Isolation Cart Checklist

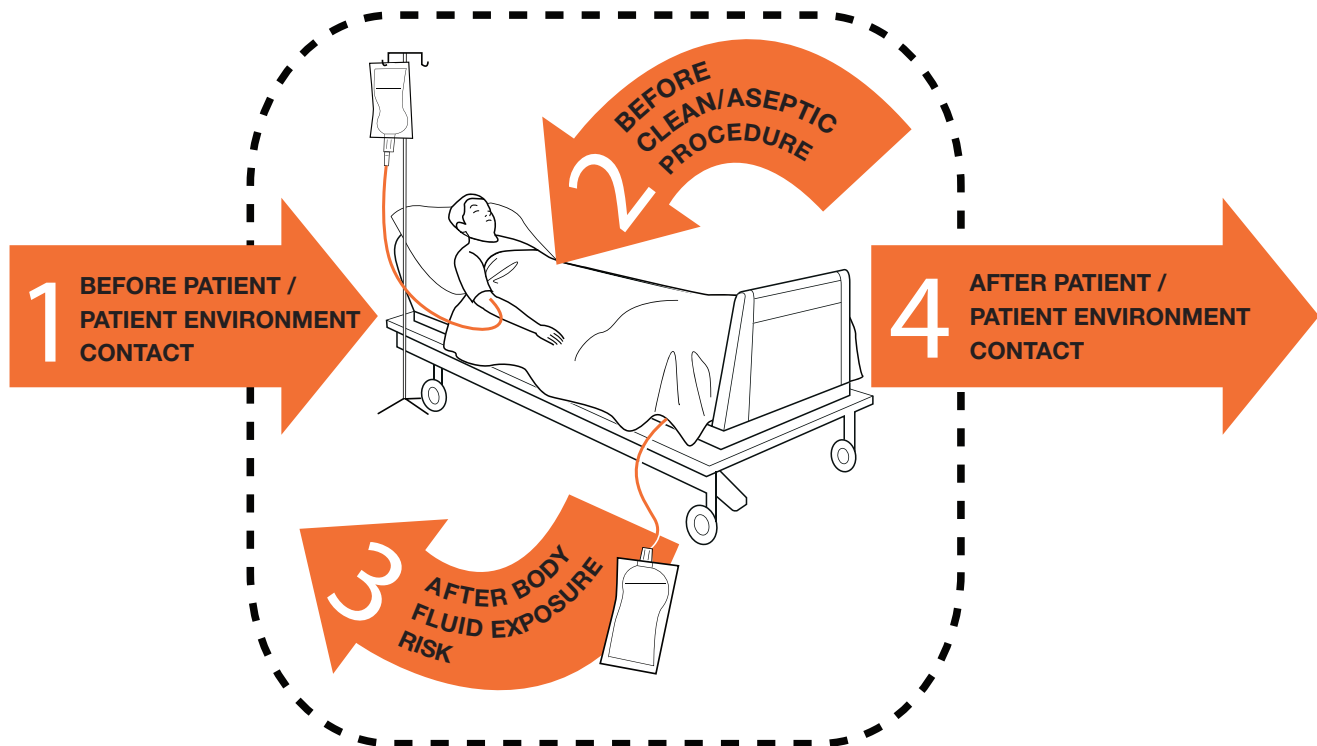
Gloves	Latex or Nitrile	Small, Medium, Large
Isolation Gowns	Reusable or Disposable	
Disposable Aprons		
Masks	Procedure or Surgical	
Eye/Face Protection	Disposable Safety Glasses	Goggles (optional), Full Face Shield (optional)
Disinfectant Wipes	SANI-CLOTH® PLUS or ACCEL TB Wipes®	Use Accelerated Hydrogen Peroxide (e.g. Accel TB Wipes®) for suspected Norovirus
Alcohol-Based Hand Rub	Isagel® or Approved Replacement	

Inside Patient Room: Linen hamper, garbage can, alcohol based hand rub near exit, antimicrobial soap at sink

Cleaning Requirements: Special Precautions

Daily Clean	Standard cleaning procedures
Terminal Clean	Double clean using facility approved disinfectant unless otherwise specified by Infection Control
