KEY POINTS: MALES

Life Expectancy at birth:

- Life expectancy at birth for **men** in Barnsley in 2015-2017 is **78.1** years; **lower** than the Yorkshire and The Humber and England rates of 78.7 years and 79.6 years respectively.
- The gap in life expectancy at birth for males between Barnsley and England has decreased during the period 2001-2003 to 2015-2017 (from 1.6 years to 1.5 years).
- Barnsley is ranked 87 out of 123 local authorities (where 1 is the best), and is ranked higher than Wakefield, Doncaster and Rotherham.

Healthy Life Expectancy at birth:

- Men, at birth, in Barnsley could expect to live **59.7** years in "good" health (3.7 year **less** than men in England overall).
- The **gap** in healthy life expectancy at birth for males between Barnsley and England has **decreased** by 1.8 years during the period 2009-2011 to 2015-2017 (from 5.5 years to 3.7 years). If recent trends continue, forecasts suggest that the gap could narrow to 2.9 years in six years' time.
- Barnsley is ranked 92 out of 123 local authorities (where 1 is the best); an improvement from 2014-2016 when Barnsley was ranked 103 out of 123. Barnsley's 2015-2017 rank is higher than Rotherham and Wakefield.



KEY POINTS: FEMALES

Life Expectancy at birth:


- Life expectancy at birth for women in Barnsley in 2015-2017 is 81.9 years; lower than the Yorkshire and The Humber and England rates of 82.4 years and 83.1 years respectively.
- The **gap** in life expectancy at birth for females between Barnsley and England has **increased slightly** during the period 2001-2003 to 2015-2017 (from 1.1 years to 1.2 years).
- Barnsley is ranked 88 out of 123 local authorities (where 1 is the best); an improvement from 2014-2016 when Barnsley was ranked 90 out of 123. Barnsley's 2015-2017 female rank is higher than Wakefield, Doncaster and Rotherham.

Healthy Life Expectancy at birth:

- Women, at birth, in Barnsley could expect to live 61.0 years in "good" health (2.8 year less than women in England overall).
- The gap in healthy life expectancy at birth for females between Barnsley and England has decreased by 3.6 years during the period 2009-2011 to 2015-2017 (from 6.4 years to 2.8 years). If recent trends continue, forecasts suggest that the gap could narrow to 0.2 years in six years' time.
- Barnsley is ranked 77 out of 123 local authorities (where 1 is the best); an improvement from 2014-2016 when Barnsley was ranked 91 out of 123. Barnsley's 2015-2017 rank is higher than Sheffield, Rotherham and Wakefield.










Life expectancy at birth (2015-2017 rankings)

Males:

Barnsley is ranked **87** out of 123 Unitary Authorities, Metropolitan and London Boroughs in England (where 1 is the best). This is a **decline** from 2014-2016 when Barnsley was ranked **79** out of 123. Barnsley's 2015-2017 male ranking is **higher** than Wakefield (ranked 91), Doncaster (92) and Rotherham (95).

Females:


Barnsley is ranked **88** out of 123 Unitary Authorities, Metropolitan and London Boroughs in England (where 1 is the best). This is an **improvement** from 2014-2016 when Barnsley was ranked **90** out of 123. Barnsley's 2015-2017 female ranking is **higher** than Wakefield (ranked 91), Doncaster (94) and Rotherham (95).





Trend in healthy life expectancy at birth for <u>males</u> in Barnsley, Yorkshire and The Humber and England: 2009-2011 to 2015-2017




Trend in healthy life expectancy at birth for <u>females</u> in Barnsley, Yorkshire and The Humber and England: 2009-2011 to 2015-2017






Trend in healthy life expectancy at birth for <u>males</u> in Barnsley, Yorkshire and The Humber and England: 2009-2011 to 2015-2017






Trend in healthy life expectancy at birth for <u>females</u> in Barnsley, Yorkshire and The Humber and England: 2009-2011 to 2015-2017




Trend in healthy life expectancy at birth for <u>males</u> in Barnsley and England: 2009-2011 to 2015-2017 with forecasts to 2021-2023

Healthy life expectancy at birth (2015-2017 rankings)

Males:

Barnsley is ranked **92** out of 123 Unitary Authorities, Metropolitan and London Boroughs in England (where 1 is the best). This is an **improvement** from 2014-2016 when Barnsley was ranked **103** out of 123. Barnsley's 2015-2017 male ranking is **higher** than Rotherham (ranked 100) and Wakefield (103), but lower than Doncaster (68).

Females:

Barnsley is ranked **77** out of 123 Unitary Authorities, Metropolitan and London Boroughs in England (where 1 is the best). This is an **improvement** from 2014-2016 when Barnsley was ranked **91** out of 123. Barnsley's 2015-2017 female ranking is **higher** than Sheffield (ranked 88), Rotherham (116) and Wakefield (121), but slightly lower than Doncaster (75).
