
## Orlando, FL, Area Economic Summary




Unemployment rates for the nation and selected

Over-the-year changes in employment on nonfarm payrolls and employment by major industry sector








Over-the-year change in the <u>prices paid by urban</u> <u>consumers</u> for selected categories


### 12-month percent change in CPI-U, April 2021





# Average annual spending and percent distribution for selected categories

Average hourly wages for selected occupations


