




Q2: Were you evaluated with the NEPF or a State Board of Education approved alternate evaluation system during the 2017-2018 school year?



Q3: Which type of training(s) did you attend regarding the implementation of the NEPF?(Check all that apply)








Q6: You are confident in knowing how to set your Student Learning Goal (SLG).



Q7: You are confident in knowing how to measure progress towards your SLG.





Q9: Did you have to modify your SLG based on your Mid-Cycle Goal Review?






Q11: How long after your Self-Assessment did your immediate supervisor discuss it with you?


Q12: Did you use feedback from your immediate supervisor regarding your Self-Assessment to set your Professional Practice Goal using the Goal Setting and Planning Tool?



Q13: Did you participate in at least one Pre-Observation conference?





Q14: How often did you participate in a scheduled observation this year?



Q15: How often did you participate in an unscheduled observation this year?




Q16: On average, how long after your scheduled or unscheduled observation did you participate in a Post-Observation conference? (Not the Summative Evaluation Conference)





Q17: As a result of the observation cycle conferences, to what extent do you agree that the feedback you received positively impacted your Instructional Practice?





Q18: On average, how much time did your supervisor spend observing your instruction?











Q22: Using NEPF Standards and Protocols have helped you to identify your areas of growth as an educator.







Q24: At your school, the implementation of NEPF Standards and Protocols is positively impacting student learning.





Q25: At your school, the implementation of NEPF Standards and Protocols is positively impacting your instructional practice.





Q26: On average, how much time was spent outside of instruction and conferences completing NEPF documentation for your supervisor?















Q33: What was your status during the 2017-2018 school year?






Q34: How long have you worked in education?
