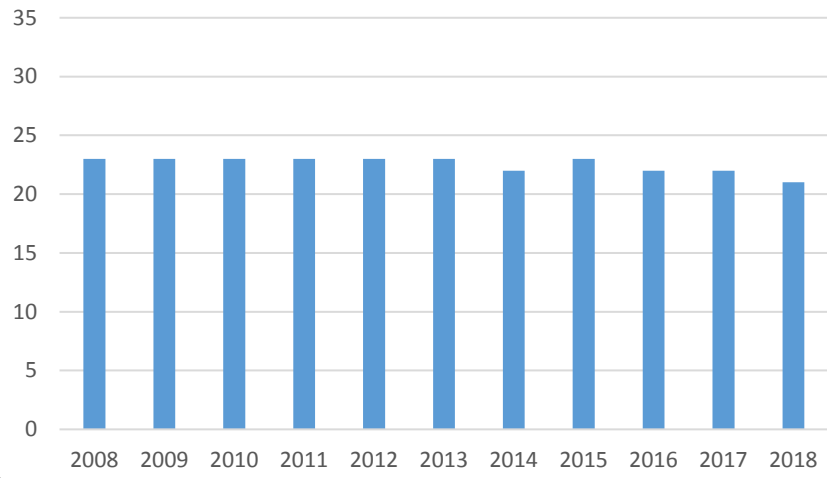

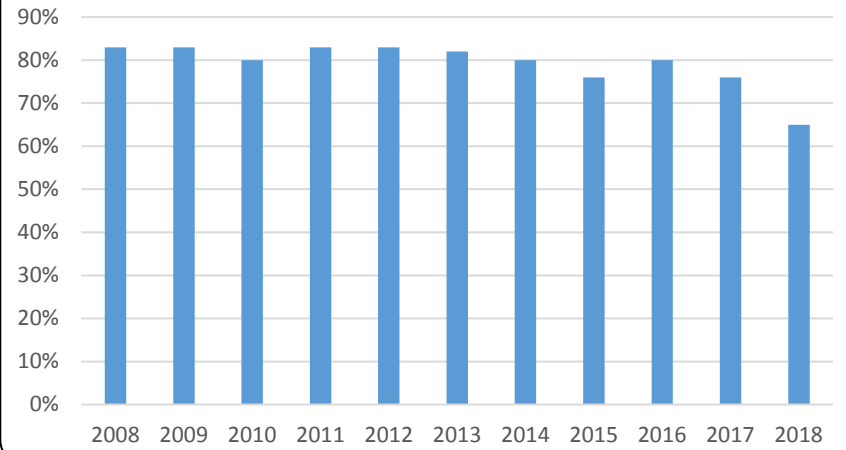

Percent Students with ACT Composite Scores of 20 or Higher

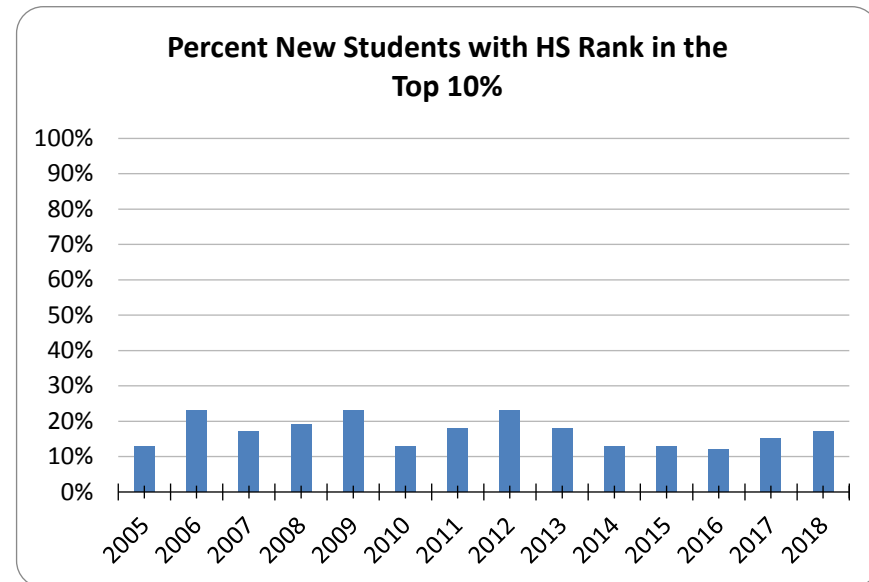
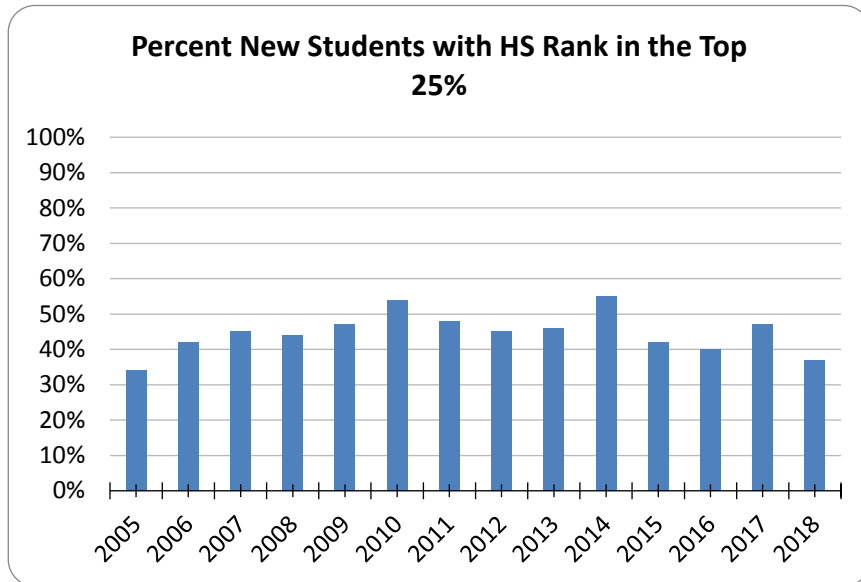
