The Rec's fax number is 717-738-1462. On Monday, May 20, Summer Municipal Programs will be randomly filled with the submitted forms. A separate form must be filled out in its entirety for each participant in each program. If a fee is required, it must accompany the registration in the form of a check or money order (no cash). Make the checks payable to the Ephrata Rec Center. If participants are registering for more than one class requiring a fee, a separate check or money order must accompany each individual registration. Walk-in registration for programs remaining open will begin on Thursday, May 23. Registrants will be notified only if a class is full and their registration cannot be accepted, otherwise, if you do not hear from us, you are in the class.
