

Well, as you know, E. Hale Curran has a STEM focus. California's new science standards, which are called the Next Generation Science Standards or NGSS, integrates engineering. Each grade span, Kindergarten-2nd and 3rd-5th, have engineering standards that include asking questions, defining problems, developing sketches, drawings and models, planning and carrying out tests and analyzing data. Science helps us to explain phenomena either natural or manmade, while engineering helps us to solve problems and design and build systems. Engineers plan, design, test, redesign (sometimes multiple times) and test again in order to find solutions. Teachers incorporate science and engineering to challenge and encourage students to think critically and problem solve. What great life skills to have in our 21st century world. Please join us for this great family event as we encourage all of you to build, construct, design and test the many different activities.





work.


Students will have a great year with field trips, assemblies and after school events – all thanks to YOU!
