Synonyms- Attendant, collateral, linked.
Antonyms- Unassociated, unconnected, unrelated.
Usage- *She loved travel, with all its concomitant worries.*
- ⤴ **EXCORIATE (ADJECTIVE)** Criticize (someone) severely.
आलोचना करना
Synonyms- Assail, castigate, lambaste.
Antonyms- Acclaim, laud, praise, glorify.
Usage- *He excoriated the government for censorship.*



- ⤴ **PROFFER (VERB)** Hold out or put forward (something) to someone for acceptance.

Synonyms- Extend, offer, tender, propose

Antonyms- Decline, deny, disallow, disapprove

Usage- *She proffered a glass of wine.*

Usage- *Dogs which have been mistreated often remain very wary of strangers.*
-  **ACCOLADE (NOUN)** An award or privilege granted as a special honour or as an acknowledgement of merit.

Synonyms- Honour, recognition, privilege, award
Antonyms- Denunciation, criticism
Usage- *The hotel has won numerous accolades.*
