Developmental Disabilities Services (DDS) offers a wide array of community services for individuals with developmental disabilities and their families. Services are individualized to meet each person's needs. DDSD services are funded through Medicaid Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Waivers and through State funds and are provided to individuals from age 3 throughout the lifespan.
