- Be nominated by said alumnus/a
- Be a full-time (12 credits or more) freshman or sophomore
- Maintain a cumulative average of 3.0 to continue the scholarship award
- Agree to release name and photo for College and/or alumni-initiated publicity

The Edna A. Lauterbach Scholarship is offered every Spring to:

2. Applicant must be interested in pursuing or furthering their careers in home and community-based care.
3. The scholarship can be used for tuition, books, specialty training and education, and other education-related expenses.
