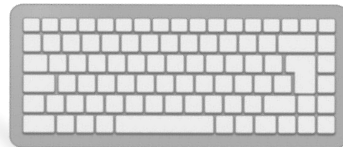

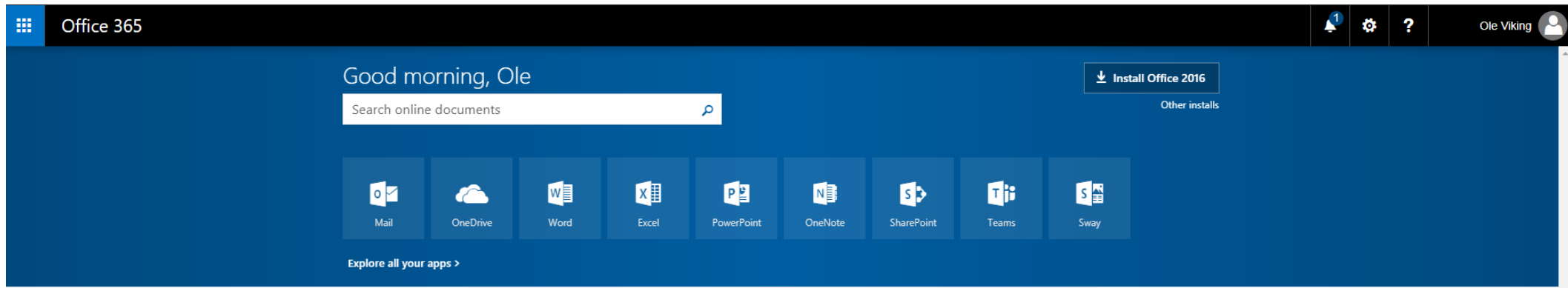

Editing online vs. in Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.



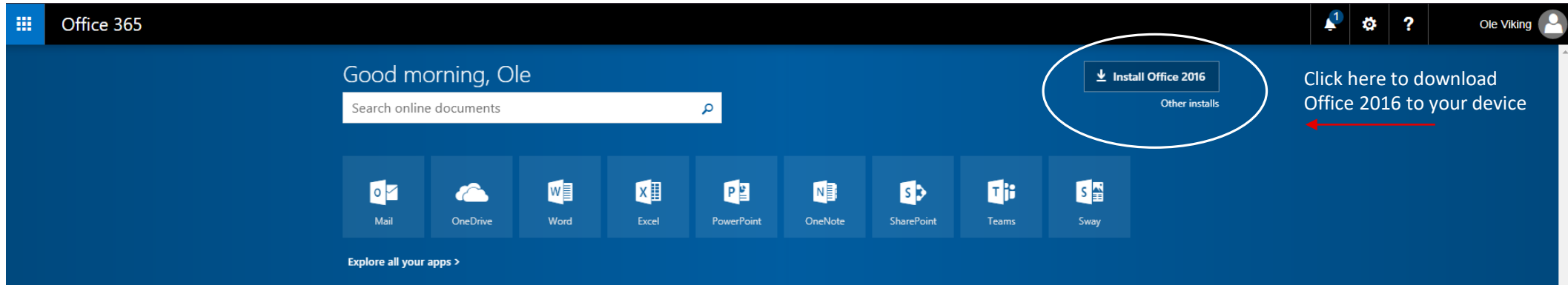
Use caution when saving your work. Be sure you are saving your files to the location intended
