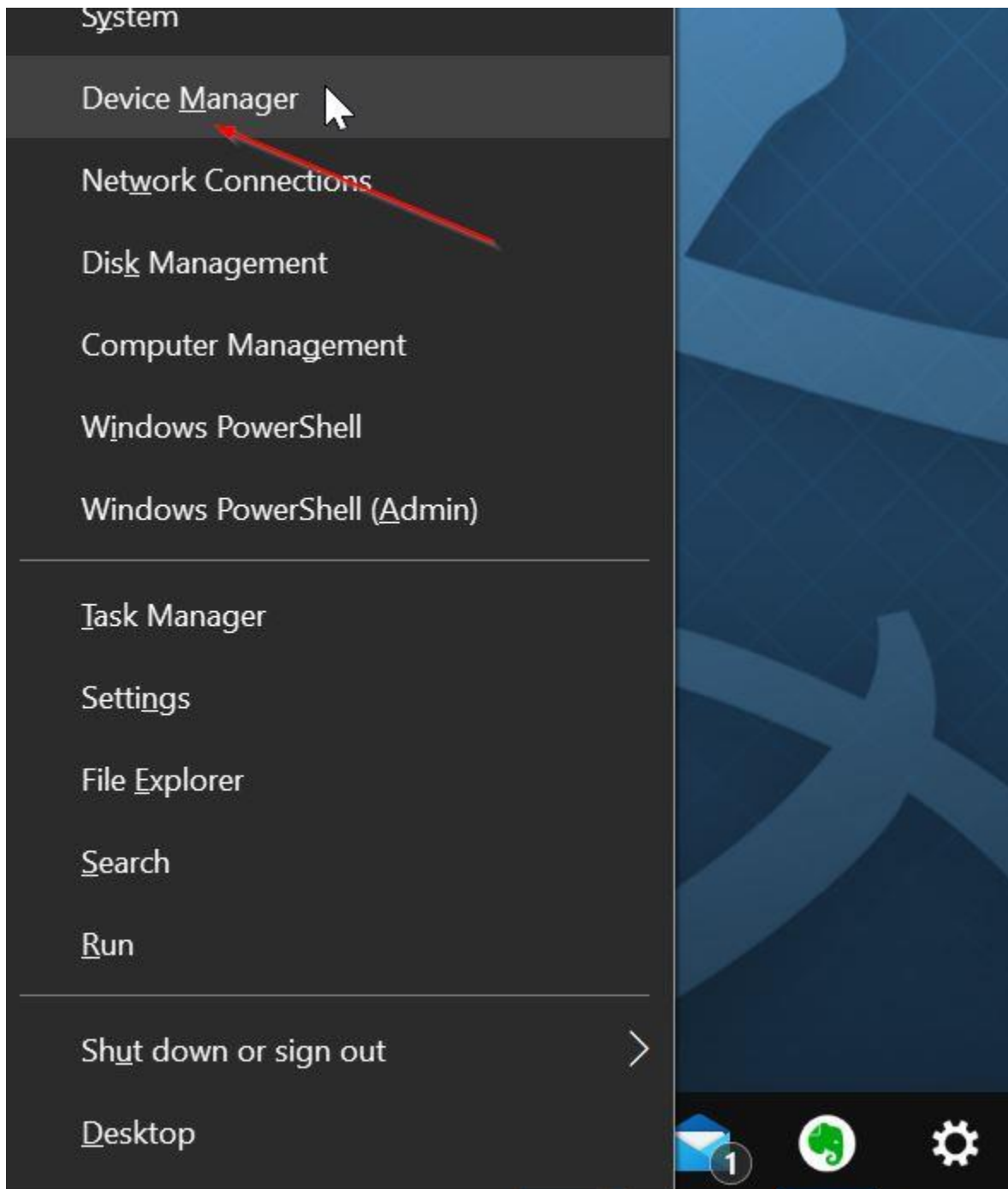
