 - Google Scholar
 - Microsoft Academic Search
- By type
 - Open access, repositories
 - Theses
 - Books
 - Images
 - Statistics
 - Datasets
 - Discipline-specific



Google Scholar

<http://scholar.google.com>

- All disciplines (including humanities); variety of formats e.g. articles, papers, books, open access materials, IRs
- Good for locating material that may fall between disciplines (e.g. *How people remember music/melodies*)
- Good for identifying which subject-specific databases to use – use as a back door
- Can limit by author, publication etc. (use Advanced Search option)
- Can link to library holdings
- Cited by feature; can save to Endnote, etc.
- No listing of what is included; not clear how often it is updated
- Too many irrelevant items may be retrieved – cannot fine-tune search as with a database search

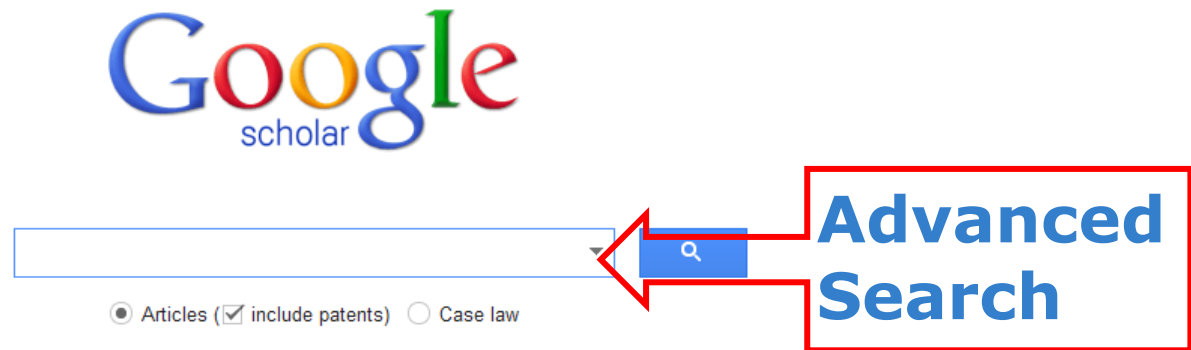

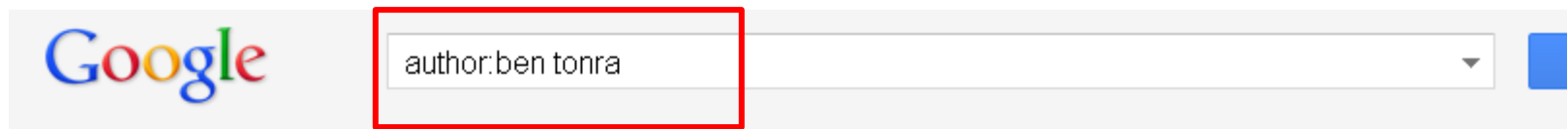

- Good sorting functionality e.g. in Author Profile, by year and citation count; can export to Endnote
- Author may have several different profiles & articles may be assigned to wrong author

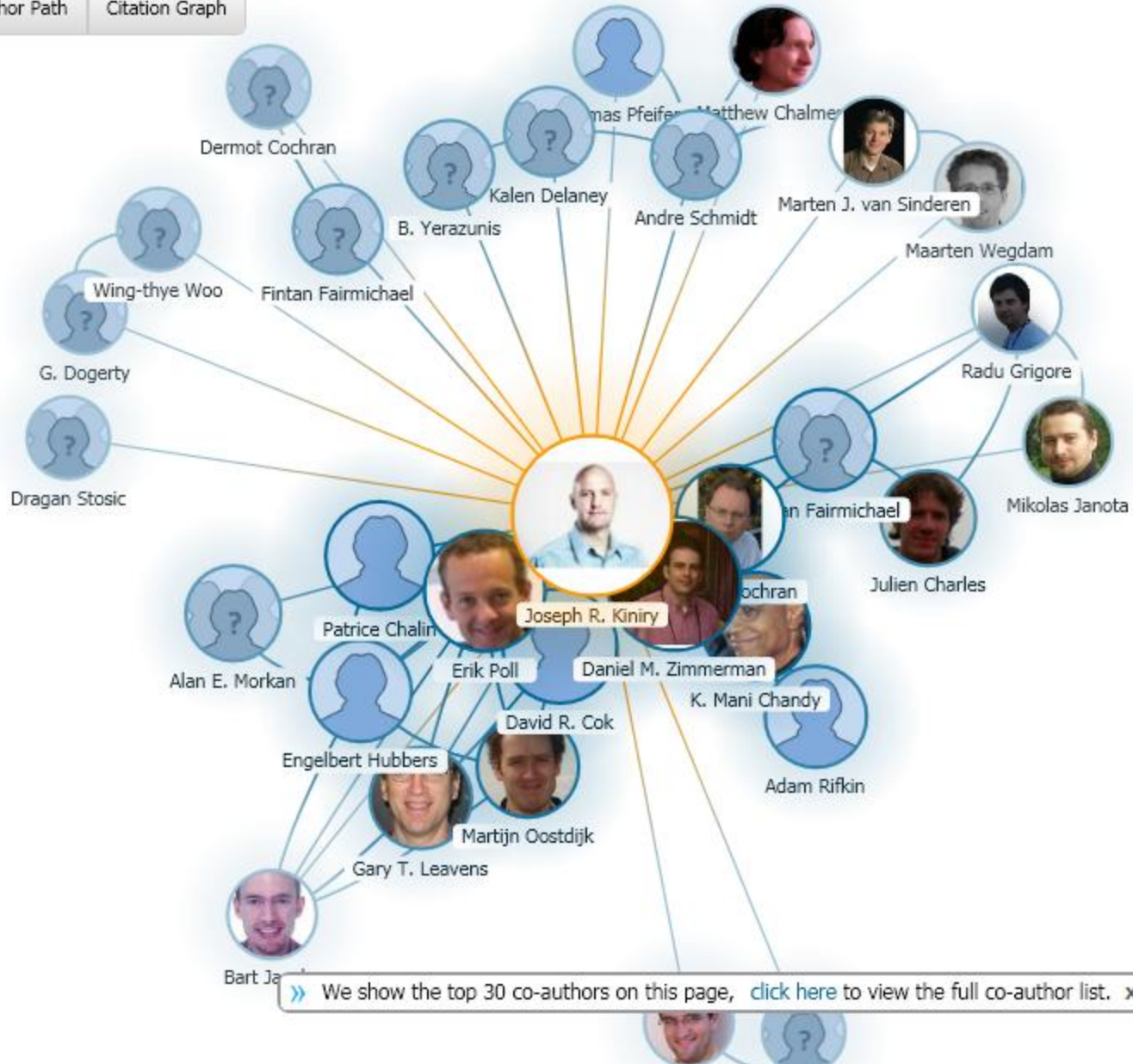

- “...one of the world's most voluminous search engines especially for academic open access web resources” (not so good for humanities)
- It sources high quality content from around 2,500 repositories from journals, conference proceedings, patents & theses. Worldwide (so not largely U.S.)
- It enables deep searching of full text documents
- Can save to Endnote, etc.
