


Advanced Placement: Student Participation

3.4% increase in the number of students participating between 2005 and 2006

In 2006: 1,799 South Dakota Public School Students took AP Exams In 2005: 1,740 South Dakota Public School Students took AP Exams In 2001: 1,343 South Dakota Public School Students took AP Exams In 1996: 571 South Dakota Public School Students took AP Exams

- Since 2001, the number of South Dakota Public School students participating in AP increased by 456 or 34.0%.
- In comparison, between 1996 and 2001, the number of South Dakota Public School students participating in AP increased by 772 or 135.2%.

Advanced Placement: Exams Taken


0.7% increase in the number of AP Exams taken between 2005 and 2006

In 2006: South Dakota Public School Students took 2,941 AP Exams In 2005: South Dakota Public School Students took 2,920 AP Exams

In 2001: South Dakota Public School Students took 1,996 AP Exams

In 1996: South Dakota Public School Students took 805 AP Exams

- Since 2001, the number of AP Exams taken by South Dakota Public School students increased by 945 or 47.3%.
- In comparison, between 1996 and 2001, the number of AP Exams taken by South Dakota Public School students increased by 1,191 or 148.0%.

South Dakota: AP Exams by Year




Advanced Placement: Exams Scored 3 or higher

0.8% decrease in the number of AP Exams scored 3 or higher between 2005 and 2006

In 2006: South Dakota Public School Students scored 3 or higher on 1,811 AP Exams In 2005: South Dakota Public School Students scored 3 or higher on 1,825 AP Exams In 2001: South Dakota Public School Students scored 3 or higher on 1,084 AP Exams In 1996: South Dakota Public School Students scored 3 or higher on 464 AP Exams

- Since 2001, the number of AP Exams scored 3 or higher taken by South Dakota Public School students increased by 727 or 67.1%.
- In comparison, between 1996 and 2001, the number of AP Exams scored 3 or higher taken by South Dakota Public School students increased by 620 or 133.6%.

South Dakota: AP Exams 3 or Higher by Year




Exams Taken by Low Income Students

- Since 2001, the number of AP Exams taken by Low Income South Dakota Public School students increased by 156 (to 167).
- In comparison, the number of AP Exams taken by Low Income South Dakota Public School students between 1996 and 2001 decreased by 33.*

Participation among Low Income Students

- Since 2001, the number of Low Income AP Public School students has increased by 91 (to 97).
- In comparison, the number of AP of Low Income AP Public School students between 1996 and 2001 decreased by 21.*

*Low income students are identified by exam fee waivers. Fee waivers are awarded for a variety of reasons, including financial need. Prior to 2002, fee waivers were not categorized by type (financial need or other) and all exams with fee waivers were regarded as having been taken by low income students. In 2002 and thereafter, only financially motivated fee waivers are used to identify exams taken by low income students.




Exams Taken by Black or African American Students:

- Since 2001, the number of AP Exams taken by Black or African American South Dakota Public School students has increased by 35 (to 39).
- In comparison, the number of AP Exams taken by Black or African American South Dakota Public School students between 1996 and 2001 increased by 3.

Participation among Black or African American Students:

- Since 2001, the number of Black or African American AP Public School students has increased by 15 (to 19).
- In comparison, the number of AP of Black or African American AP Public School students between 1996 and 2001 increased by 3.

South Dakota: AP Black or African American Students by Year




Exams Taken by Hispanic or Latino Students:

- Since 2001, the number of AP Exams taken by Hispanic or Latino South Dakota Public School students has increased by 26 (to 36).
- By contrast, the number of AP Exams taken by Hispanic or Latino South Dakota Public School students between 1996 and 2001 increased by 10.

Participation among Hispanic or Latino Students:

- Since 2001, the number of Hispanic or Latino AP Public School students increased by 10 (to 18).
- In comparison, the number of AP of Hispanic or Latino AP Public School students between 1996 and 2001 increased by 8.

South Dakota: AP Hispanic or Latino Students by Year




Cohort Data from the Public School Graduating Class of 2006**

AP Participation: The Graduating Class of 2006

- In South Dakota, 15.8% of the Public School graduating class of 2006 has taken an AP Exam at some point in their high school career: this compares to 24.2% for the Nation.
- In South Dakota, 9.2% of the Public School graduating class of 2006 took one or more English AP Exams: more than any other subject area.***



AP Performance: The Graduating Class of 2006

- In South Dakota, 9.4% of the Public School graduating class of 2006 scored 3 or higher on an AP Exam at some point in their high school career: this compares to 14.8% for the Nation.
- In South Dakota, 5.1% of the Public School graduating class of 2006 scored 3 or higher on one or more English AP Exams: more than any other subject area.***
