- ❖ Uveitis, scleritis

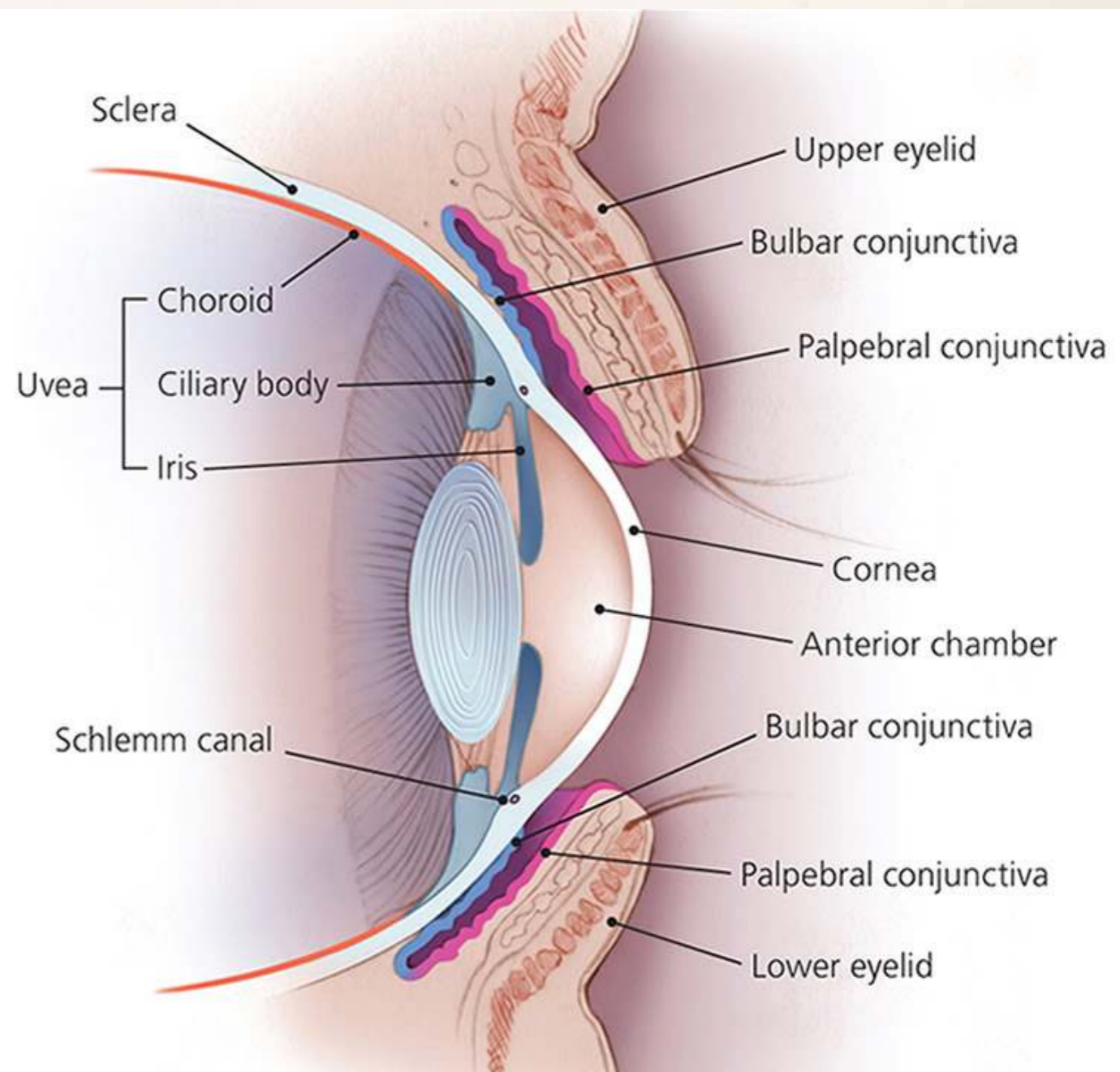
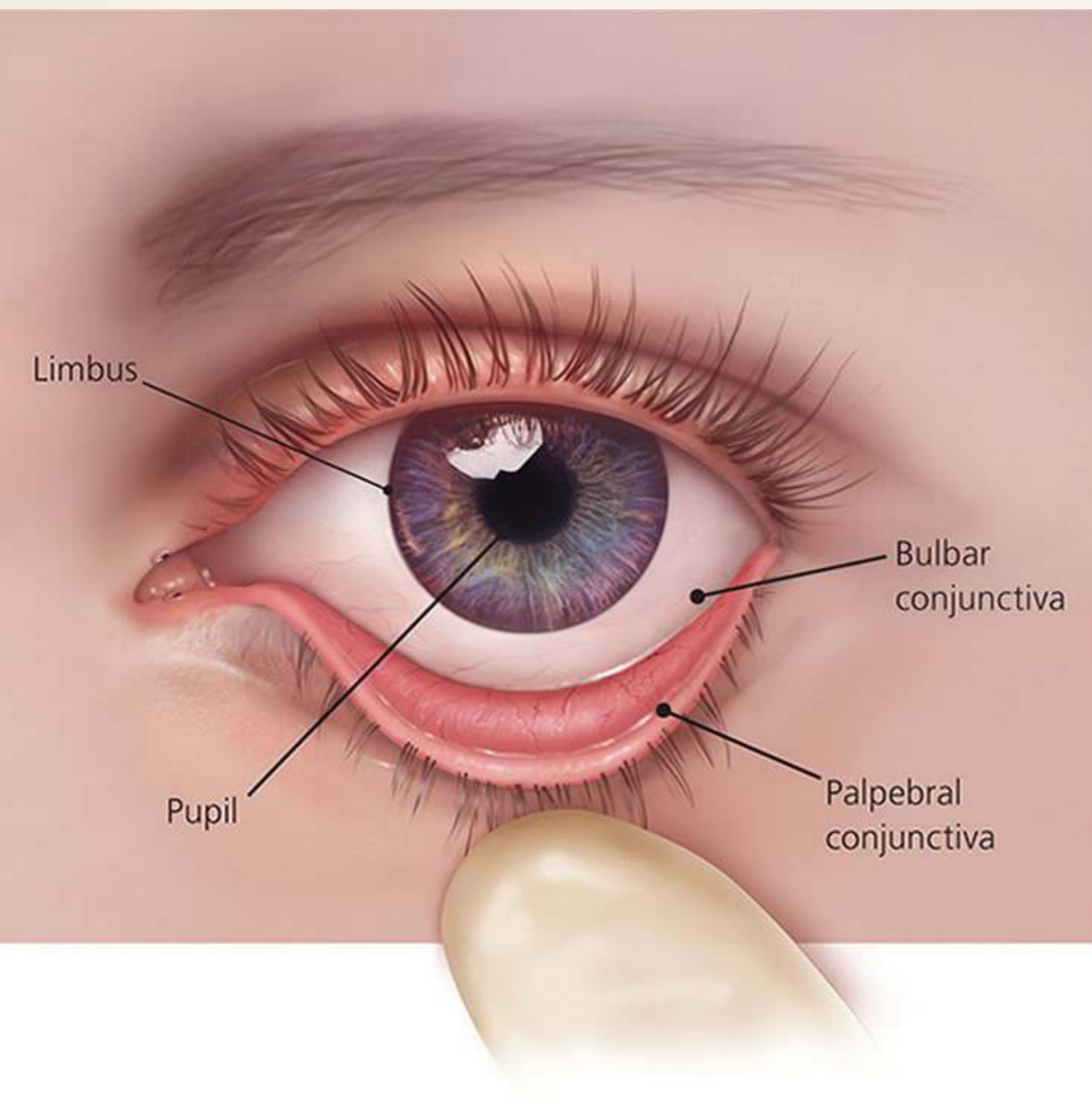
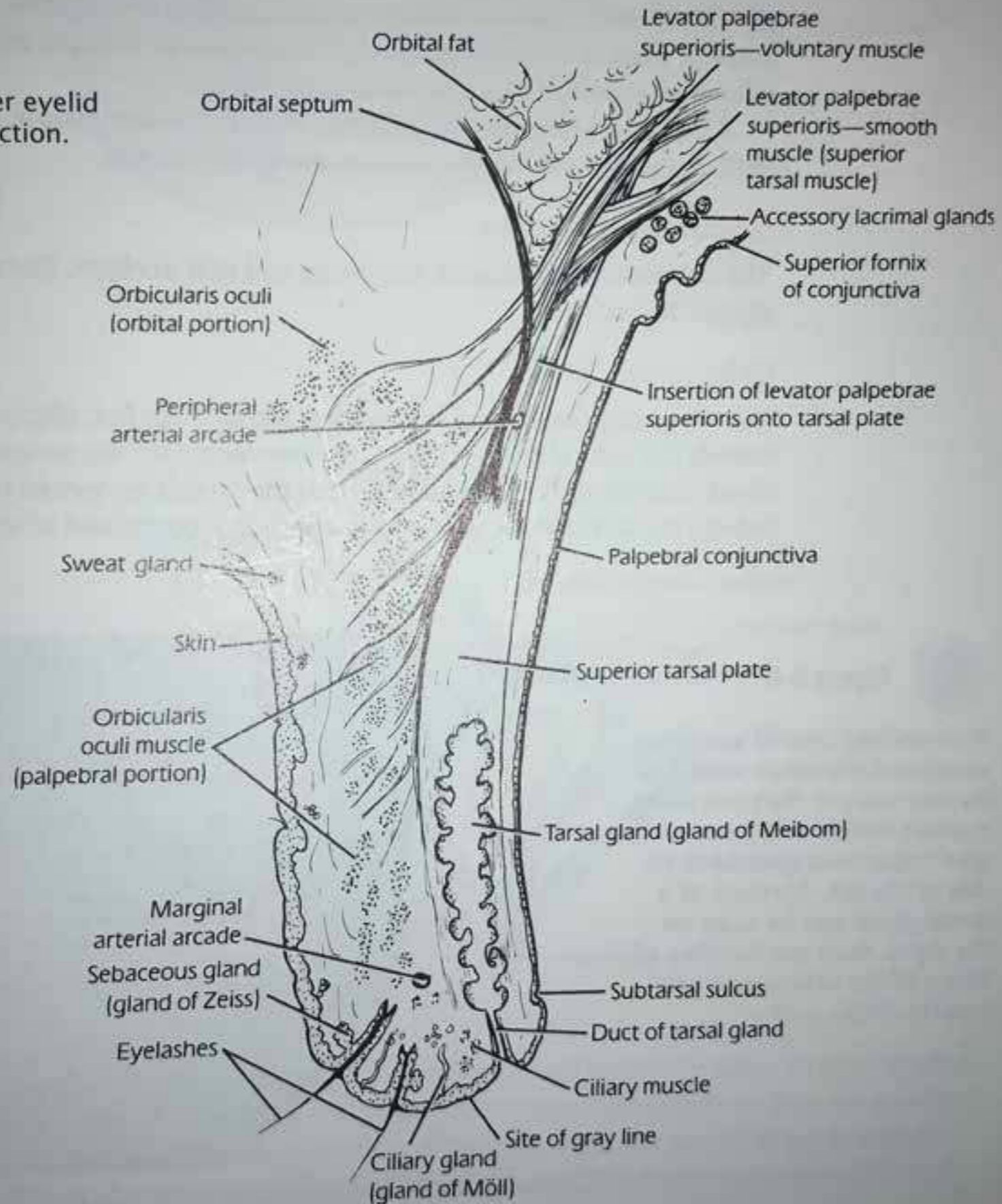

