ST. PHILIP'S COLLEGE FIRSTS

- Founded in 1898, St. Philip's College was the first higher education institution for blacks in the city of San Antonio.
- St. Philip's College is the only institution of higher education in the United States with dual designations as Historically Black and Hispanic Serving.
- St. Philip's College's Culinary Arts program was first accredited in the state of Texas by the American Culinary Federation.

ST. PHILIP'S COLLEGE BEST RANKINGS

- SPC was recognized by the Quality Texas Foundation at the Achievement Level in 2017, 2016, 2014 and 2013.
- We are certified as a National Center for Construction Education and Research training institution.
- SPC was awarded a \$900,000 Minority Serving Institution Partnership with Community-Based Organization grant sponsored U.S. Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration for substance abuse, HIV-AIDS and Hepatitis C prevention.
- In 2017, VITA income tax site processed over \$8 million in refunds for clients and was recognized at the community college level as the highest producer in the area.
- The Ruth Jones McClendon Collection, located in the Center for Learning Resources, is the largest community college archive in the South Texas Region.
- St. Philip's College was recognized by the American Welding Society as the first college-accredited testing facility.
- We are one of four colleges in Texas to possess a NAEYC-accredited Early Childhood Associate Degree.

- Dr. Loston is the only president to be awarded the Shirley B. Gordon International Presidential Award of Distinction twice.
- Our Cyber Tigers club is Texas' first model of volunteer cyber first responders of its type at the community college level.
- St. Philip's College is the first community college in San Antonio and the second in Texas to be certified to offer curriculum approved to meet the National Training Standard endorsed by the National Security Agency (NSA) and the Committee on National Security Systems (CNSS).
- We received 2017 Best Community Partner award by San Antonio for Growth on the Eastside (SAGE).
- SPC hosted the Women in Non-Traditional Occupations Conference (WINTO) with over 400 attendees.
- Our Annual Scholarship Golf Tournament has raised over \$1.3 million in just nine years.
