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

ick-ups have evolved over the last 50 years. From purely load-carrying forces, many of them are now stylish rides that aim for a good balance between

workload and comfort across diverse terrains.

Now car makers are locked in a furious race to manufacture a pick-up that combines all these and what else they project for the future. Going by the enhanced performance, safety and designs of the pick-ups already in the market, arriving at that destination may be sooner than later. Bit by bit, the modern pick-up is adding new elements that take it closer to the future.

All models come with a three-year or 100,000km warranty, whichever comes first. A one-year service plan is included as an introductory offer. Finance is available via DTB with 10 percent deposit.

Suzuki's no-nonsense approach to your pick-up desires

The Suzuki Super Carry pick-up truck distributed in the country by CMC Motors Group Limited is a modified version of the previous one. Its strong, built-tolast petrol-driven power, 760kg load-capacity, and load box that's the widest in its class, are all implemented with a no-nonsense approach to your business.

Cyrus Maingi, the sales manager at CMC Motors' Suzuki division says the manufacturers have refined the engine and made it compliant in terms of emissions.

This light commercial vehicle runs on a G12B 1,200cc capacity four-cylinder engine. Each cylinder has 16 valves. The previous Suzuki was fitted with an earlier generation of the G12 engine.

It produces a power of 54kW at 6,000rpm and a torque of 101NM at 3,000rpm.

Mr Maingi says the Suzuki Super Carry offers reliability. "Business is about margins or profits and an affordable, small workhorse with efficient fuel consumption makes a difference," he explains.

It has a rack and pinion steering system for easy maneuverability.

This model was first launched in the country in 2018. The new pick-up truck with additional features was re-launched this year.

It is a 5-speed manual transmission truck with a 30-litre capacity tank. On average, the truck does 17-18km per litre, allowing motorists to make savings on fuel.



A robust brake system is part of the pickup truck's safety features. The font has disc brakes, while the rear has drum brakes. The vehicle's minimum turning radius is 4.3 metres. The loading deck is 2,153mm, allowing more cargo to fit in. The width is

1,458mm. The cargo space comes as an open body, giving the owner the option for specialised conversion.

As Mr Maingi explains, owners of the Suzuki Super Carry can customise the body, depending on what they want to transport.

"Some people use it to transport vegetables or fruits," he says, adding that others use the vehicle to carry gas cylinder, beverages or even bales of clothes.

The Suzuki Super Carry, he says, has been performing well since CMC Motors brought into the country the first unit in 2018.

"This vehicle is quite popular in Nairobi and Mombasa among people in the distribution business and starting at Ksh1.4 million, it is highly affordable compared to others within its class," says Mr Maingi.

The Suzuki comes with a 5-speed manual transmission.

The ground clearance is 175mm, allowing motorists to drive the vehicle on tarmac and off-road.

Buyers enjoy a service package of one year. The warranty is three years or 100,000km – whichever comes first.

After-sales service for the model is available countrywide at CMC Motor Group Limited service outlets.

CMC has partnerships with several banks for financing purchases of the truck.