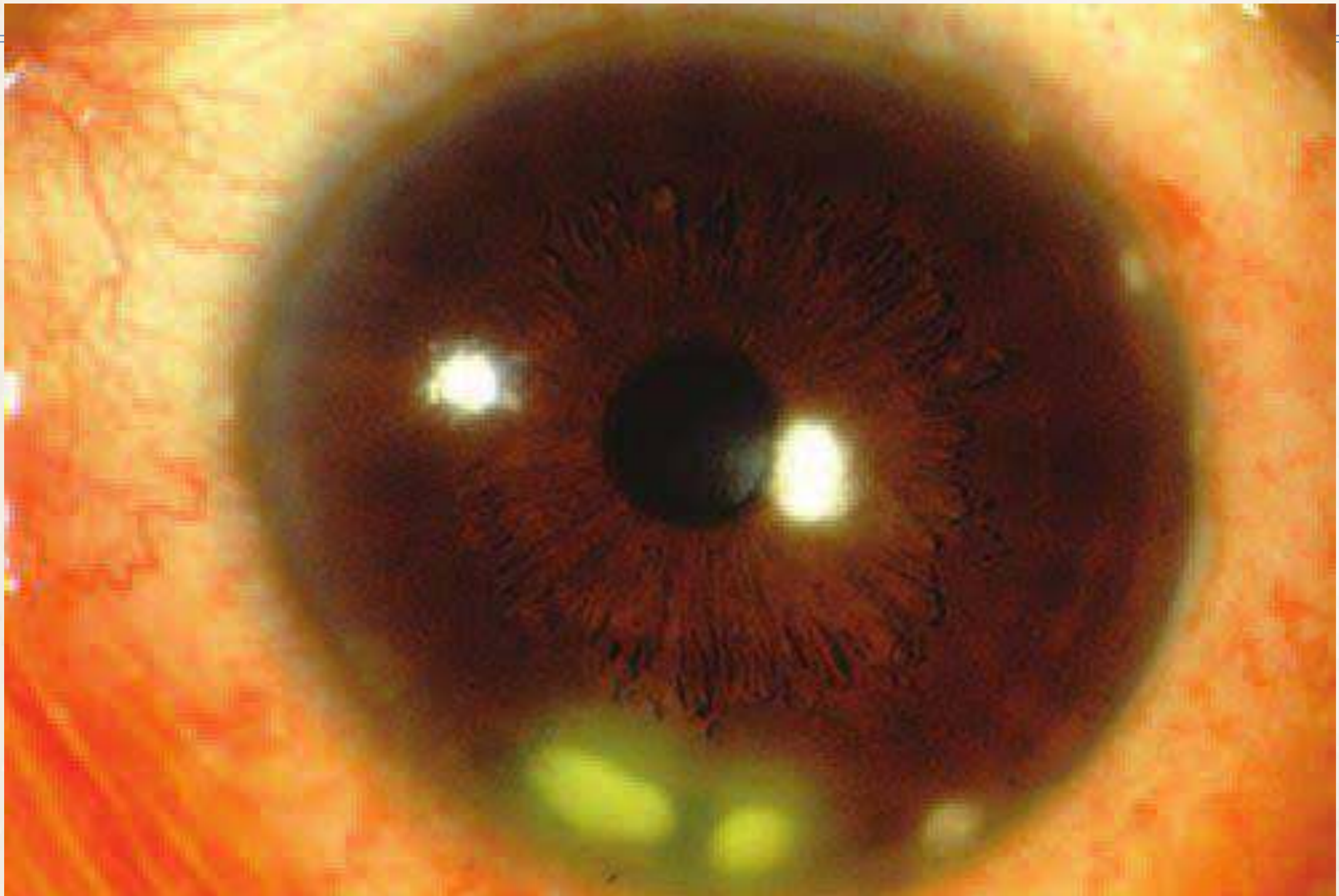
Structure of the upper eyelid as seen in vertical section.

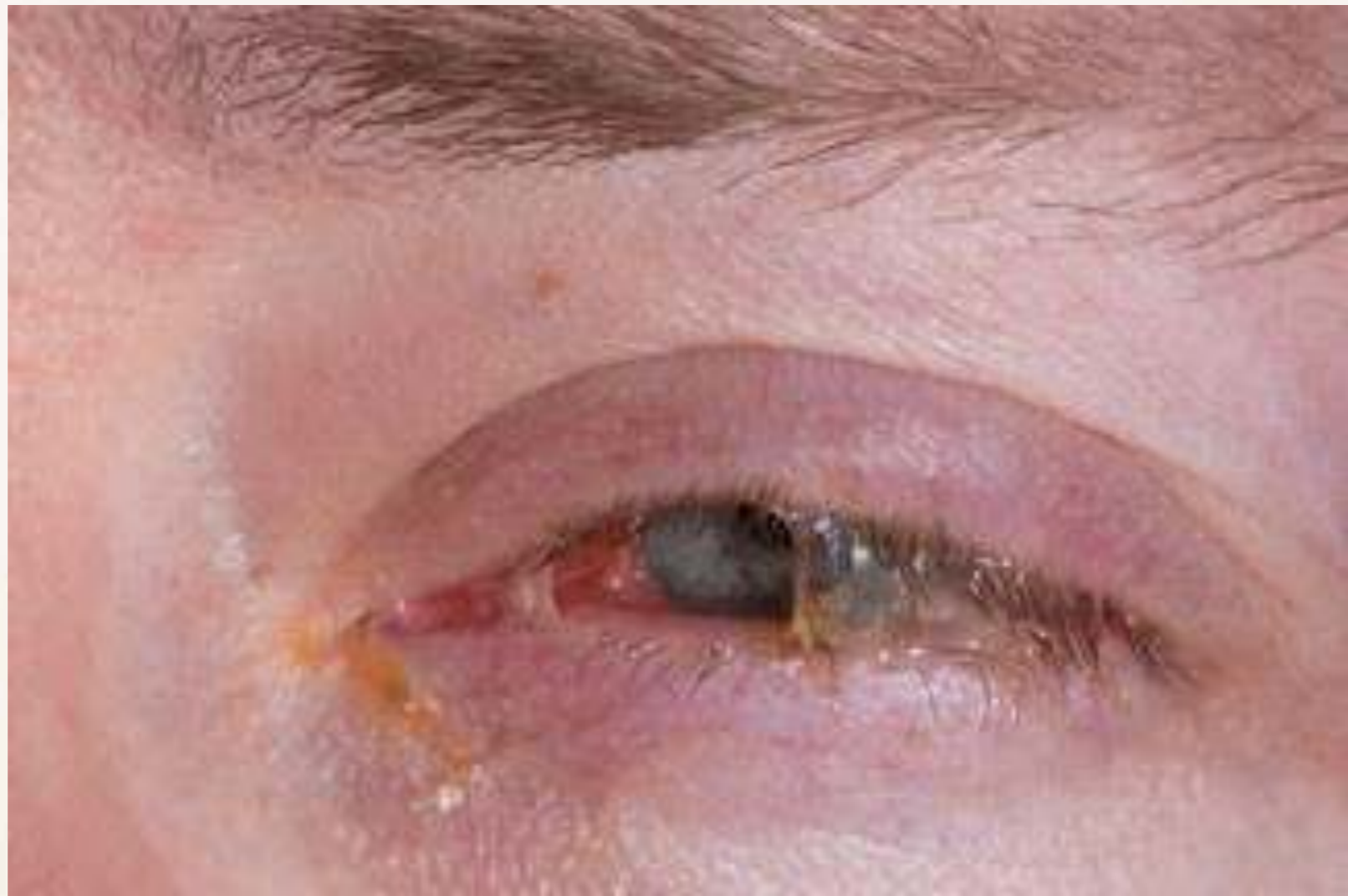
Symptoms and Treatment

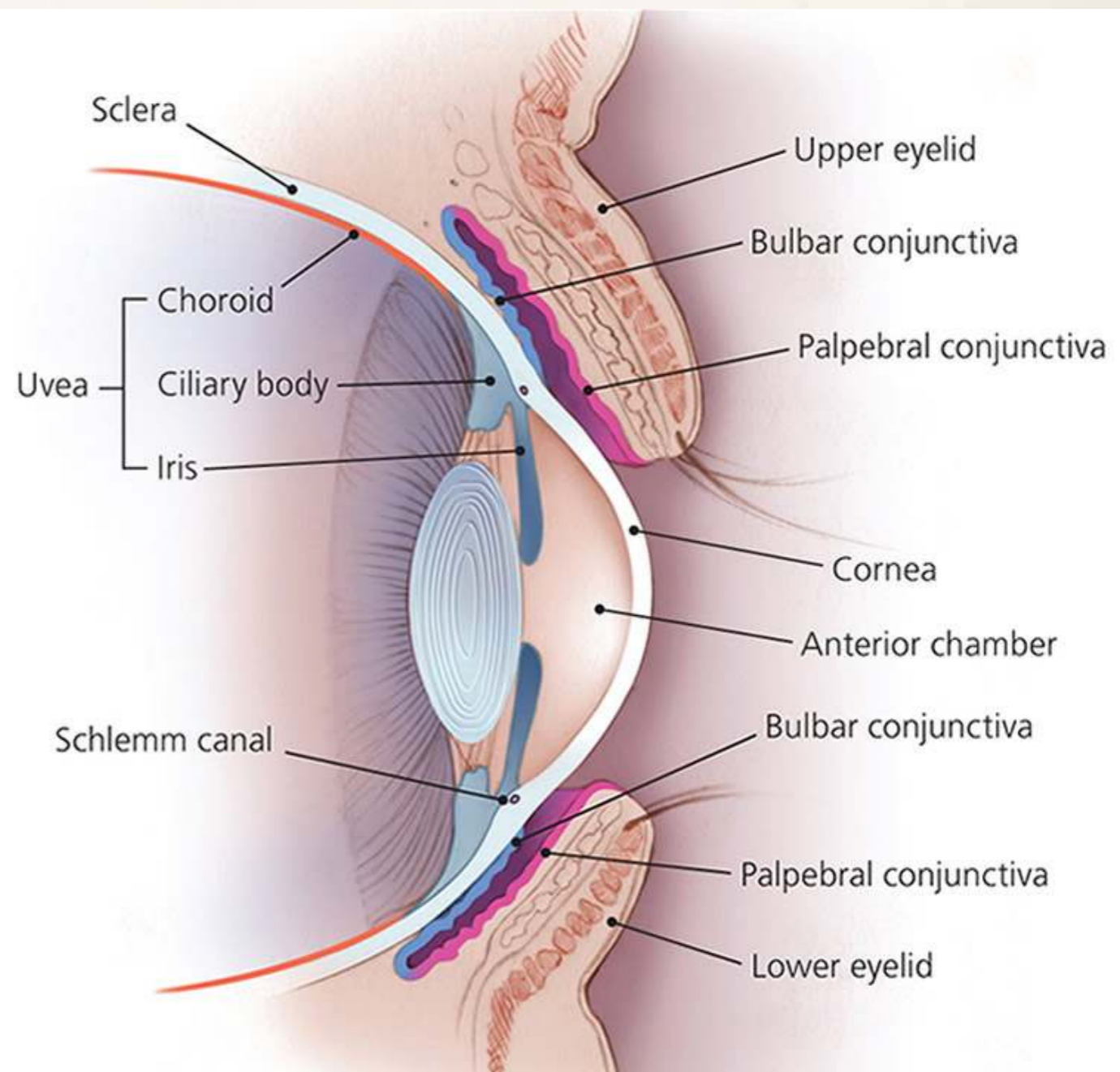
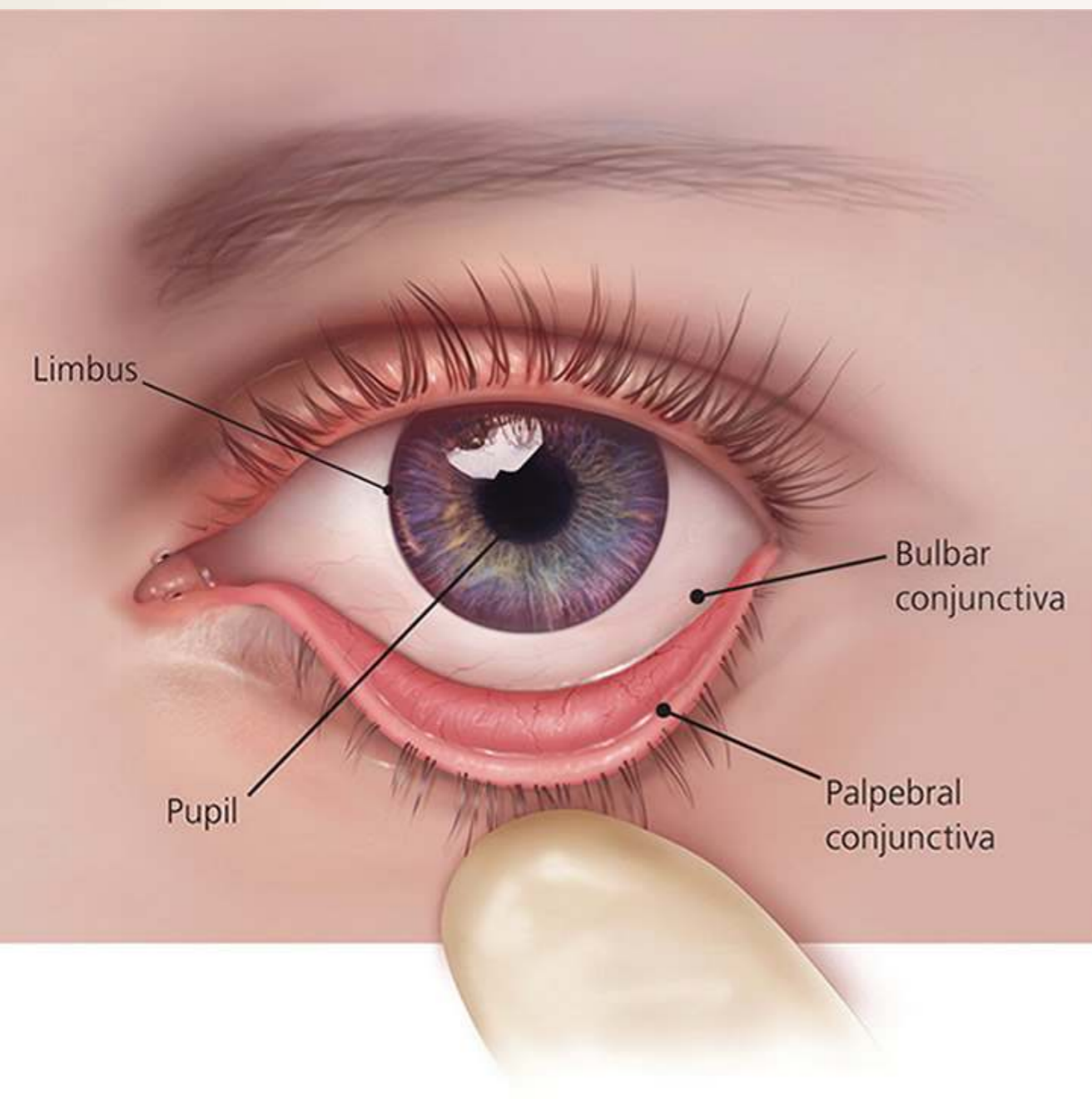
- ❖ Gritty eyes
- ❖ Watery and yellow discharge
- ❖ Reduced vision

