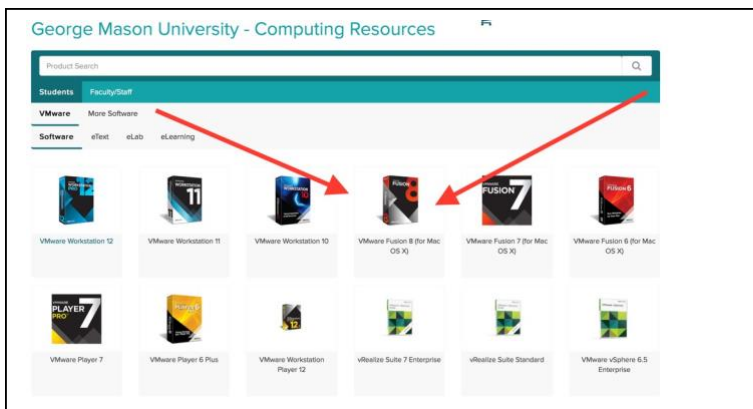
#### Registering and Installing VMware Fusion on a Macintosh

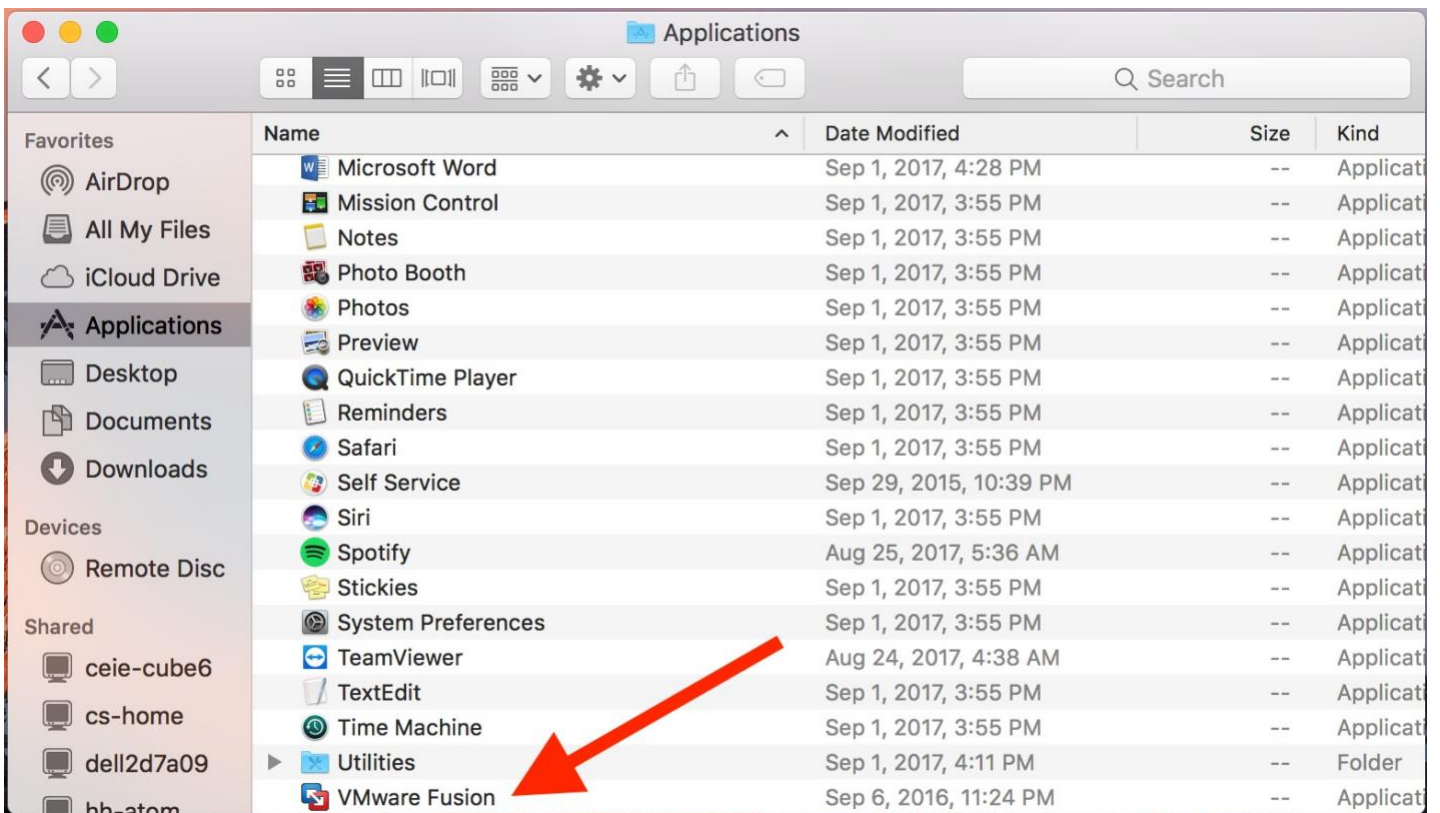
To access the Windows virtual machine after installation Run VMware by clicking on Finder



Click on Applications



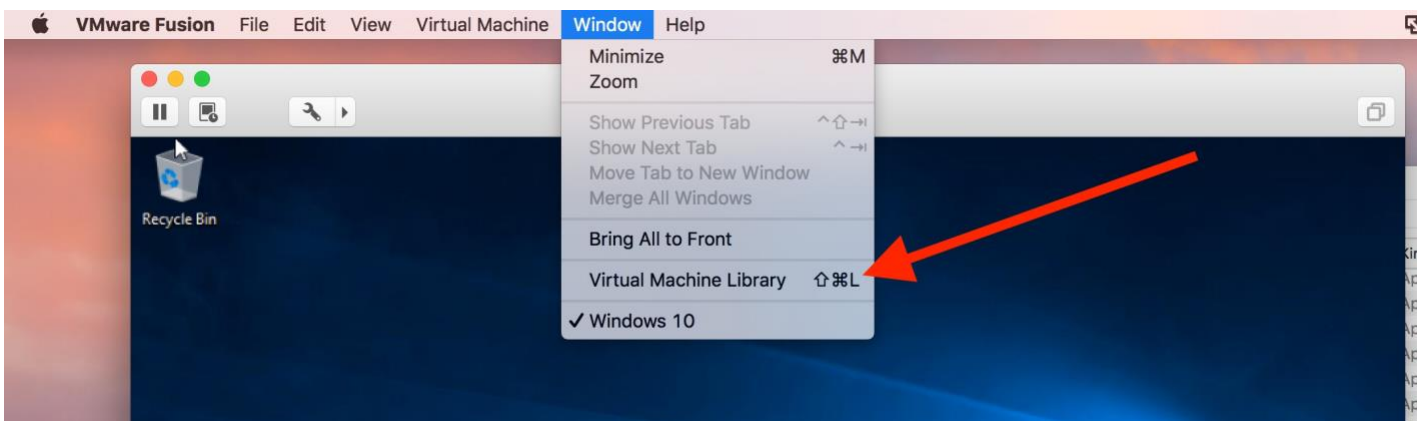
Double click WMware
