Waterpalooza

Get ready to make a splash during this wet and wild week of camp! Campers will enjoy various water activities such as water bucket relays, water balloons, water balloon toss, water tag and more. Each day campers will be introduced to a new water themed activity or game while also participating in traditional camp activities such as team building, character development, arts and crafts, and swimming. Campers will have fun all week in and out of the water. All swimming abilities are welcome. Campers should bring sunscreen, swim suit and towel each day of camp.

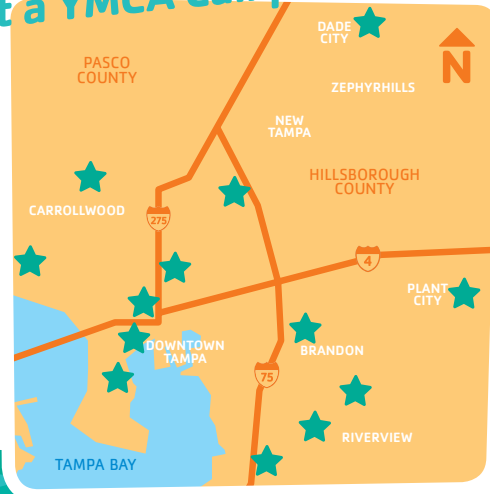