- ❖ Eyelid hygiene
- ❖ Hot Compresses
- ❖ Lubricating drops and occasionally steroid eye drops
- ❖ Antibiotics are hardly ever indicated

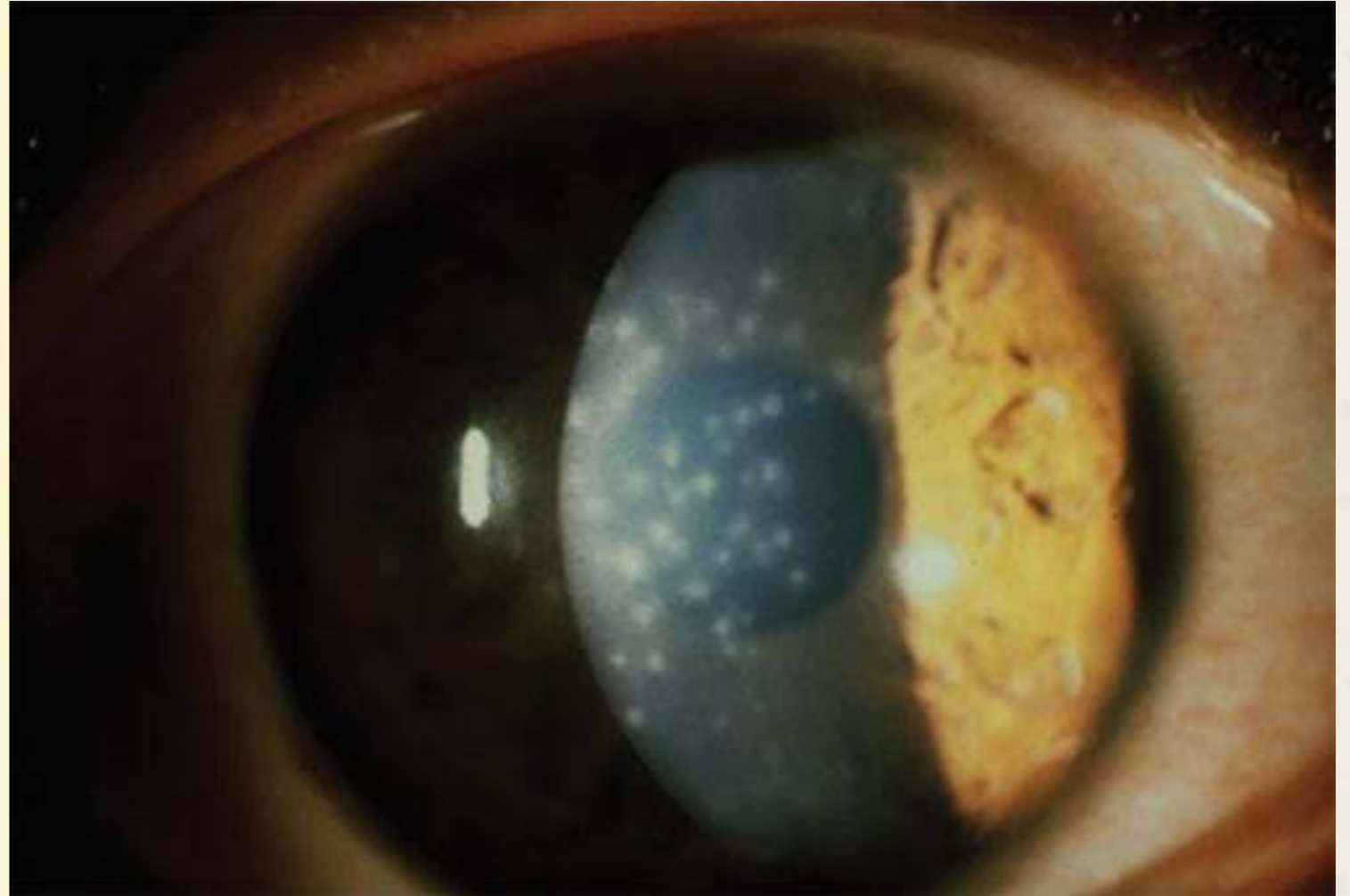
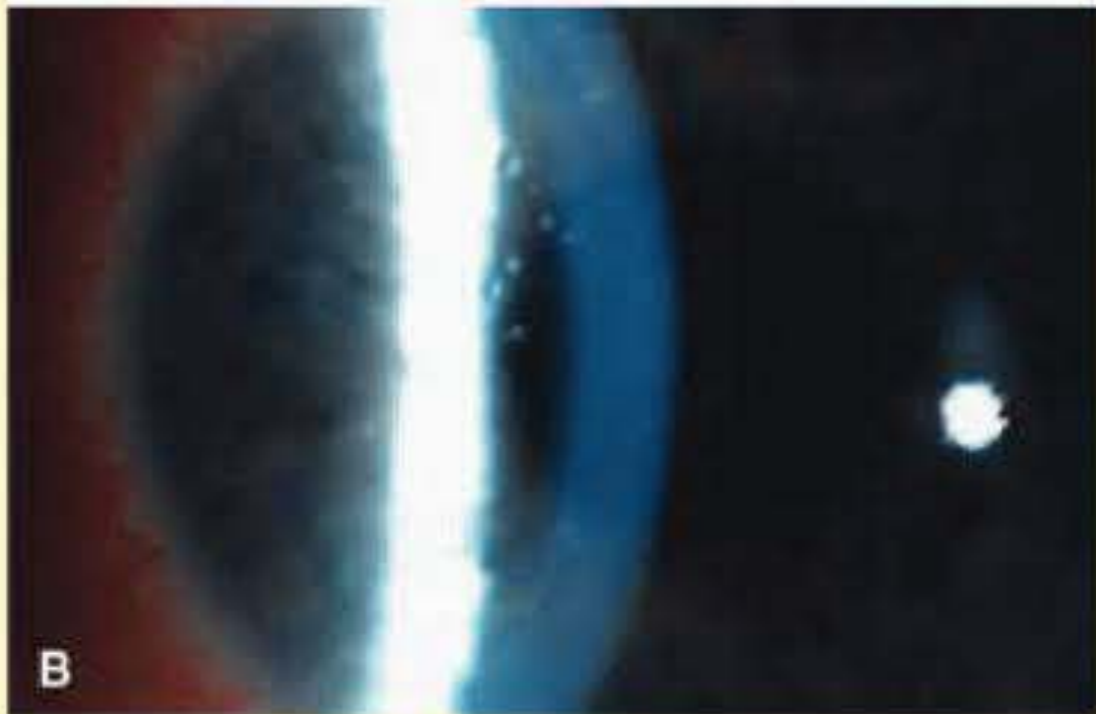