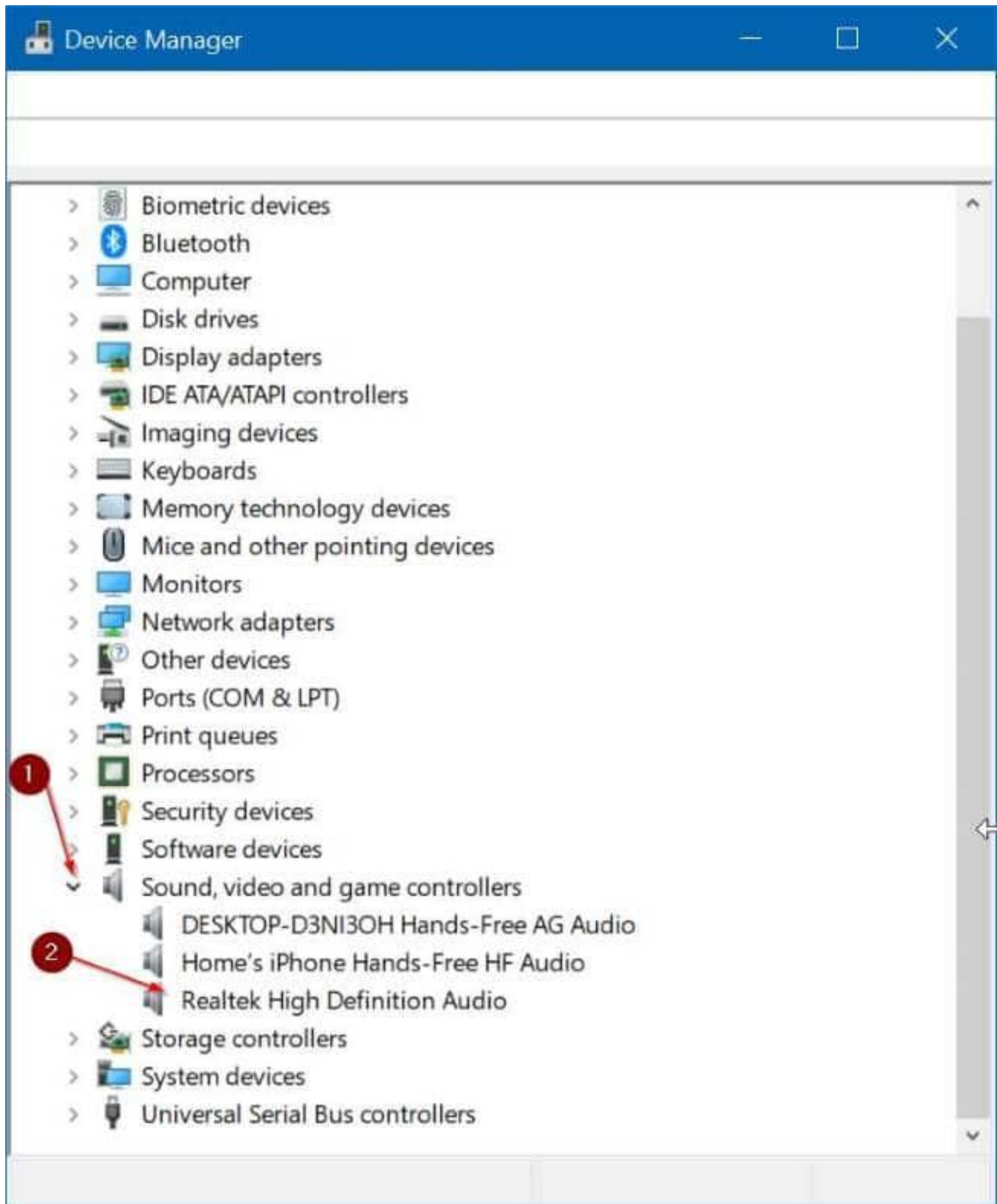


