

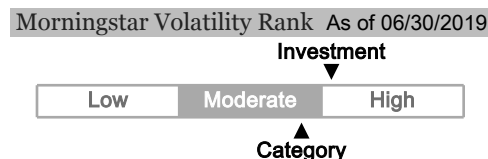

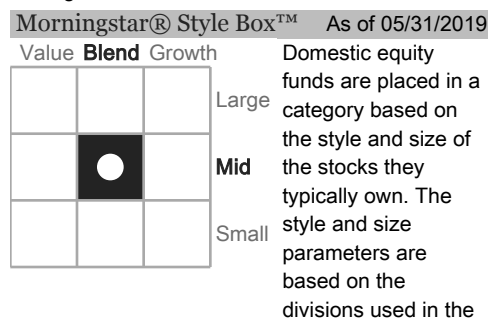

Description / Objective

The investment seeks to provide a high level of income and moderate long-term capital appreciation by tracking the performance of the MSCI US Investable Market Real Estate 25/50 Index that measures the performance of publicly traded equity REITs and other real estate-related investments. The advisor attempts to track the index by investing all, or substantially all, of its assets—either directly or indirectly through a wholly owned subsidiary, which is itself a registered investment company—in the stocks that make up the index, holding each stock in approximately the same proportion as its weighting in the index. The fund is non-diversified. There is no assurance the objectives will be met.

Sector funds are subject to risks within their specific sectors because they concentrate their investments in securities of companies within certain industries. Therefore, the price of these securities can be volatile.