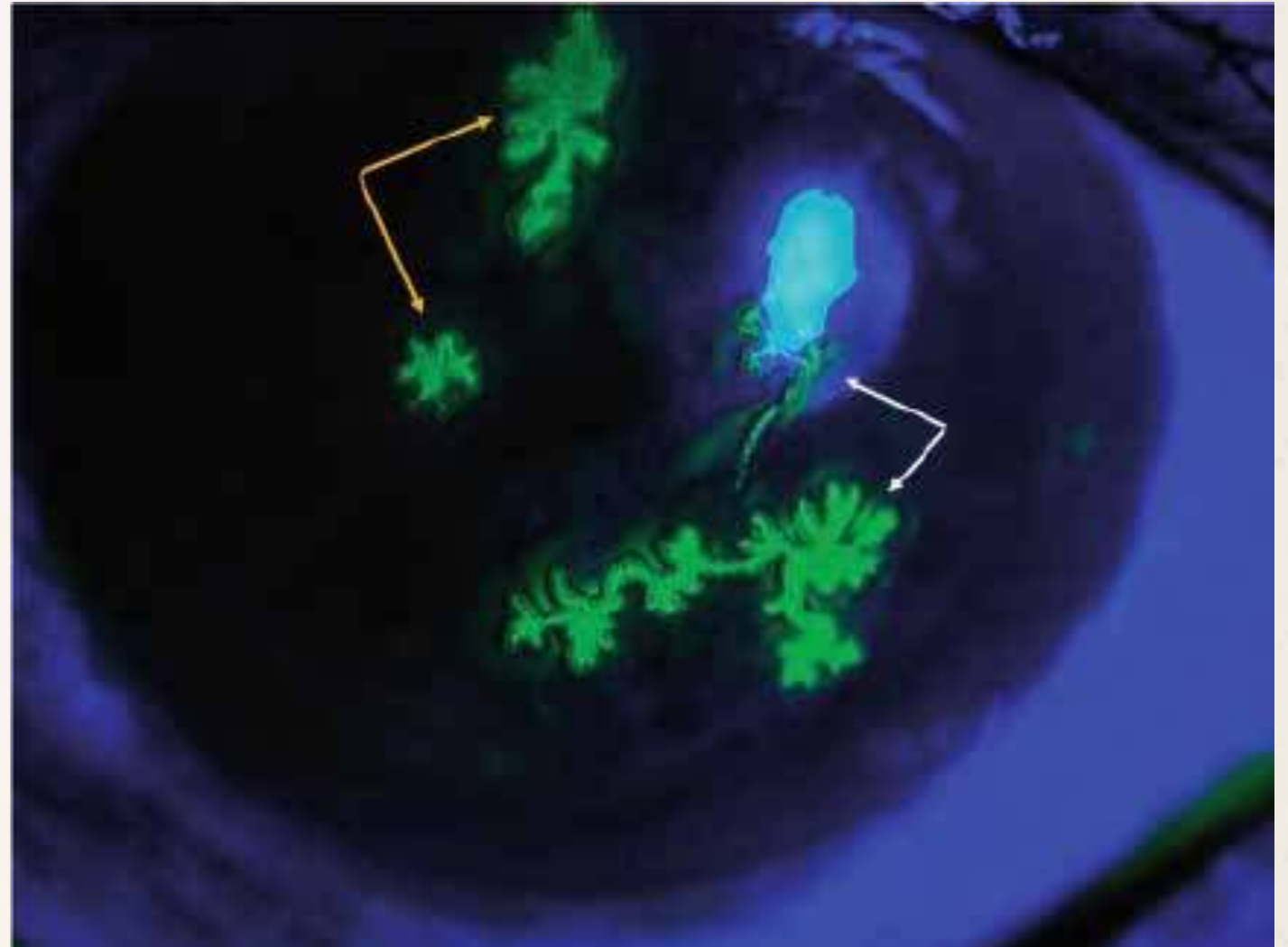




Viral Conjunctivitis (adenovirus)

Symptoms and Treatment

- ❖ Itchy and gritty Eye
- ❖ Watery discharge
- ❖ Reduced vision

- ❖ Cold Compresses
- ❖ Lubricating drops
- ❖ Rarely needs antibiotics, usually self limiting and resolves after a few days
- ❖ Anti-virals in case of HSV infection
- ❖ Steroids only if cornea is involved (ophthalmologist)

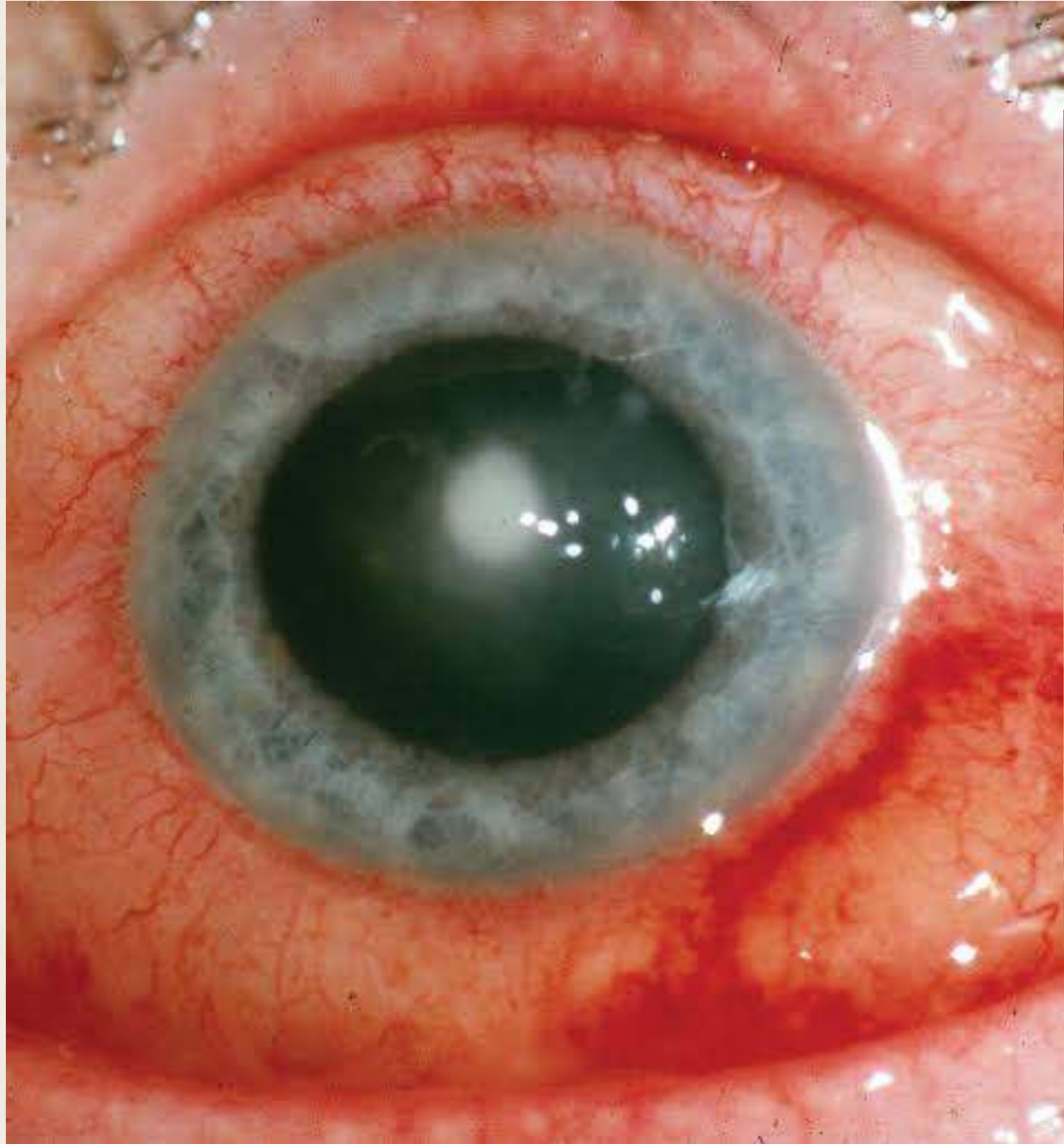


Symptoms and Treatment

- ❖ Itchy Eye
- ❖ Watery discharge
- ❖ Reduced vision - slightly

- ❖ Cold Compresses
- ❖ Cease all existing eye drops
- ❖ Preservative free lubricating eye drops
- ❖ Steroids eyedrops are often needed, close monitoring is required to avoid complications

Bacterial Keratitis



Symptoms and Treatment

- ❖ Itchy, gritty and painful Eye
- ❖ Yellow discharge
- ❖ Reduced vision - significantly
- ❖ Medical Emergency
- ❖ Often needs hospital admission with intensive topical antibiotics and risk of significant loss of vision



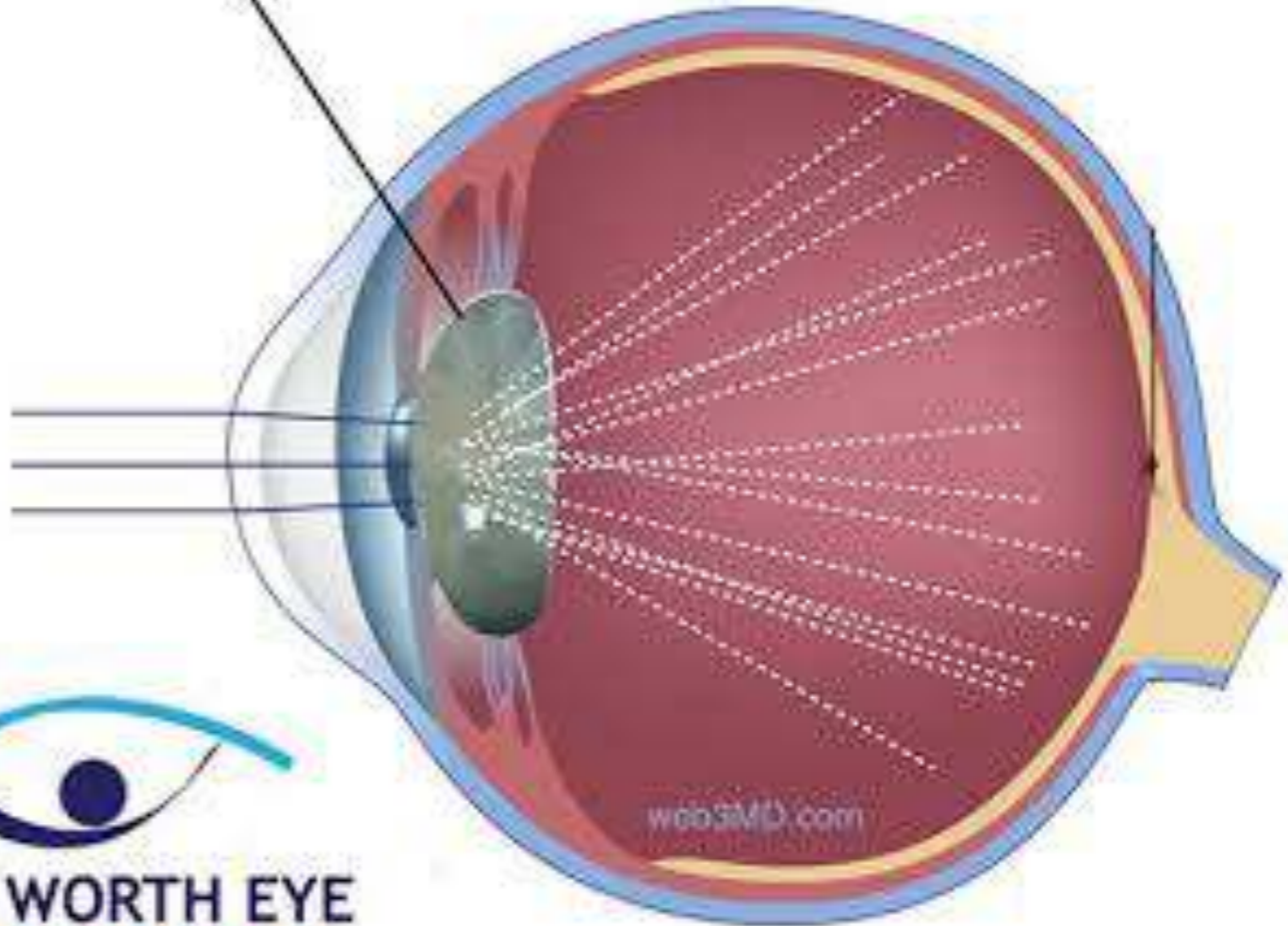
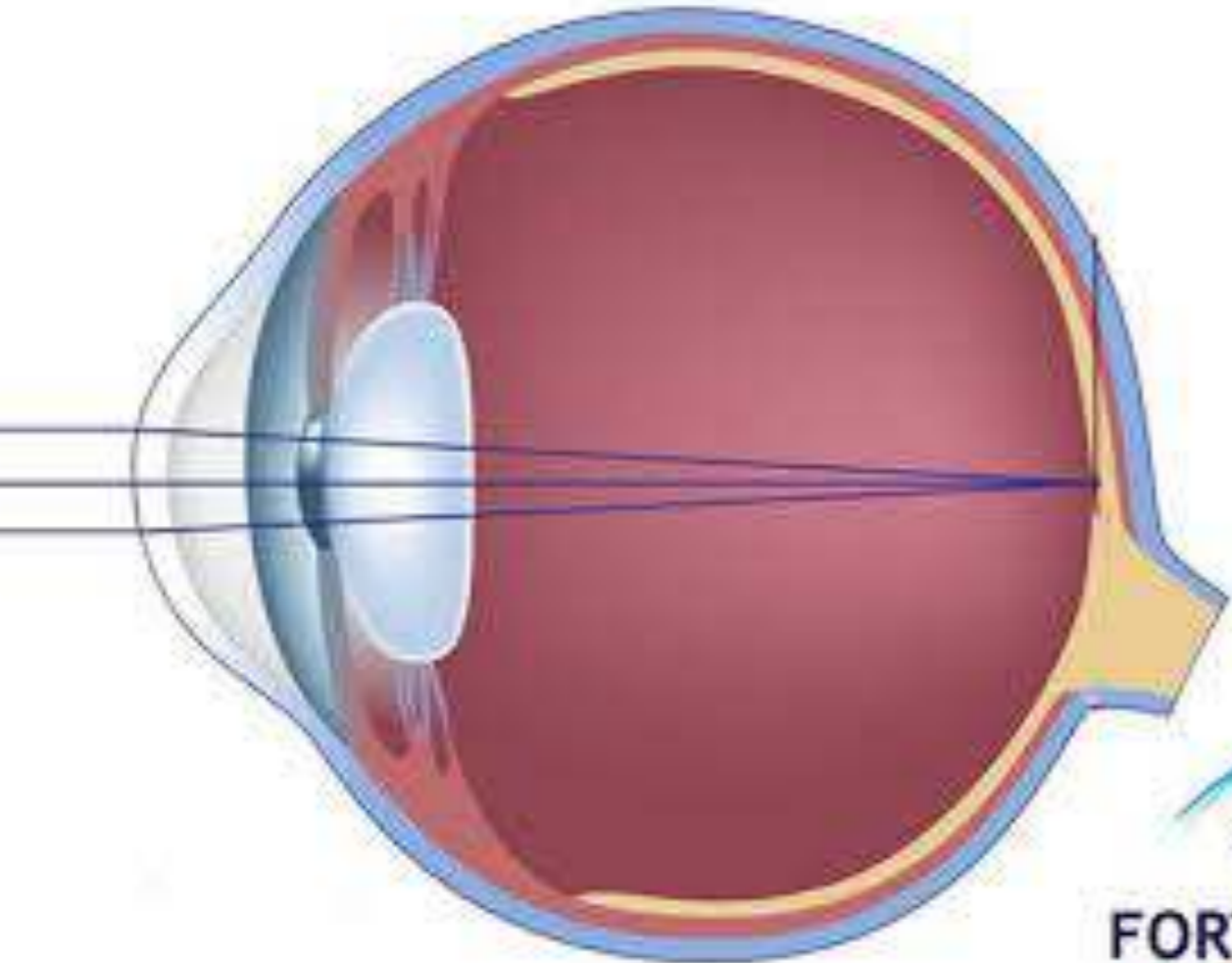
Cataract

