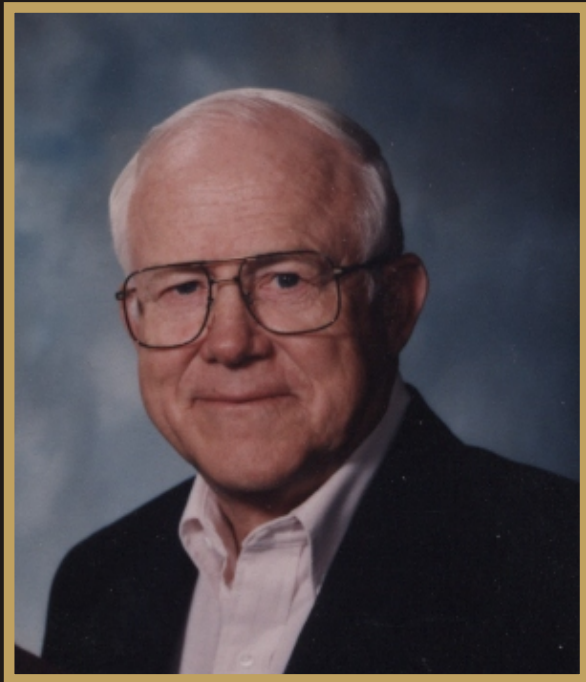


TED JENNINGS

Bob coached football for thirty years (1944-1973) during which time he won 13 conference championship titles, including eight undefeated teams (1946-1948, 1956, 1967-1968, 1970-1971). His 1946 team held opponents scoreless for the whole season, which is a S.D. 11 Man Team State Record yet today. He was selected as S.D. "Football Coach of the Year" in 1949 & 1967. Bob was inducted into the S.D. High School Football Coaches "Hall of Fame" in 1998.

Record 252 - 144

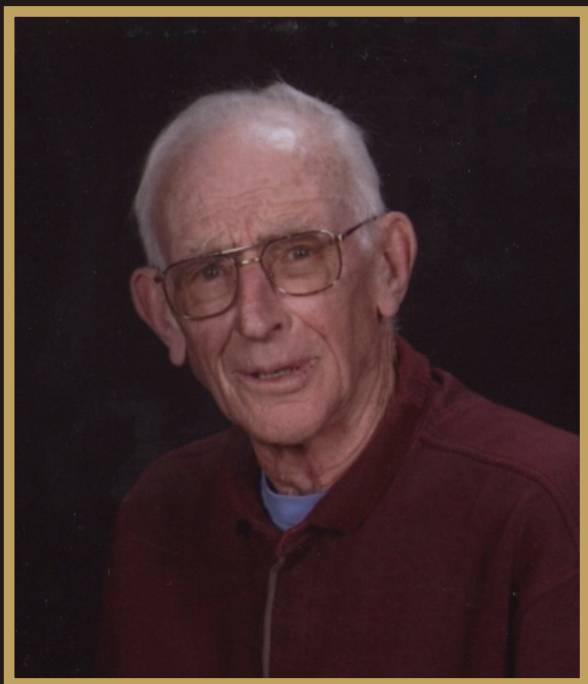
Bob coached basketball for nineteen years (1945-1963). His teams made five consecutive trips to the State "B" Tournament (1945-1949) ending with an undefeated State "B" Championship in 1949. Bob was inducted into the S.D. High School Basketball Coaches "Hall of Shrine" in 1989.

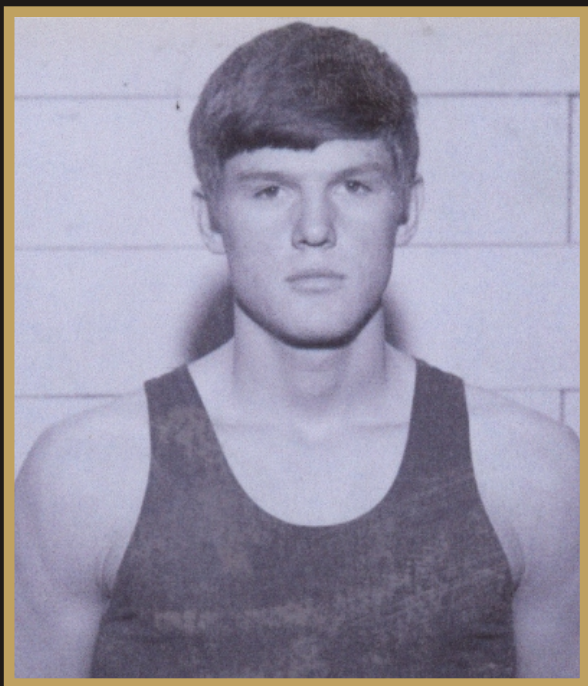
Letterman
