

## Windows 10

To Log in “NSU” follow these steps:

1. From the Desktop, click on the Network Connections icon in the Windows Taskbar (looks like a series of signal bars).



2. Choose “NSU” from the list of available wireless networks.



3. In the panel that appears, check the box "**Connect automatically**" then click the "**Connect**" box. *This will ensure that the next time you are in the network range you will be automatically connected.*



4. Enter your NSU username and password and click **OK**.



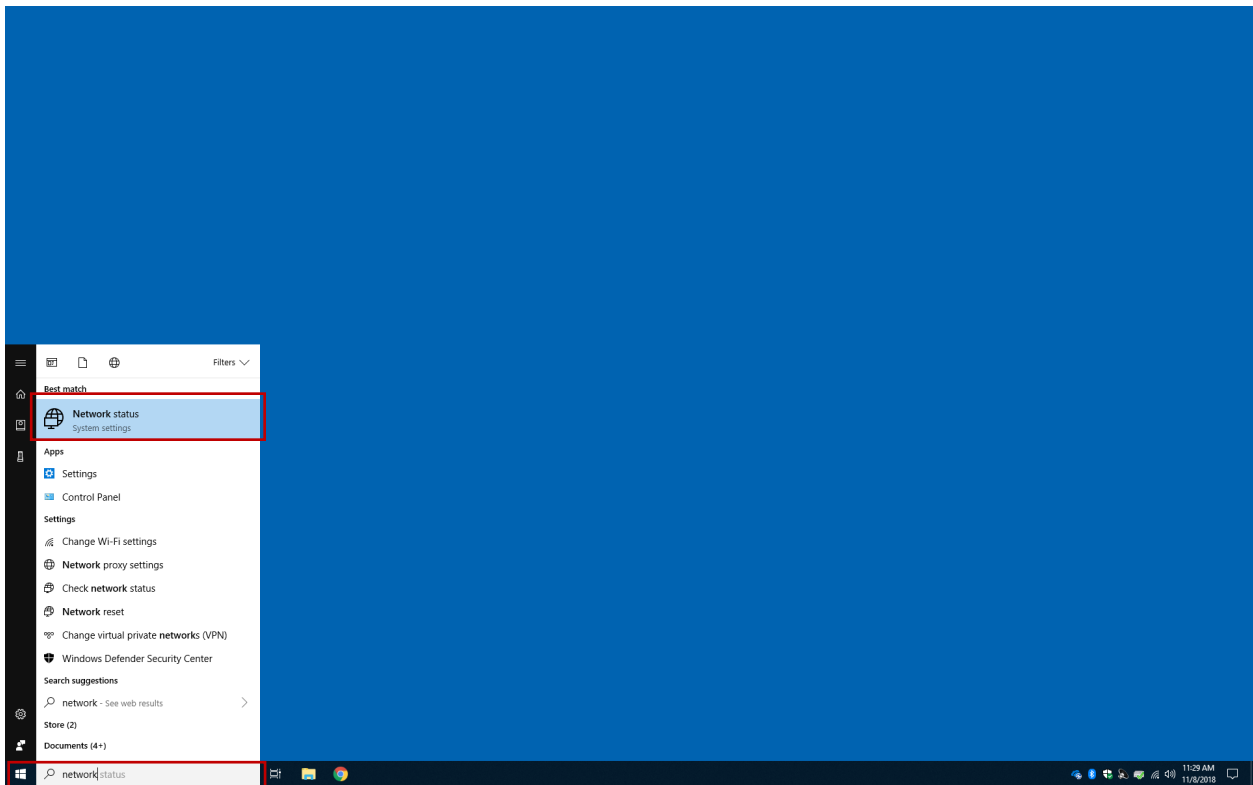
5. The first time you connect you might get the message about the location of the network (an issue related to the certificate). Click "**Connect**" to accept the server's certificate. After that, authentication will be automatic.