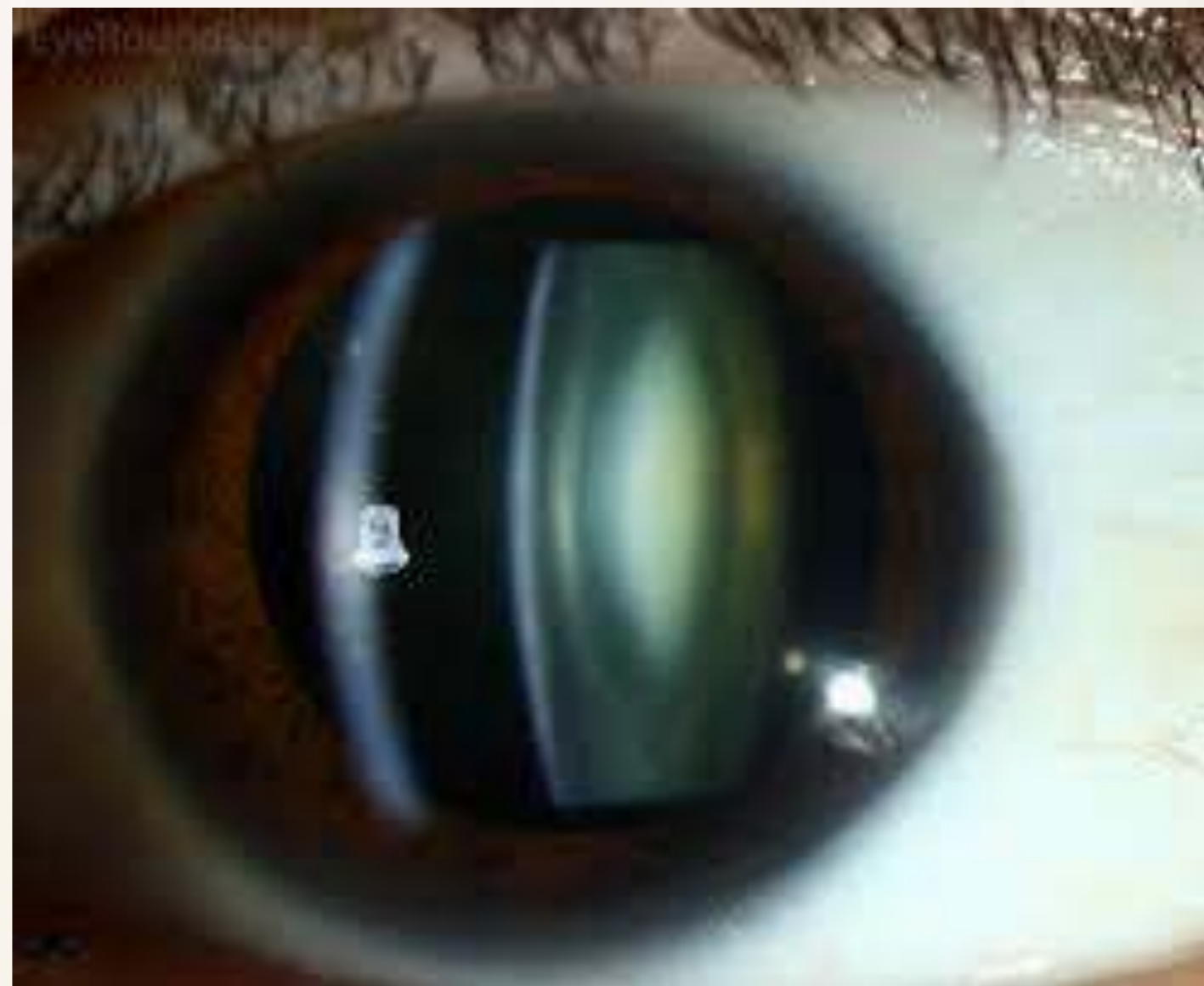

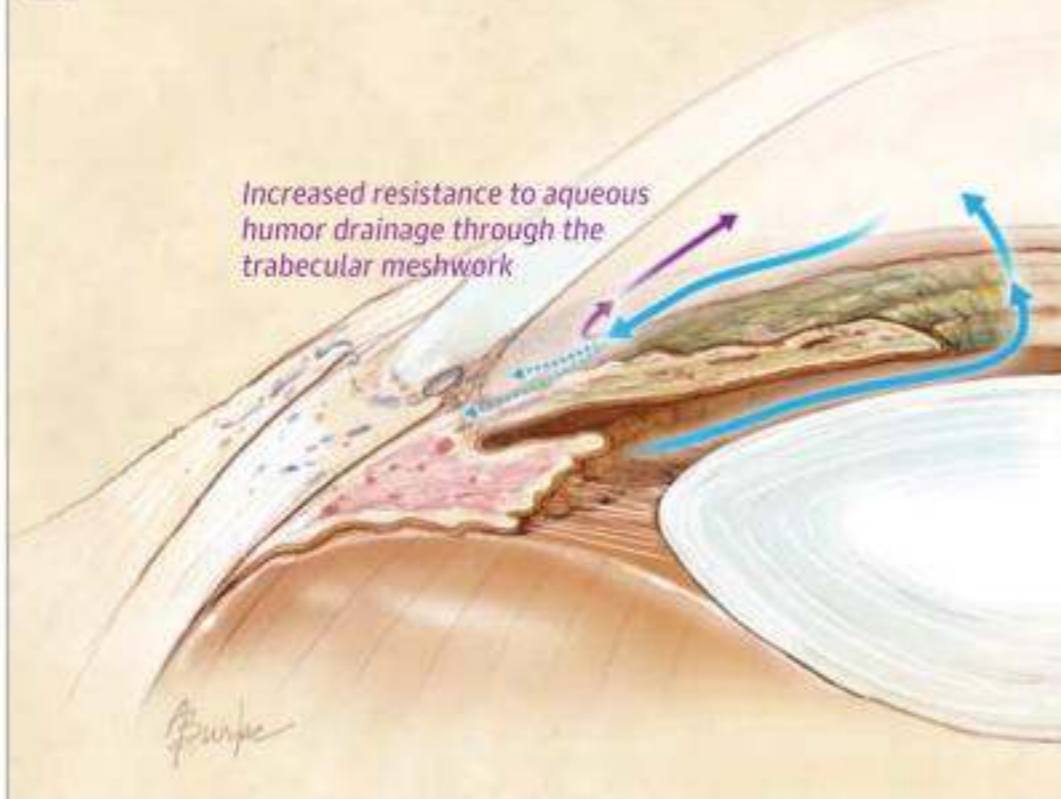
Open angle vs closed angle



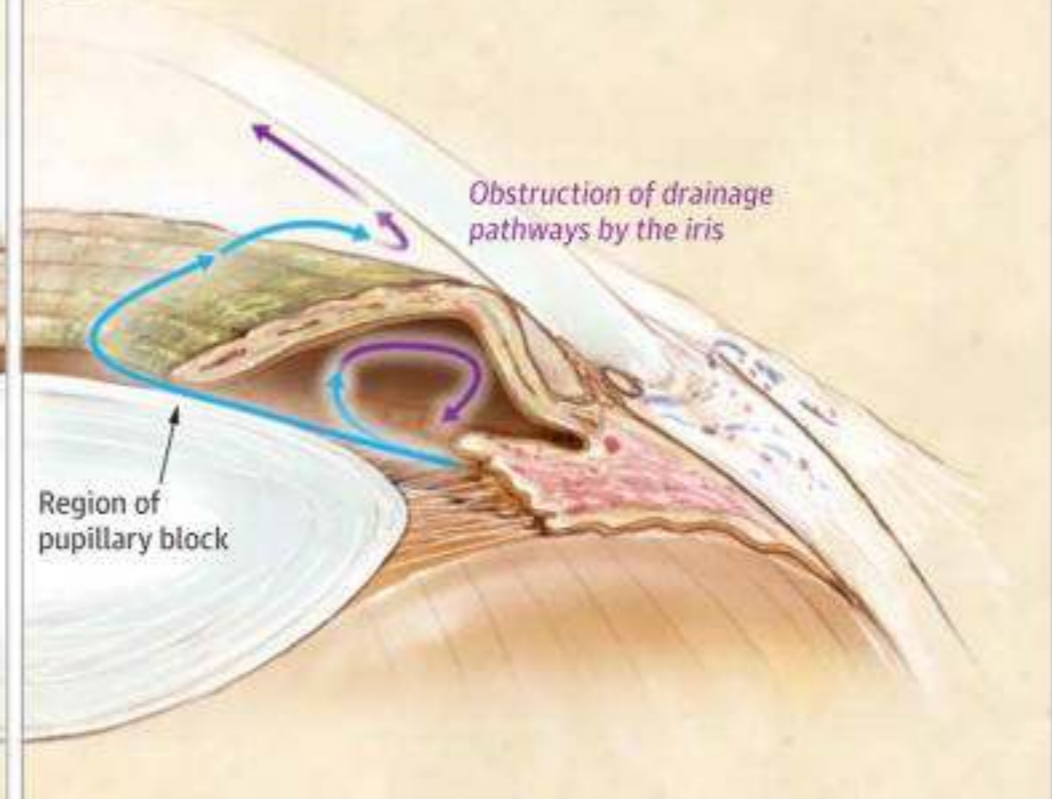
A Anatomy of healthy eye and aqueous humor drainage pathways

