Vocabulary Word	Part of Speech	Sentence	Picture
Allergy	Noun	I can't eat peanuts - I have a peanut allergy .	
Appetizer	Noun	Before our meal, we would like an appetizer .	
Busser	Noun	The busser cleaned the table and set it for the next customer.	

Cash Register	Noun	Put the customer's money into the cash register .		
Chef	Noun	I will let the chef know how you want your steak cooked.		
Customer	Noun	Please ask the customer what they would like to eat.		
Dessert	Noun	After my meal, I would like the chocolate cake for dessert .		
Dish washer	Noun	Give the used plates to Brian, he is the dish washer .		
Drink	Noun	Would you like to order a drink ?		
Entrée	Noun	For my entrée , I would like the steak dinner.		
Gratuity	Noun	The bill includes an 18% gratuity , so we do not need to leave a tip.

<p>Kitchen</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>All of the food is made in the kitchen.</p>		
<p>Menu</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>Here is the menu, let me know when you have decided what you would like to order.</p>		
<p>Napkin</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>May I please have an extra napkin?</p>		
<p>To Order</p>	<p>Verb</p>	<p>I would like to order the chicken sandwich, please.</p>		
<p>Order</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>Has someone taken your order yet?</p>		
<p>Plate</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>Be careful, this plate is very hot.</p>		
<p>Refill</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>I see you have finished your soda. Would you like a refill?</p>		

<p>Specials</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>Are there any specials today?</p>		
<p>Table</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>We would like a table for two, please.</p>		
<p>Tip</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>The waitress was very nice, so we should leave her a 20% tip.</p>		
<p>Tray</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>I have three plates to bring to the table, so I will need a tray to carry them.</p>		
<p>Utensils</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>May we have an extra set of utensils?</p>		
<p>Wait</p>	<p>Verb</p>	<p>It looks busy. How long will we have to wait for a table?</p>		
<p>Waiter (Waitress)</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>The waiter took our order, and then brought us our bill after we finished eating.</p>		
<p>Vegetarian</p>	<p>Noun</p>	<p>I cannot have any meat because I am a vegetarian.</p>