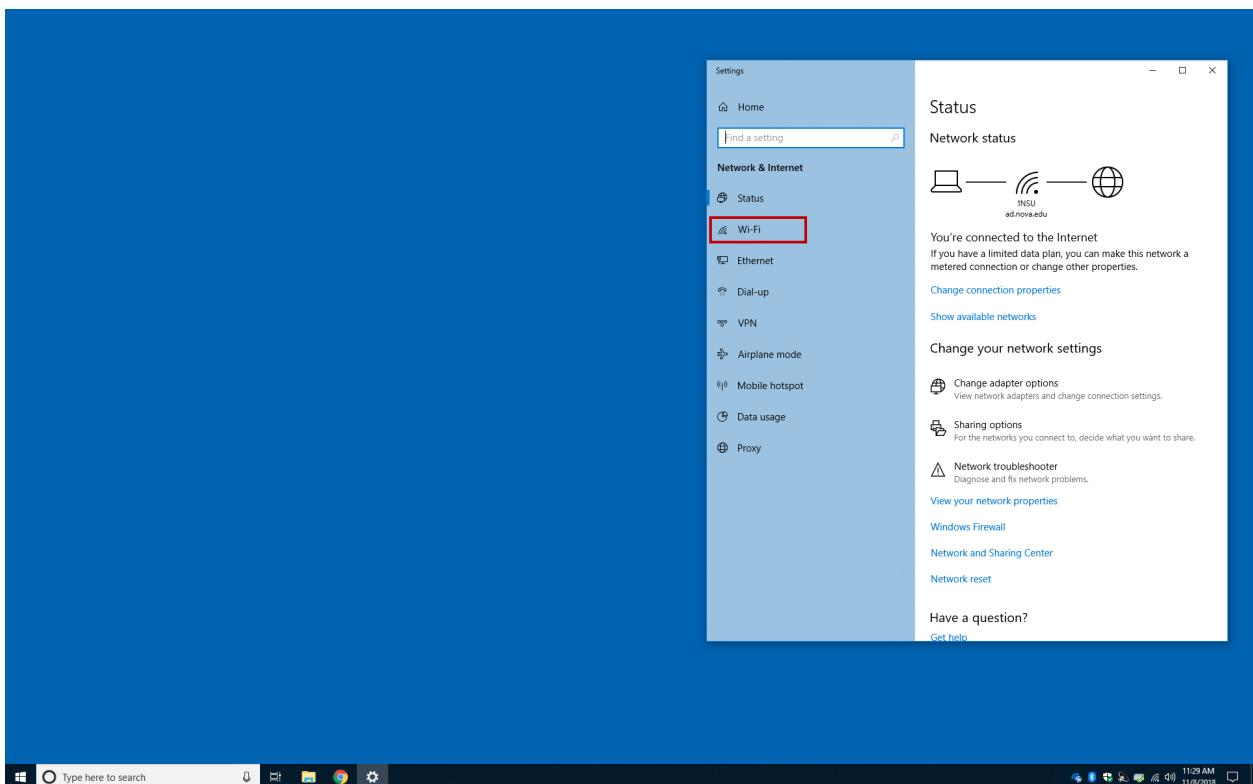


## Forget Wireless Profiles Windows 10

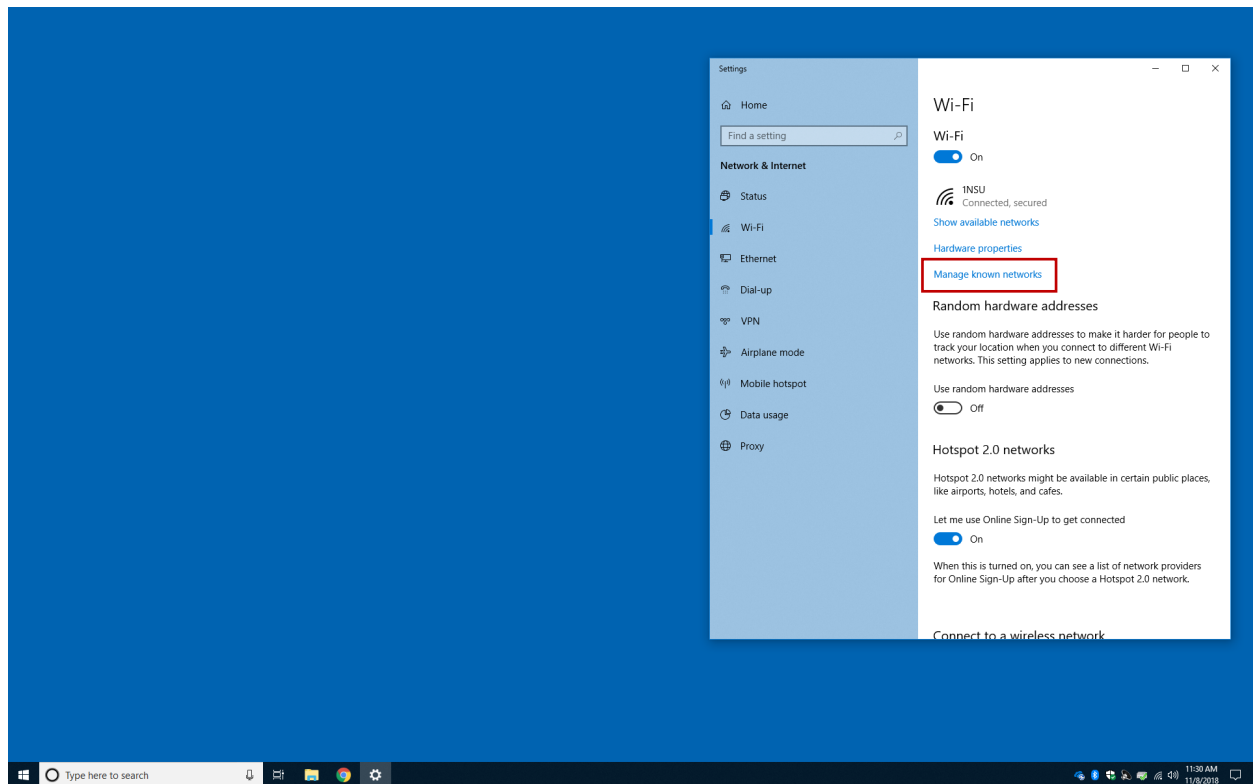
1. Select the 'Search' icon in the Start