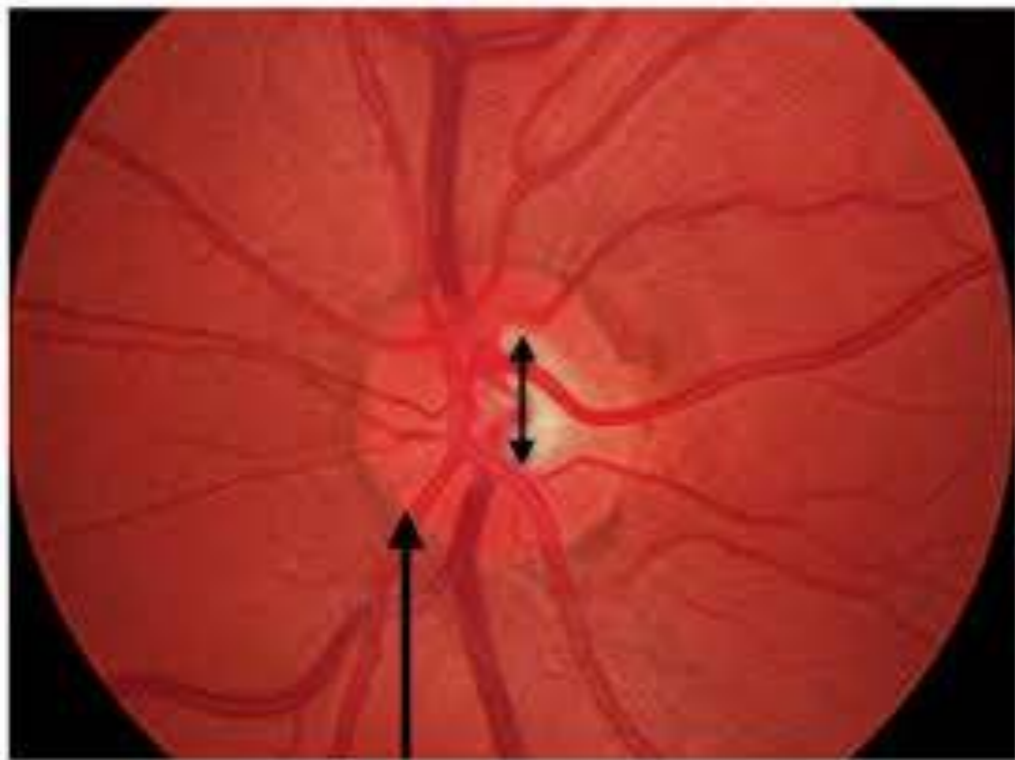


B Primary open-angle glaucoma

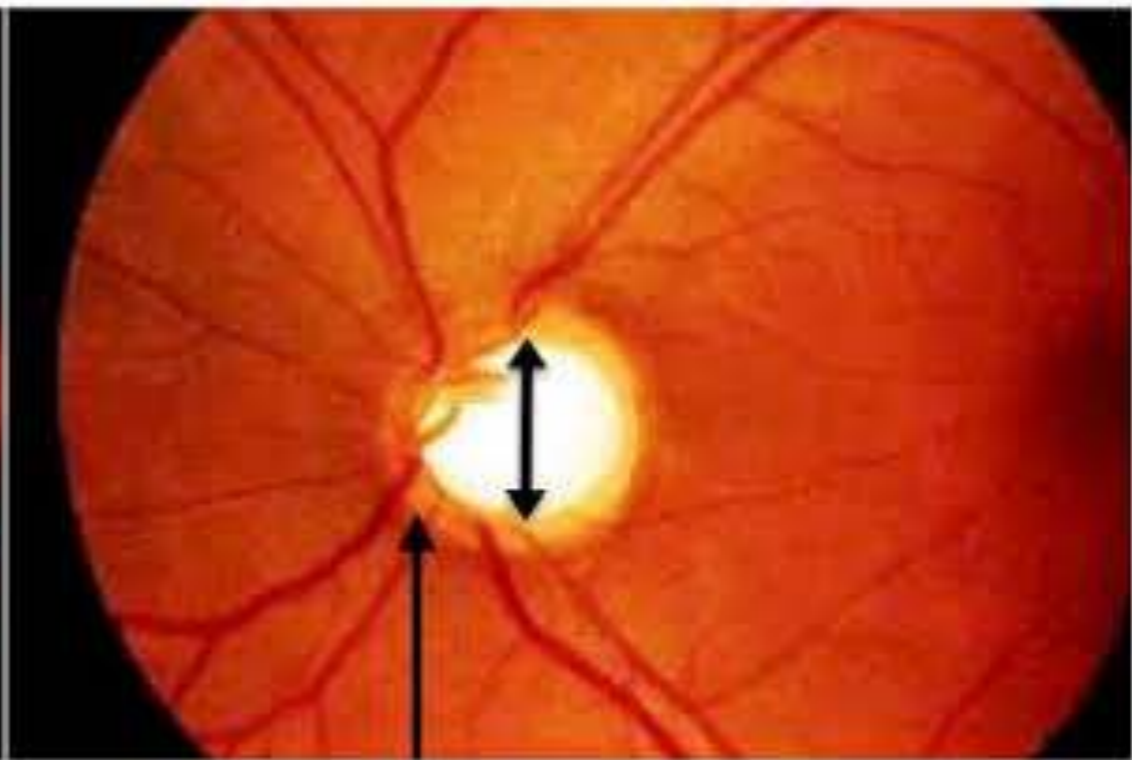


C Primary closed-angle glaucoma

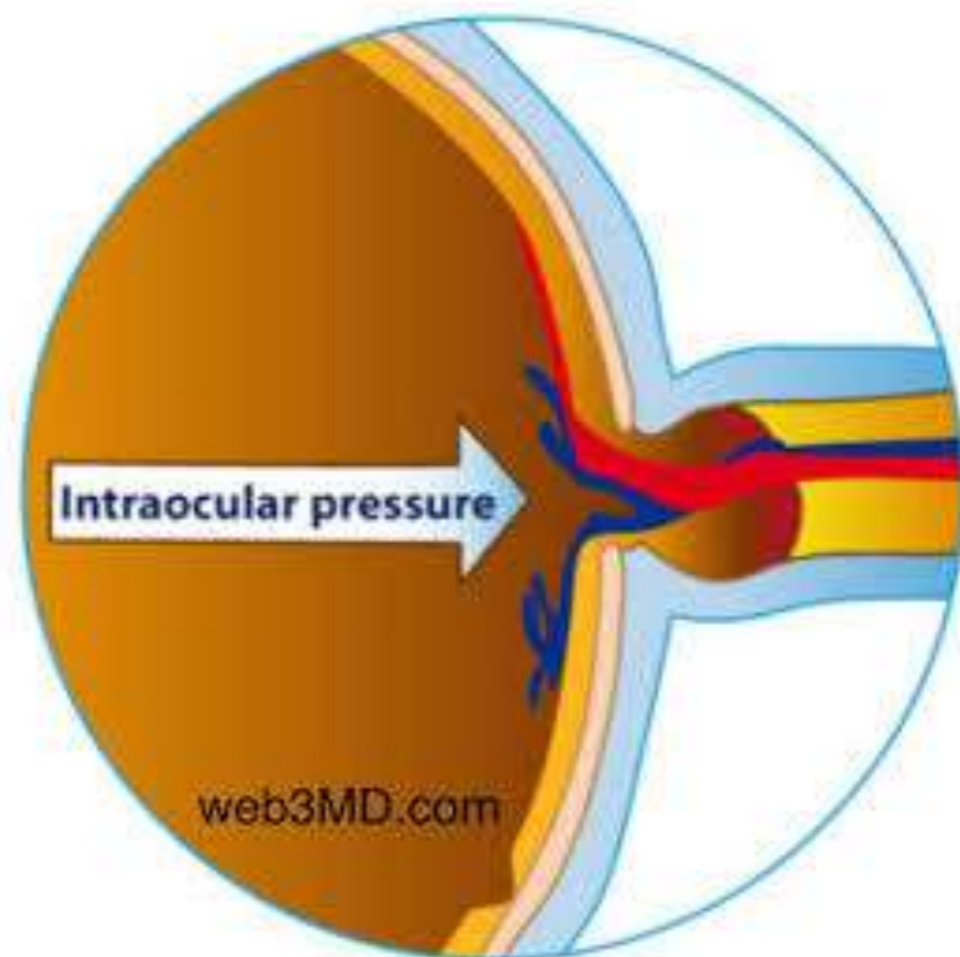
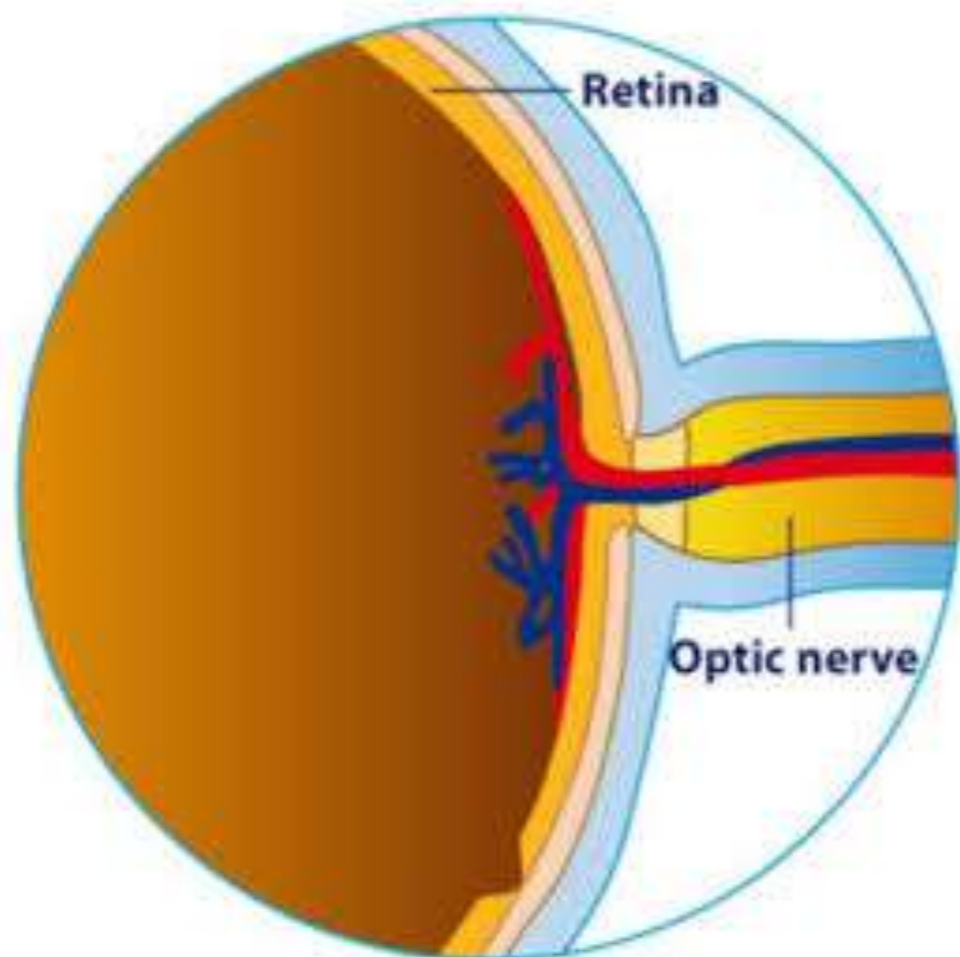




