The data provided in this form assists UNC in maintaining records of admitted and enrolled students. Students requesting a Certificate of Eligibility Form I-20 (for F-1 status) or DS-2019 (for J-1 status) must complete Parts I and II of this form. United States federal regulations require certification that you have sufficient funds to pay for your tuition and living expenses at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill for the duration of your studies. A Form I-20 or DS-2019 can be issued only after this certificate and proof of financial support has been received. A copy of the identification page of the passport you will use to enter the U.S. is also required. Students already in F-1 or J-1 status at another U.S. school must also submit a Financial Certificate and supporting documentation in order to be issued a UNC-Chapel Hill Form I-20 or DS-2019.

Go to https://connectcarolina.unc.edu/ and log in with your Onyen and password. Required materials will be listed on your To Do List until you submit them.
