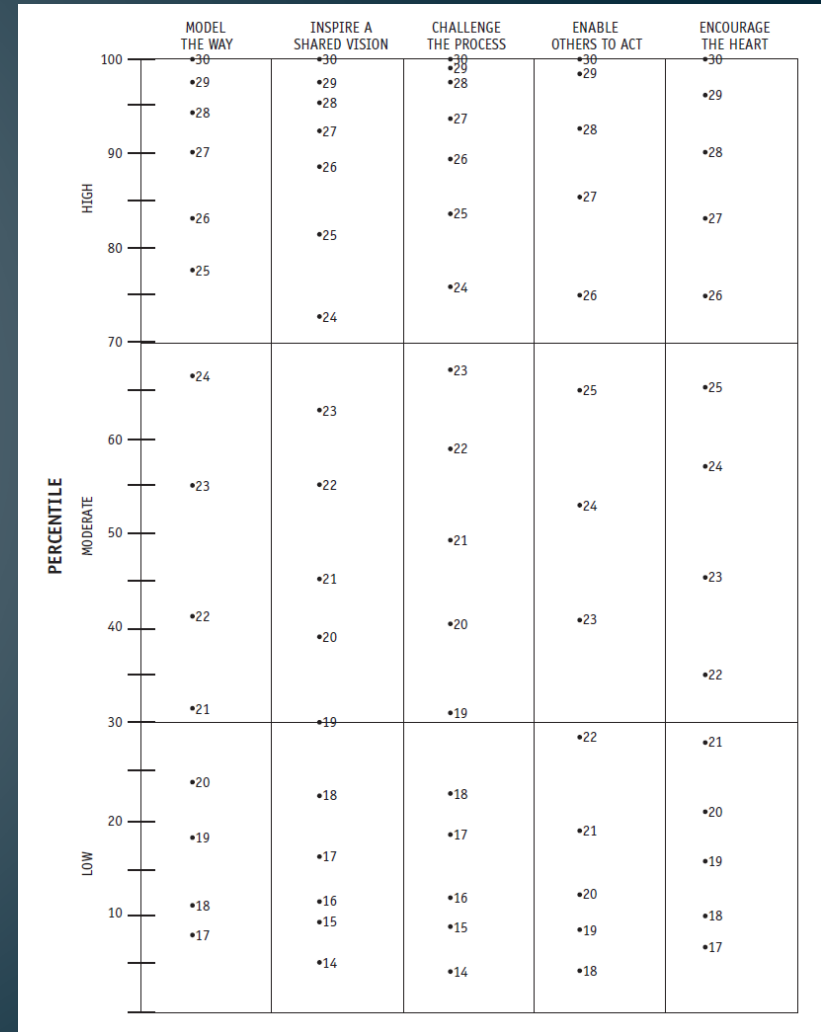

# Enable Others to Act

- Learn to delegate
- Ask questions
- Listen
- Take Advice
- Foster Collaboration
- Strengthen Others
  - Accept paradox of power: Student leaders *become most powerful when they give their power away!*

# Encourage the Heart

- Make people feel connected to the organization through praise and awards
  - Honor and respect the unique contributions of each team member
- Celebration is key!
