Doody	Youngest of the guys. Small, boyish, open, with a disarming smile and a hero-worshipping attitude toward the other guys. Plays guitar (optional). Eugene	The class valedictorian. Physically awkward, with weak eyes and a high pitched voice. A nerdy apple polisher, smug and pompous but gullible. <i>(Possibility of casting two people as Eugene – one as student, one as adult.)</i>	Alma Mater (with Choral Group of 12)	
Vince Fontaine	Adult, a typical 'teen audience' radio disc jockey. Slick, egotistical, fast-talking. A veteran 'greaser'. Must be able to convincingly play an adult (25+)	Non singing	
Johnny Casino	A 'greaser' student at Rydell who energetically leads a rock'n'roll band and likes to think of himself as a real rock'n'roll idol (like Elvis).	Shaking at the High School Hop (Lead) Born to Hand Jive (Lead) Good energetic solo performer	A – C Good Falsetto to High C (optional)
Teen Angel	A good looking, falsetto voiced crooner. A singer who would have caused the girls (and women) to scream and riot back in 1958. <i>(Possibility of casting a well-known NZ celebrity to play this role.)</i> Must be able to convincingly play a 'celebrity' (25+)	Beauty School Dropout (Lead) Good dancer	E – B Good Falsetto to E

Sandy	Danny's love interest. Sweet, wholesome, naïve, cute, like Sandra Dee of the 'Gidget' movies. However, must be able to play sassy and sultry after her transformation. Rizzo	Leader of the "Pink Ladies". She is tough, sarcastic and outspoken, but vulnerable during a pregnancy scare. Italian, with unconventional good looks. Must be able to convincingly play an older teenager (16+)	Freddy My Love (with Marty and Pink Ladies) Look At Me I'm Sandra Dee (Lead) There Are Worse Things I Could Do (Solo)	A – C
Frenchy	A dreamer. Good natured but a little dumb. Heavily made-up, fussy about her appearance – particularly her hair. She can't wait to finish high school so she can be a beautician. Must be able to convincingly play an older teenager (16+)	Freddy My Love (with Marty and Pink Ladies)	
Marty	The 'beauty' of the Pink Ladies. Pretty, looks older than the other girls, but betrays her real age when she opens her mouth. Tries to act sophisticated. Must be able to convincingly play an older teenager (16+)	Freddy My Love (Lead) Must be able to walk comfortably in high heels – please wear to audition	C – Db
Jan	Energetic, bubbly, and eating all the time! Loud and pushy with the girls, but shy with the boys.	Freddy My Love (with Marty and Pink Ladies) Mooning (with Roger)	Bb – Bb
Patty	A typical all American cheerleader. Attractive and athletic. Aggressive, sure of herself, given to burst of disconcerting enthusiasm. Catty. <i>(Possibility of casting two people as Patty – one as student, one as adult.)</i> Must be able to convincingly play an older teenager (16+)	Alma Mater (with Choral Group of 12) Cheerleading / Baton Swirling (optional)	
Cha-Cha	Kenickie's blind date, who dances the Hand Jive with Danny. Sexy, fiesty and overly confident. Is, and takes pride in being 'the best dancer at St Bernadette's'. Must be able to convincingly play an older teenager (16+)	Non singing Excellent dancer Must be able to walk AND dance comfortably in high heels – please wear to audition	
Miss Lynch	The Rydell High School Head Mistress. Strict, demanding teacher, who would like to consider herself 'hip', but she definitely isn't. Must be able to convincingly play an adult (40+)	Alma Mater (badly)	Doesn't need to be a good singer
Blanche	Miss Lynch's faithful secretary. Miss Lynch considers her more like a servant.	Alma Mater (very high pitched)	Soprano
