The eleventh grade program uses, *The Catholic Faith Handbook for Youth*, *Third Edition* (CFH) is a comprehensive overview of the Catholic faith, in conformity with the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. Its thirty-nine chapters cover the Creed, liturgy and Sacraments, Christian morality, and prayer. The main text of each chapter presents a particular topic of the Catholic faith. They sidebar articles in the chapter enhance the main text by connecting the topic of prayer, catholic saints, Catholic history, and lived faith. This guide provides the teaching process for the catechist to use in covering each chapter's content and connecting it to young people's life experiences.
