What Trading View is



TradingView (est. 2012) is a world leading, cutting-edge FREE online visualisation financial charting platform for beginners up to the most advanced professional traders, with over 10 million subscribers.

The platform has direct access to unlimited live streaming data from stocks, futures, bonds, indices, Forex, commodities, ETFs and even crypto-currencies.

It allows you to customise your watch lists, back test your strategies, share, publish or enjoy live and active trading ideas, signals and tutorials through the platform or directly to your Twitter and Stock Twits feed.

With Trading View you'll be able to enjoy this free charting phenomena across either your web browser, Android or Apple iOS devices.



The Downside



It's important to note that *TradingView* is not integrated with most brokers. This means you'll need to have two platforms at all times to place a trade.

However, this might change in the near future as *TradingView* is already associated with some of the world's leading brokers such as, Oanda and FXCM.

Start to chart, learn and share trading ideas

TradingView has been in the making for the last 20 years, and so you'll find that it offers more services than what is mentioned in this short guide.

When you go to their website, you'll see a whole range of trading realtime data, information, analyses tutorials coming from both professional, corporate as well as trading individuals...

Here's what you'll see as when you enter their website.





1. Tickers:

Real-time – Market prices and percentage changes.

2. **Home**:

Click here to go back to the homepage.

3. What's New?:

To update you on any developments & messages.

4. Language:

Choose your preferred language.

5. Search:

Look up markets, ideas or people i.e. TimonRosso

6. Profile:

Update or see your profile, account or settings.



7. Watchlist:

View ideas, info and customise your watchlist.

8. Alerts:

Update your trade alerts or go to your chart to create one.

9. Hotlists:

See what markets are hot and trending.

10. Calendar:

View the economic, financial and earnings calendar.

11. My Ideas:

See or update your trading ideas you've posted on the forum.

12. Public Chats:

Read and enjoy what trade ideas & signals the community has to share.

13. Private Chats:

Chat about trading with any member in private.

14. Ideas Streams:

Gain new trading ideas, info or signals from other members.

15. Notifications:

See engagement on your posts from others i.e. Likes & Comments.

16. Ideas:

Find trade ideas on markets, members, indicators or risk management.

17. Markets:

Look up a quick review on different real-time asset classes.

18. Scripts:

Look up information on indicators, oscillators & trend analysis.



19. Screener:

Find all your markets and fundamental data here.

When you click on the 'Chart' tab in the website, or when you click on the app on your Android or Apple device, you'll gain instant access to the best charts, trading tools and social networking all in one.

Charting Platform

Top Toolbar



#1: Search bar

Type and search the market you're looking for:

(Stock, Futures, Forex, CFD, Cryptocurrency, Index & Economy)



#2: Time frame

To view the overall market over different time periods



NOTE:

Click on the star on the right next to your favourite time frames to be added to the top for quick and easy access.


#3: Chart type

Choose your ideal chart type



#4: Compare

Compare and overlay any market on another market



#5: Indicators

Choose or type your preferred indicator, band or oscillator to add to the chart



#6: Financials

Here you'll find real-time market fundamentals information




#7: Templates

Customise and save your indicator template to suit your charting needs



#8: Alert

Create and modify your trading alerts on any market




NOTE:

You can also right-click on the chart area at the price you'd like to create your alert.

#9, #10, #11:

Change your settings, view full screen or screenshot your chart




NOTE:

To exit the full-screen mode – hit the Esc key.



#12: Publish

Publish a tutorial or a trading signal (long, short or neutral)



i. What type of post?

Choose whether to publish a chart analysis or a chart tutorial.

ii. Investment strategy

Pick whether the chart analysis is 'Long', 'Neutral' or 'Short'.

iii. Category

Choose up to three categories based on your analysis in the drop-down list.

iv. Tags

Tag a few key words to help others find your post.

v. Share

Post your analysis or tutorial on Twitter or StockTwits by ticking the boxes.

vi. Title

Give your post a strong title.

vii. Description

Give a bit more information about your analysis or tut.

viii. Publish Public Idea

Click here to publish your idea where the community will be notified.

NOTE:

With this social platform, you might make your name in the trading community where you get discovered by top trading firms.



Charting Platform Left Toolbar




Drawing and Annotation tools

Chart your analysis with ease

The left toolbar will give you the ability to personalise your charts.

It houses a whole bunch of drawing, analyses and annotation tools you can place on your chart window.



SHORTCUT NOTES:

Copy = Cntrl+C / Cmd+C

Paste = Cntrl+V / Cmd+V

Undo = Cntrl+Z / Cmd+Z

Duplicate = Hold Cntrl + Click item and drag down

Remove All = Right-Click on the main chart and choose Remove All

Indicators / Drawing Tools



Positions

Visualise your trading positions

This button allows you to visually place a Long Position, Short Position, Price range as well as calculate your risk-to-reward ratio simultaneously.

You'll save time as a trader, rather than having to use your calculator each time.

I've personally never seen this option available on any charting or trading platform other than with *TradingView*.

BottomToolbar



The bottom toolbar gives you access to mainly taking down notes, testing strategies, coding, paper trading and connecting to the brokers available.


#1: Stock Screener

Find the markets prices and fundamental data here




#2: Text notes

Jot down important notes with each chart




#3, #4: Pine Editor & Strategy Tester

Write your own code and test strategies built into the chart



#5: Trading Panel

Paper trade or connect to your broker's account



How to create a free TradingView account

Step #1:

Click here to get started

Step #2:

On the far top left corner, click the settings icon (Three lines)



Step #3:

Scroll down and click on 'Join Now'



Step #4:

Fill in your details in the new window and click 'Sign Up'

Step #5:


Check your email (junk folder) to verify account – Click Activate

Step #6:

Fill in your details in the new window and click 'Continue'

Done!

Click on the 'Chart' tab to start analysing and sharing your trade ideas



When you sign up for a FREE account, you'll have the following:

- Full access to all markets
- 3 Indicators per chart
- 1 Saved chart layout
- 1 Indicator on an indicator
- 1 enhanced watchlist

You will see an advert now and then, but they're not as intrusive as your local FB, YouTube or Instagram ads.
