Age Distribution


29 and Under - 9% -50-59 - 34%30-39 - 19%- 60-64 – 9%

- Encourage continuous learning and professional growth across all levels of the DoD FM workforce


Requirements

- Course-based training in FM and Leadership competencies
- DoD-specific training in Ethics, Audit Readiness, and Fiscal Law
- Specified number of years of FM Experience and DoD FM Experience
- At Level 3, one Developmental Assignment to gain experience outside primary expertise
- Continuing Education and Training (CET) to keep skills sharp