bar. Type **network** and select “**Network status**”.



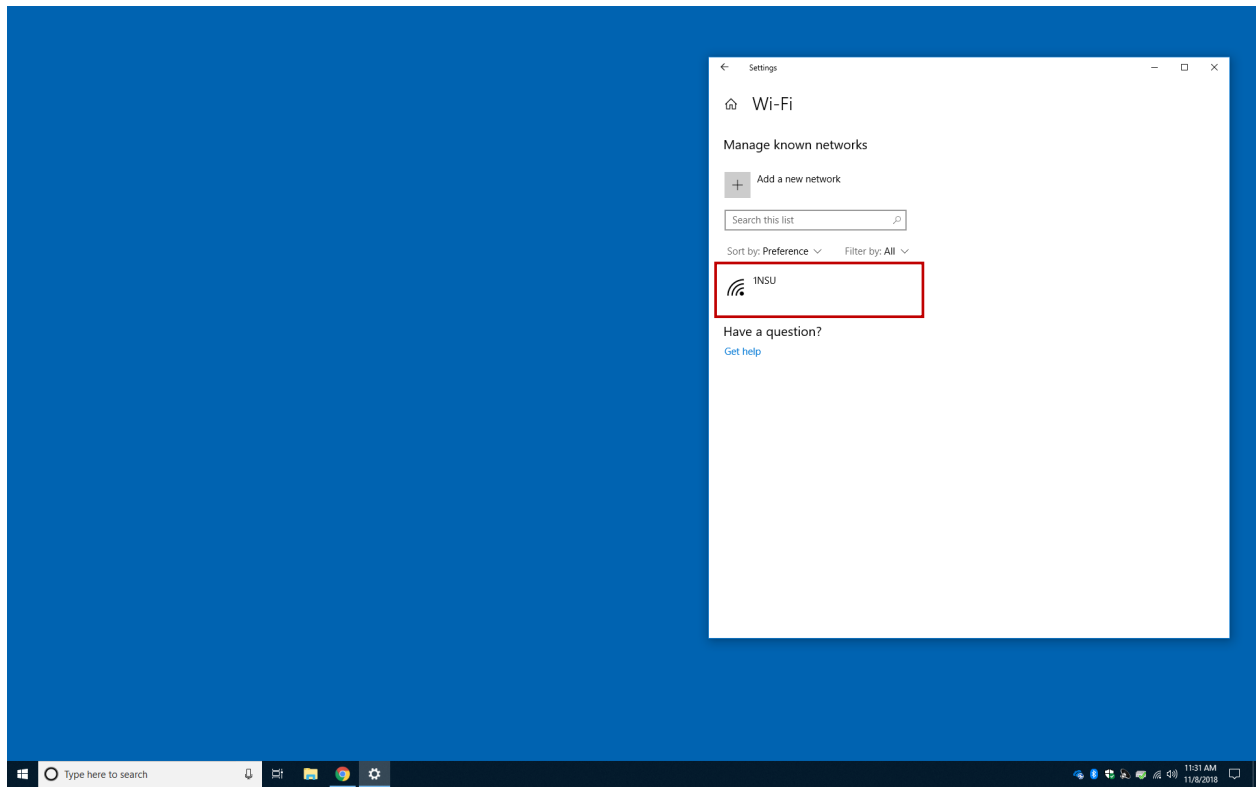
2. Select **Wi-fi** on the left, under **Network & Internet**.