Healthy eye with a normal optic nerve head



Glaucoma eye with glaucomatous cupping of the the nerve head

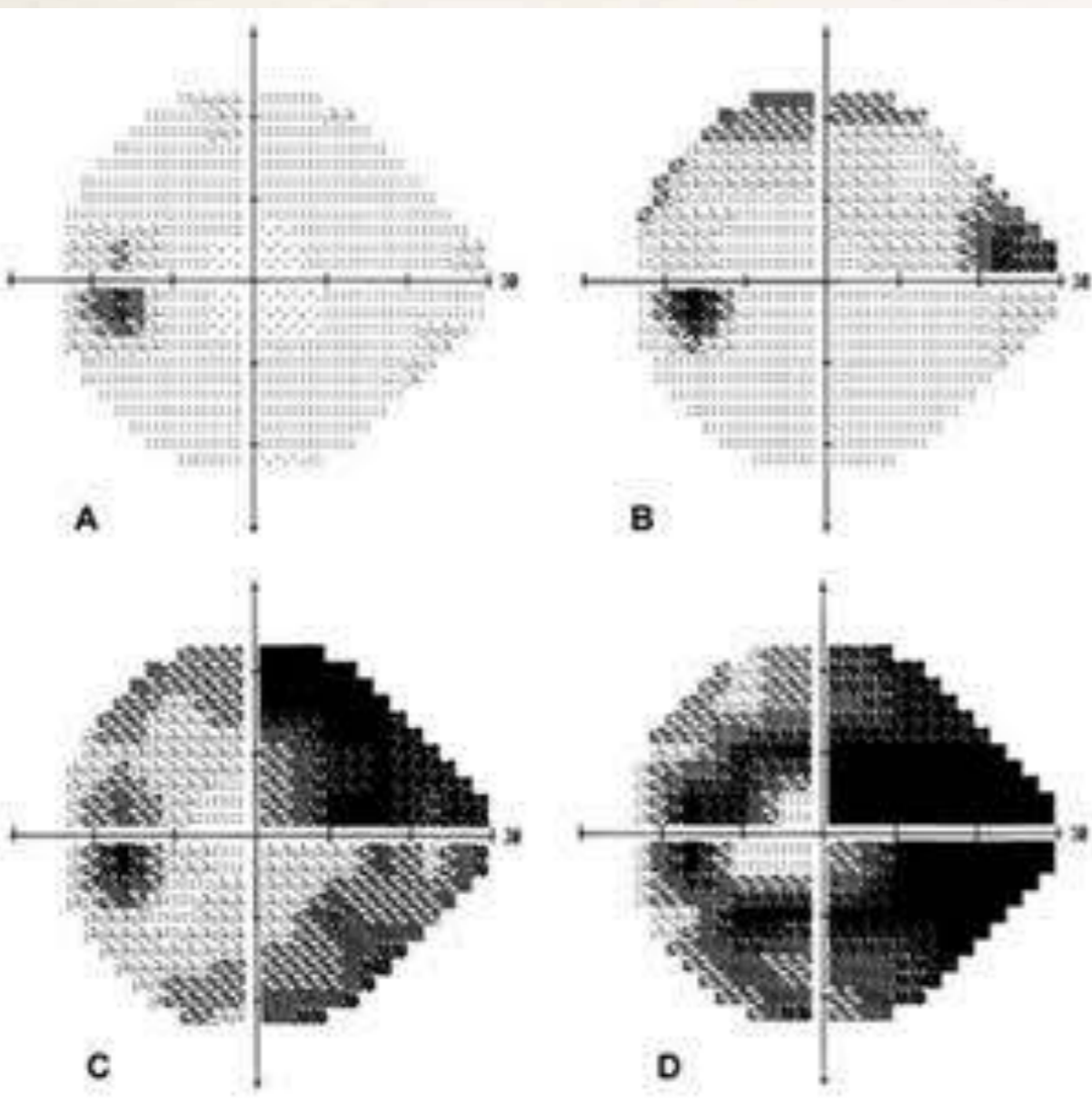

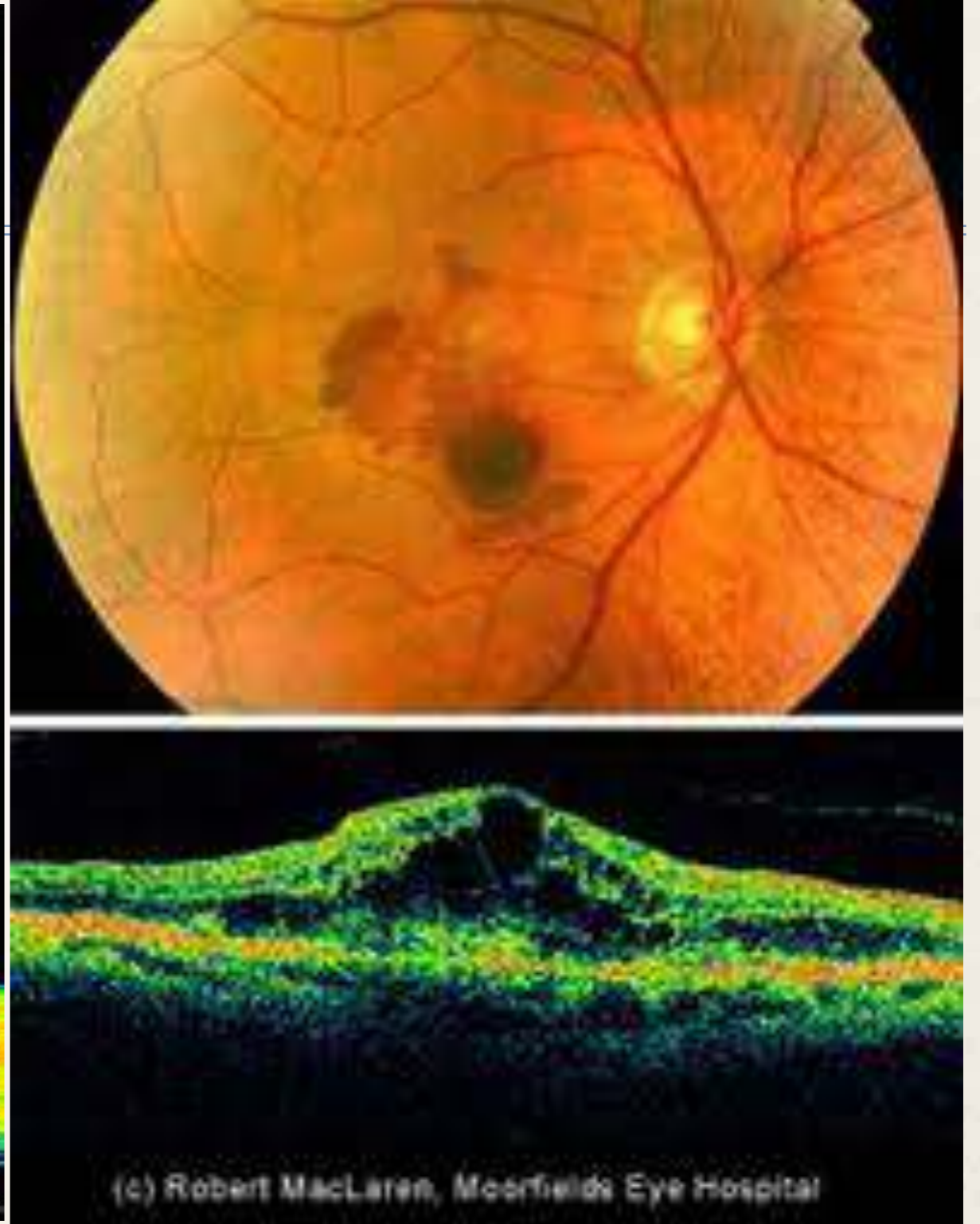
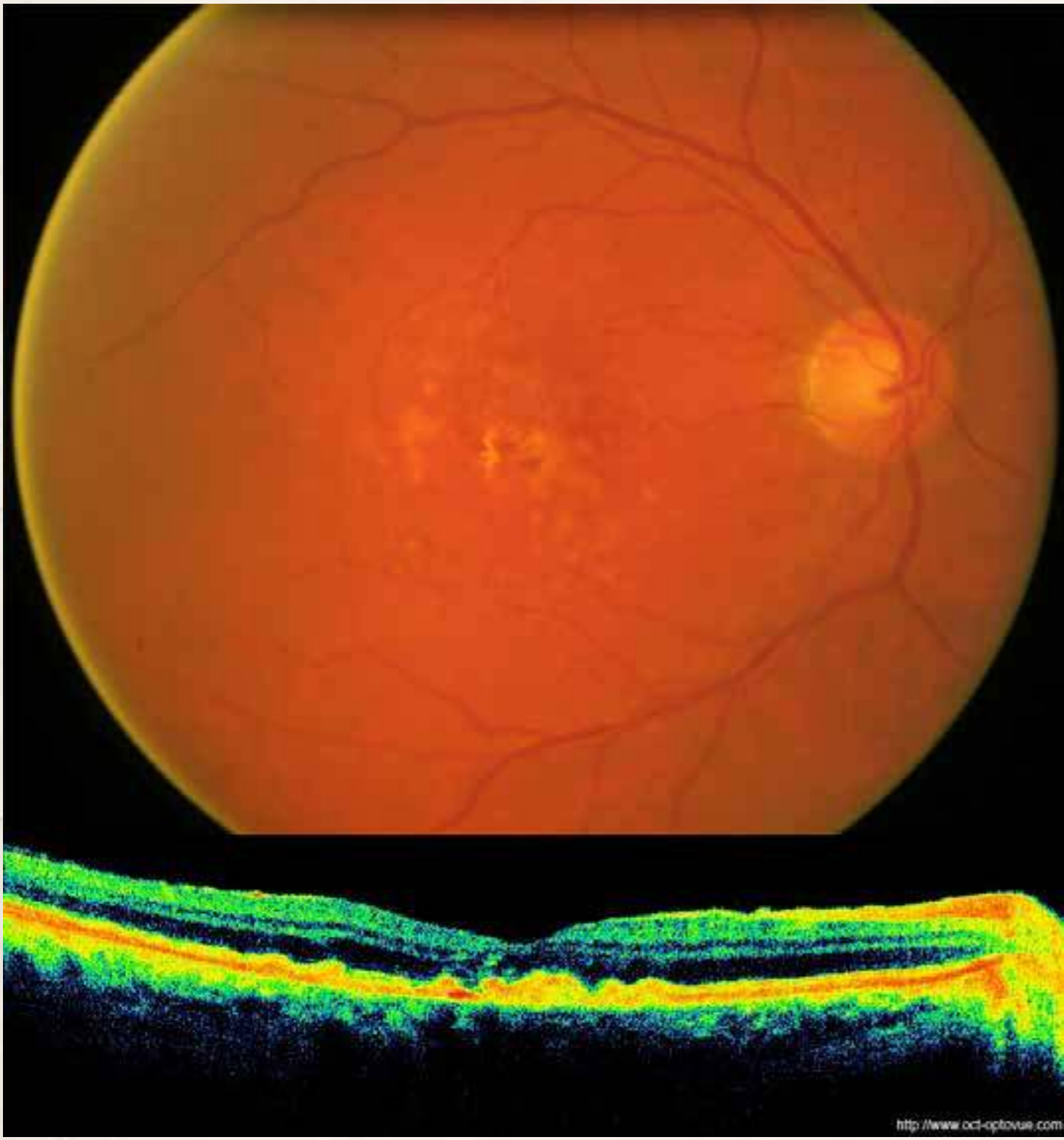
- ❖ Loss of Peripheral vision to complete loss of vision

Symptoms and Treatment

- ❖ Painless often gradual loss of central vision
- ❖ Central scotoma
- ❖ Vitamins ACE, cease smoking, improve diet to slow down the progress of the disease.
- ❖ Intra-ocular injections of anti-VEGF (Vascular Endothelial Growth Factor)
- ❖ Photodynamic therapy, laser photocoagulation