Reinstall Windows 10 audio driver from Device Manager

Step 1: Right-click on the Start button in the taskbar area and then click **Device Manager** to open the same.

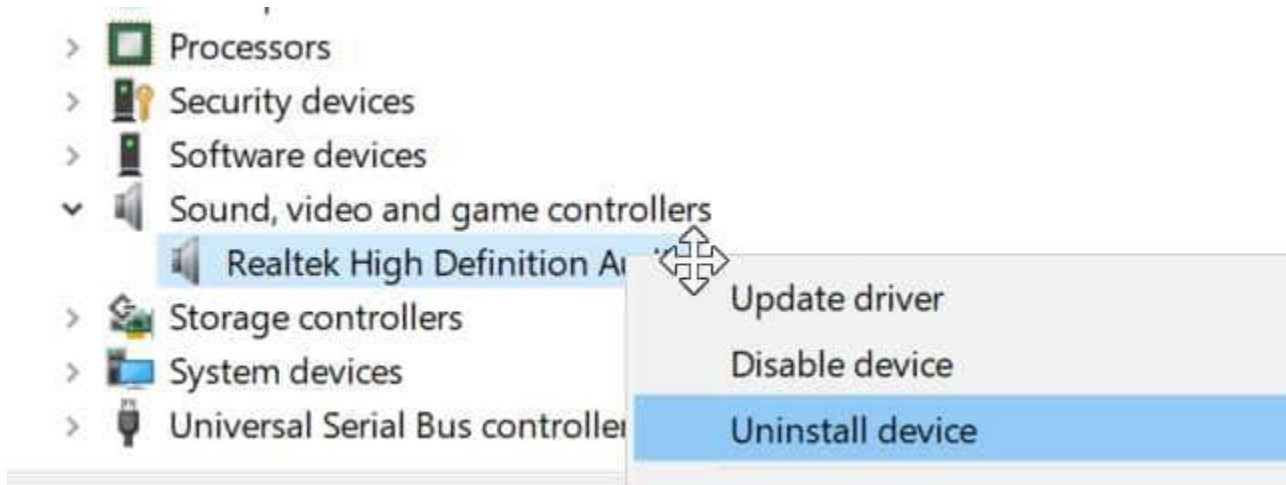


Step 2: In the Device Manager, expand **Sound, video and game controllers** tree.



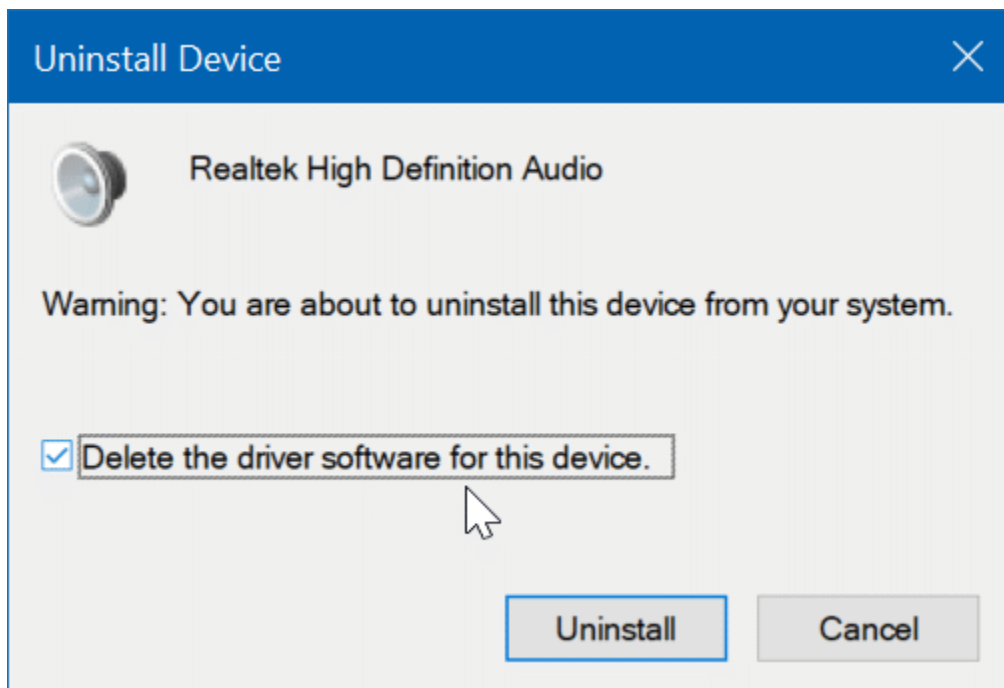
Step 3: You should now see your audio driver's name. Most likely you have Realtek High Definition Audio.

Right-click on it and then click the **Uninstall device** option.



Step 4: You will now get the following confirmation dialog. Select **Delete the driver software for this device** checkbox. Note that if you don't select this option, Windows will not uninstall the audio driver. So, be sure to select it.

Click the **Yes** button if you see the confirmation dialog to go ahead and uninstall the device driver.



Step 5: Restart your PC once. This is important. Save your work and please reboot your computer once.
