The four stages of the canine thermal cycle are as follows: Proestro: The proestro is the beginning of the thermal period in which the dog's body prepares to mate. The signs seen during this phase include swelling of the vulva, exhaust-tint blood, excessive lacquering of the genital area, sticky behavior, and aggression against male dogs. Your dog can also keep the tail close to her body.Áċ Estrus: The extrus phase is the mating stage in which your female dog will be receptive to males. You may notice that your dog seems to urinate more frequently than normal, as she is marking spots to indicate her readiness to reproduce. Although it could leave signs of urine in some areas, its vaginal secretion will slow down and could change of straw color. Since your dog is ready for mating, it will approach the males with the tail held on the side, but it will be aggressive towards the other females. Áċ Right: This phase occurs immediately after the "heat" phase and allows your dog's body to return to normal or develop in pregnancy. Its vulva will return to a normal size and the vaginal discharge will disappear. Anestrus: Anestrus is an inactive phase, without signs of hormonal or sexual behavior. Áċ Dogs have an average of two thermal cycles per year, about six months away. Some females have irregular cycles, especially if they are very young or very old. Small breeds can cycle three times a year, while giant races can cycle only once every 12 months. Unlike some other species, canine estrous cycles do not depend on seasons, sunlight, or temperatures. Áċ If your dog is experiencing its first heat cycle, it can be a disturbing situation for both of us. Follow these tips to make sure its heat is as smoothly as possible: Never leaveDog out in the courtyard alone. Do not underestimate the operation of a male dog to find a female that emits reproducer pheromones. You can walk out to find a strange male dog tied to your female. Never leave your dog on a leash when it is in heat. Even if your dog can have excellent excellent skill, its ability to recall can fall on the side of the road when it is influenced by its hormones and is going to find a male. Make sure your dog's id tags and microchip information are up-to-date. If the unthinkable happens and your dog runs away from your yard or runs away, make sure that you can be reunited with legible, updated id tags and current microchip contact information, consult your veterinarian if you notice signs of disease. Occasionally, a female dog may experience health problems after a heat cycle when the uterine coating remains thickened and produces more fluid, creating the ideal environment for bacterial growth, this can lead to a life-threatening pyometra, or uterine infection. a pet with a piometra can drink excessively, have a fever, vaginal discharge, decrease of appetite, or appear letargic. consider spaying your dog after its heat cycle is over. if you are not going to breed your dog, consider the wait until her heat cycle is finished for spy her. Your veterinarian may recommend on the appropriate age for spy your pet, and it probably recommends to wait until she is finished with her extrus stage for spy her.