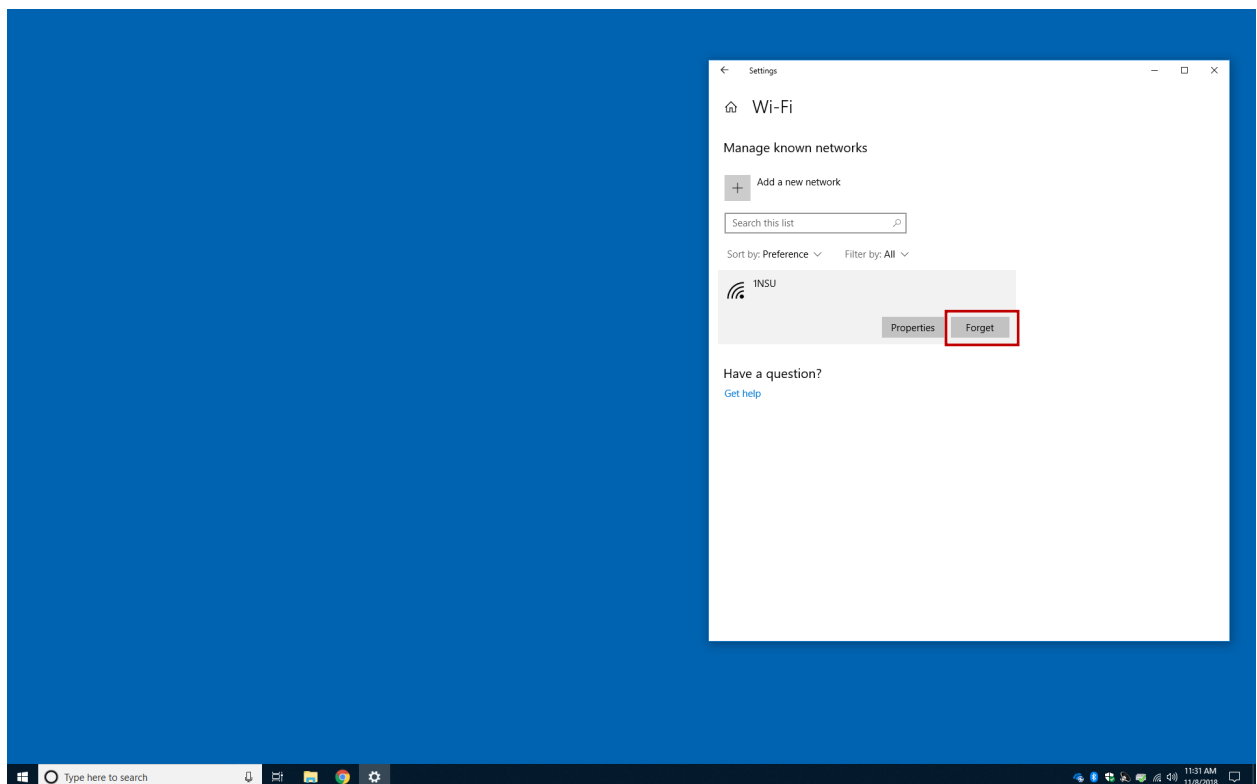
3. Select "Manage known networks".
