- Graduate from high school, practice for and take college admissions tests (SAT / ACT).
- **2.** Develop good reading and writing skills.
- **3.** Attend college and graduate with a 4 year college degree.
- **4.** Find a lawyer or judge you admire and ask them to be a mentor.
- **5. Practice** for & take the Law School Admissions Test (LSAT).
- **6.** Research law schools according to what kind of lawyer you want to be, finances, school resources, location, and likelihood of admission.

- **7.** Apply to, attend, and graduate from law school.
- 8. **Practice** for and take the Bar Examination in the state in which you would like to practice.
- **9.** Apply for membership to the bar association of that state, and pass Moral Character investigation.
- **10.** Pass Bar Examination, get sworn in by the State Supreme Court.