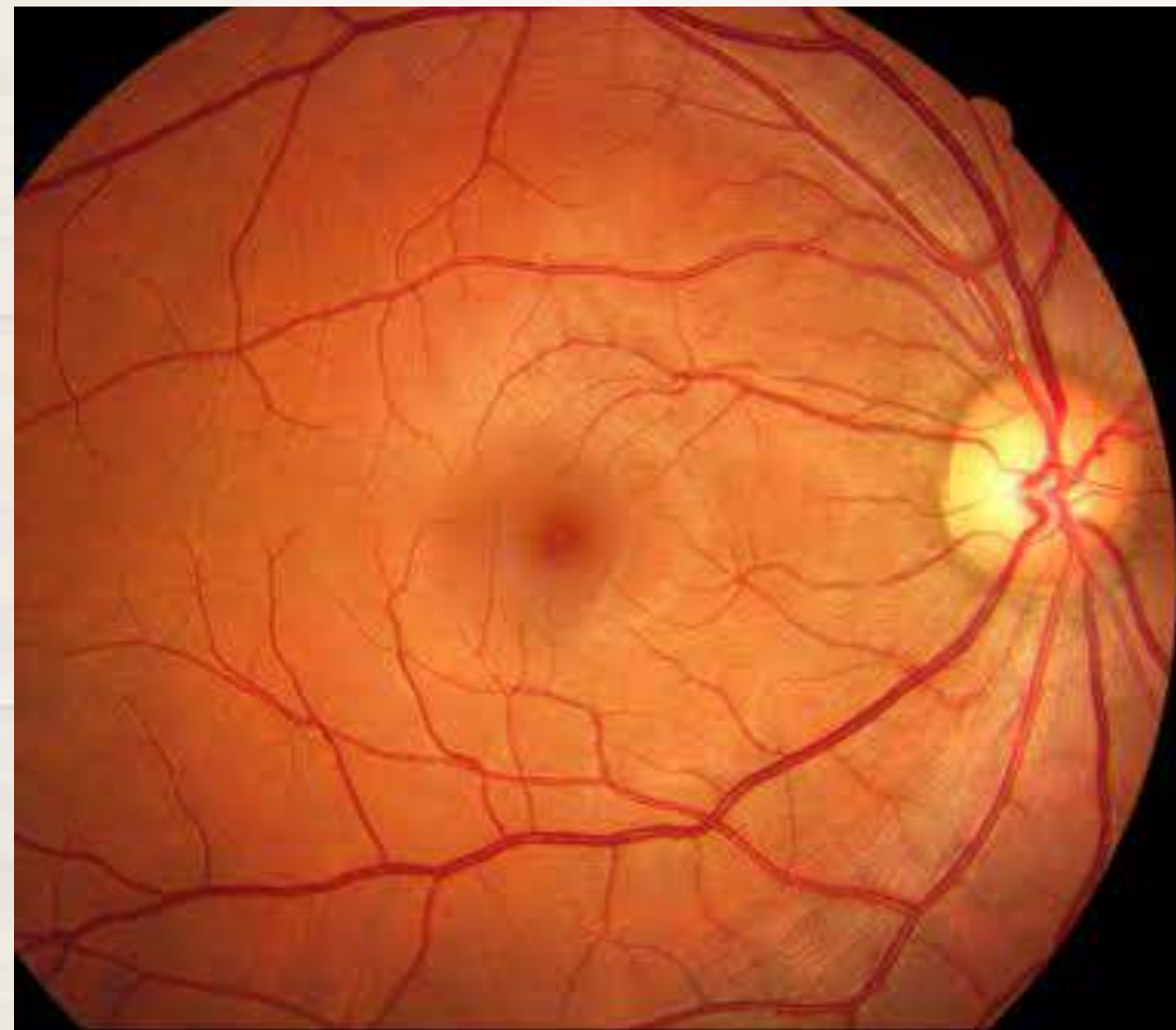


A picture is viewed by an observer while we monitor eye position and hence direction of gaze. The eyes jump, come to rest momentarily (producing a small dot on the record), then jump to a new locus of interest. It seems difficult to jump to a void—a place lacking abrupt luminance changes.

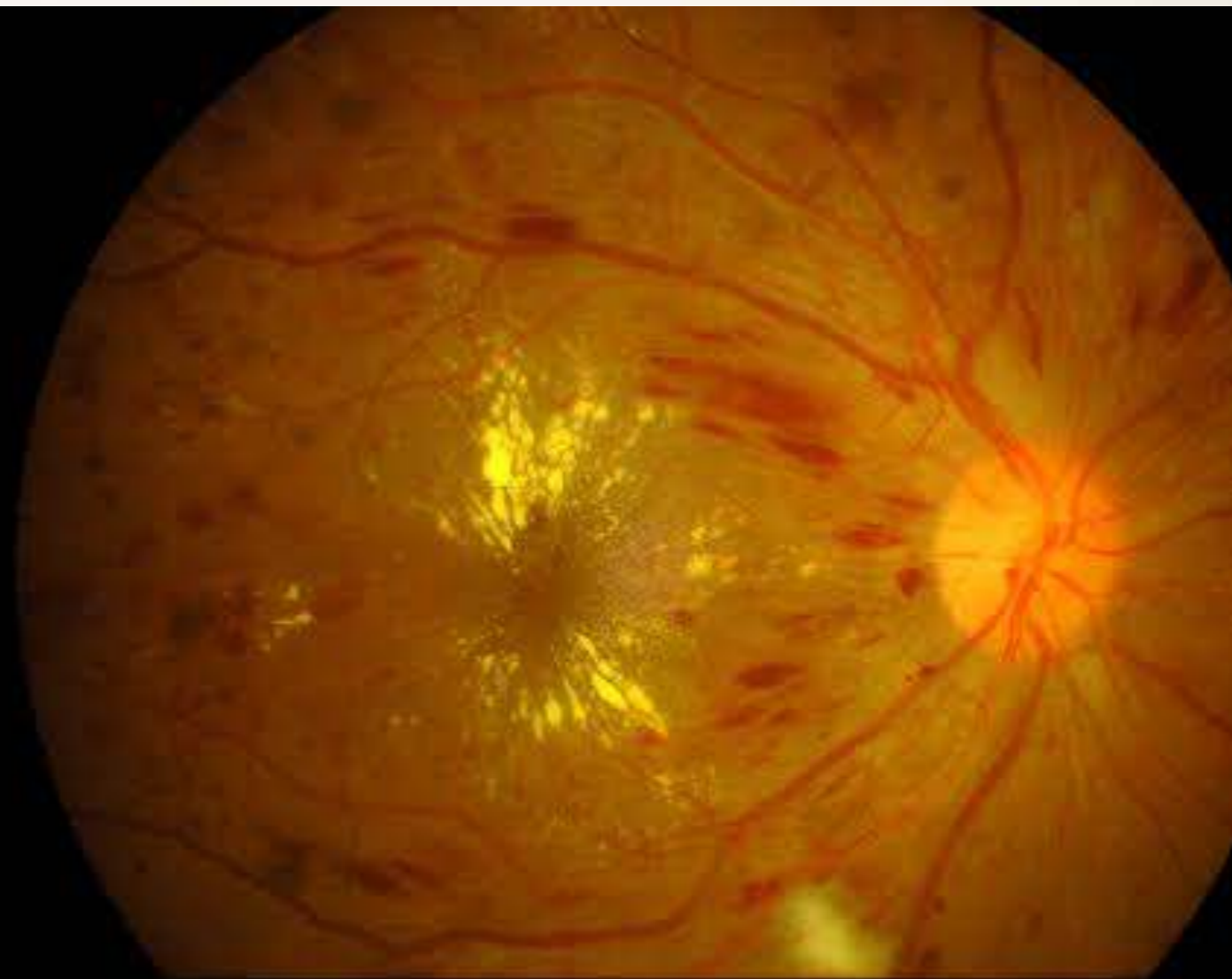

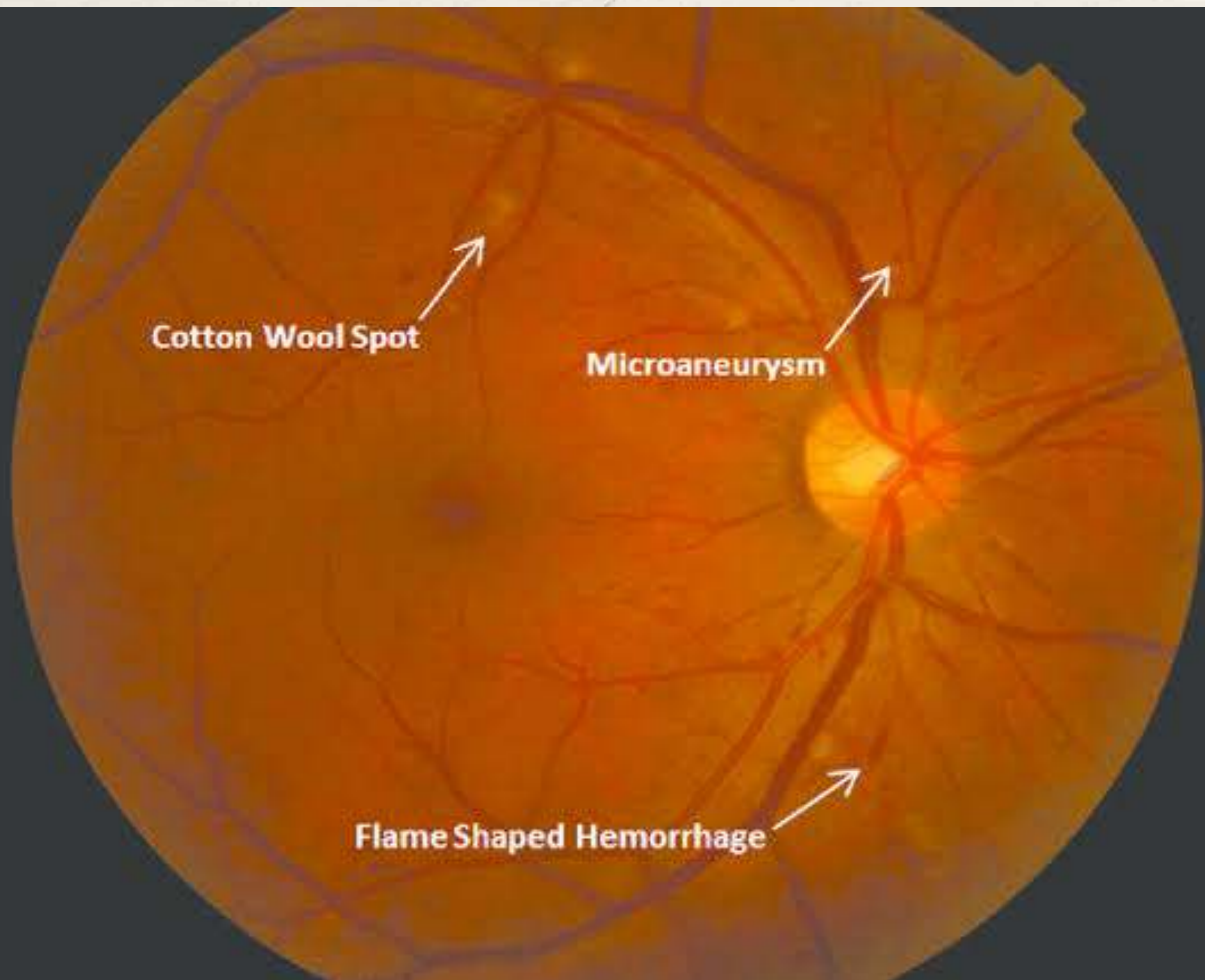

Symptoms and Treatment

- ❖ Loss of vision
- ❖ Gradual unless there is heavy bleeding
- ❖ Good control of BSLs
- ❖ Laser photo-coagulation
- ❖ Anti-VEGF injections
