KINDERGARTEN READINESS CAMP (ENTERING KINDERGARTEN)

Y DAY CAMPS (ENTERING GRADES 1-6)

Children spend time indoors and outdoors as experienced staff lead campers in a wide variety of activities each day, including nature, water fun, games, weekly off-site field trips, sports, instructional/recreational swimming, arts and crafts, and new friendships.
