





HOW TO APPLY


Your application to our Online MBA program will need to include the following:

- Official transcripts from all colleges/ universities attended
- Official TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE Academic scores are required for candidates whose undergraduate instruction was conducted in a language other than English except those candidates with at least two years of full-time work experience in the U.S.
- Two letters of professional recommendation
- □ Resume
- □ Essay/personal statement
- \Box Application fee of \$100 USD

PREREQUISITES:

- Undergraduate degree from an accredited institution of higher learning
- \Box GPA score of 3.0 or higher on a scale of 4.0
- Currently employed with five (5) years of demonstrated leadership experience in a work or professional setting*

*Candidates who do not meet the minimum requirements, may still apply. In these cases, supplemental documentation, such as official GMAT test scores, official professional designations or certifications, or STEM and business degrees may help to strengthen an application portfolio.
