

Enrollment Update

- Student Enrollment Fall 2018
 - 1,162 full-time students
 - 36 states, 12 countries
 - 49% male, 51% female
 - 5% international students
 - 30% athletes
 - 78% Bachelor's Degree
 - 22% Associate Degree
 - 89% reside on campus
- Entering Class
 - Average GPA: 2.75
 - Average SAT: 1030
 - 80% Bachelor's Degree







Admissions Process

- Early Action 1 November 1st decision by December 15
- Early Action 2 December 1st decision by January 15
- Rolling Admissions after December 1st
- Apply for free with Dean application or Common App
- Requirements:
 - High School Transcript
 - If applying to the Arch program Arch application, interview & documentation
 - If applying to Dance or Theatre Audition
- Optional:
 - Personal statement/essay
 - Letters of recommendation
 - SAT/ACT scores







Financial Aid

- Complete the FAFSA
- Award sent approximately 2 weeks after acceptance to the college
- 95% of students receive some form of assistance
- 85% of students receive need-based financial aid



- Merit scholarships awarded at time of admission. Notification with the acceptance letter.
 - \$10,000 \$25,000 per year
 - Based on academic achievement
 - Undocumented students are considered for merit scholarships
 - Need-based financial aid considered after the scholarship
- Average cost ~\$25,000 after financial aid
