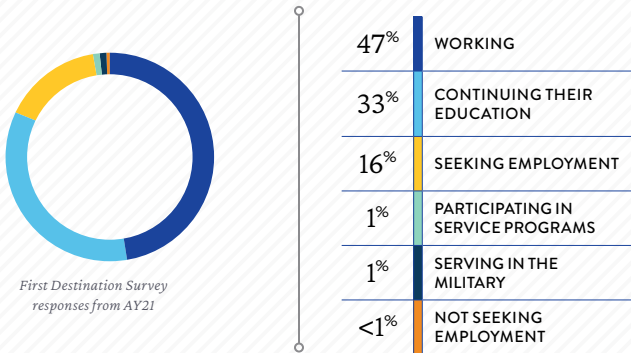

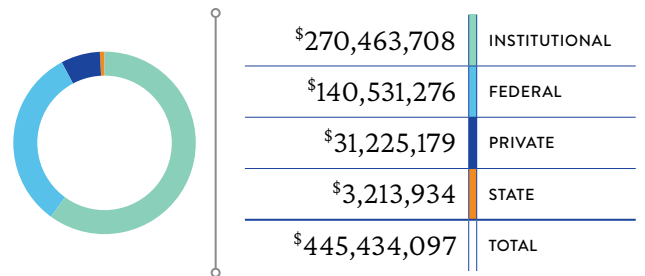
Student Financial Support

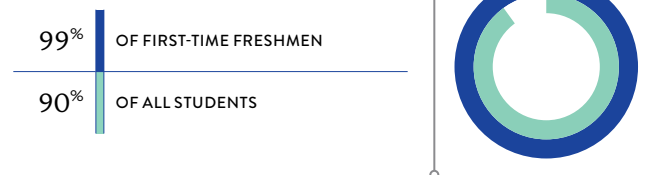

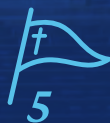

SLU LEADS IN GEOSPATIAL RESEARCH

The new Taylor Geospatial Institute connects SLU with seven institutions to build on St. Louis' geospatial assets and position the region as the global center of innovation, impact and excellence. The University also partnered with the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency to host the fourth annual Geo-Resolution Conference.

VACCINE RESEARCH

SLU's Center for Vaccine Development is testing the safety, tolerability and immune response to investigational second-generation COVID-19 vaccines. This is the latest in a series of COVID-19 vaccine research at SLU.

At SLU's School of Medicine, researchers reported the first effective drug to treat a rare, genetic liver disease that formerly could only be treated with a liver transplant. This breakthrough is the culmination of over a decade of work to cure this disease.

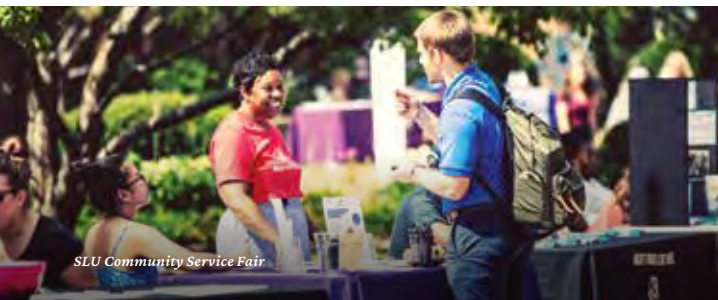

WHAT'S A BILLIKEN?

The Billiken is a mythical good-luck figure who represents “things as they ought to be.” Before he was Saint Louis University’s mascot, he was a national sensation. In 1908, art teacher Florence Pretz received a patent for her version of

the mythical figure. Later, the Billiken Co. of Chicago adopted the likeness, giving the Billiken its name and manufacturing Billiken statuettes.

In 1910, local sportswriters thought SLU football coach John Bender bore a striking resemblance to the impish creature, and SLU’s football team was dubbed “Bender’s Billikens.” The public took up the moniker, and it became the official nickname of all SLU teams.

BRAND-NEW, BEST-IN-CLASS FACILITIES

The **O’Loughlin Family Champions Center**, to open in 2023, will offer student-athletes support with academic and career advising, spiritual development, sports performance, nutrition, wellness and sports psychology.

The **Billiken Soccer Legacy Center**, a 5,000-square-foot locker room and athletic training center for the men’s and women’s teams, opened in 2022.

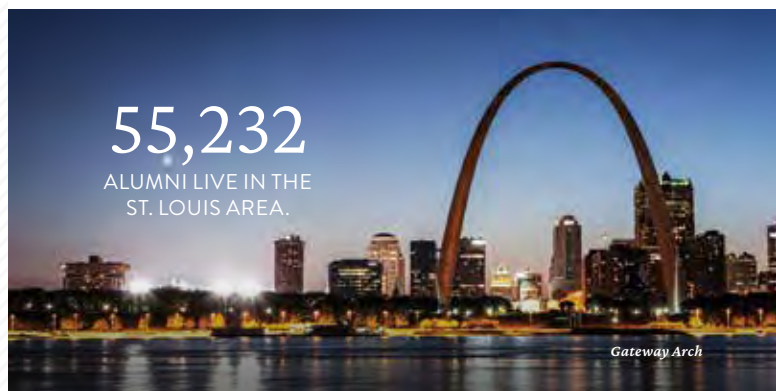

A BRIEF HISTORY OF SLU

- 1818** — SLU (then Saint Louis Academy) became the *first institution of higher learning* west of the Mississippi River.
- 1829** — The *Society of Jesus* assumed control of the college.
- 1832** — The college, now Saint Louis University, received a *formal charter* from the state of Missouri.
- 1888** — The University moved from downtown to its present *Midtown St. Louis* site.
- 1967** — SLU established a campus in *Madrid, Spain*.
- 2018** — Saint Louis University marked its bicentennial, *celebrating 200 years* of academic excellence and service to the community.
